He will be coming from off the pace in a field laced with early speed. Behrens (Pleasant Colony), who won the 1997 running of the GII Pegasus H., struggled last year finishing in the money in only one of four starts. But he came back from a six-month layoff Jan. 9 to run a strong second in the traditional Donn prep, the GIII Broward H. Sir Bear (Sir Leon), the Broward victor, won the GI Cigar Mile two back, is remarkably consistent and should figure in today's outcome.

Third in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, Kona Gold (Java Gold) took two months off and came back Jan. 3 with a win in the El Conejo H. by 2 1/4 lengths. On paper, he appears much the best in this field.

GODOLPHIN DERBY ENTRY GROWS Aliabr (Storm Cat), the early favorite for the Sagitta 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 1, is yet another of Godolphin's three-year-olds who could be pointed toward the Kentucky Derby, it was reported yesterday by the Racing Post. Unbeaten after three starts, including an impressive 4 1/2-length victory in the G1 Prix de la Salamandre at Longchamp Sept. 19, Aljabr will join Godolphin's two American purchases, Worldly Manner (Riverman) and Comeonmom (Jolie's Halo), in preparing in Dubai for a run at the roses. Godolphin racing manager Simon Crisford told the Racing Post, "Aljabr has been entered for the Kentucky Derby and we will wait to see how he gets on in his trials in Dubai before making a decision on where he will run. We are keeping all our options open at this stage, but his owner, Sheikh Hamdan, is keen to consider the Kentucky Derby for Aljabr if he can demonstrate that the colt has the natural ability to handle the surface. We are looking at the Kentucky Derby project very seriously. Obviously, this is one of the best races in the world and it is a race in which we want to take part and, more than that, we want to be competitive." Godolphin has also nominated Listed winner Charmes (Personal Hope) for the Derby.

Jockey Josie Gomez received a 15-day suspension from Gulfstream stewards Monday after a spot check by the clerk of scales revealed she had somehow lost two pounds immediately after weighing out for the fourth race at Gulfstream Sunday, Jan. 24. Gomez weighed in with clerk of scales Jerry Santage at 118 pounds. A couple of minutes later, after a quick trip to the jockeys' room, Gomez was weighed a second time and was two pounds lighter. "It was the quickest weight drop I've ever seen," said Gulfstream steward Charlie Camac. Gomez' tack was corrected to 118 pounds and her mount, Bad Bad Betty, finished third at 16-1. Camac, a veteran racetracker said, "I haven't seen anything like that in years. Jockeys are getting smarter and don't try those kind of tricks these days." Gomez, who chose not to appeal her suspension, was not available for comment.
