Puerto Madero came to this country last summer and showed great potential with two fast-closing second-place finishes to Skip Away in the GIII Massachusetts H. and the GI Hollywood Gold Cup. He was laid off for four months after finishing up the track in the Aug. 15 Pacific Classic, but came back with a vengeance in the GIII Native Diver H. at Hollywood Dec. 20. In that race, he sat uncharacteristically close to the pace, but still unleashed a burst of speed in the lane to win by 2½ lengths. Made the 4-1 second choice by the crowd, Puerto Madero broke well and was in good position, rather close to a blazing pace of :23 1/5 and :46 3/5. The big bay angled outside of Sir Bear (Sir Leon) and Littlebitlively (Lively One) on the turn, gained command entering the stretch and was clear late for the victory. Behrens and Silver Charm made strong runs late, but were no match for the winner. "I think he just ran a great race today," said trainer Richard Mandella. When asked how the winner ranked with Gentlemen (Arg) and his other South American stars, Mandella replied, "He's right up there." Puerto Madero will go next in the G1 Dubai World Cup on Mar. 28. Bob Baffert, trainer of beaten favorite Silver Charm, said, "He didn't totally embarrass himself by running third. If this were a California race and we drew post 12, I wouldn't have run him."
