GOURMET GIRL SOLD Gourmet Girl (Cee's Tizzy), the 9-2 second choice on the morning line for today's GII La Cañada S. at Santa Anita, has been sold to Gary Tanaka for an undisclosed sum. Trainer Pico Perdomo said the deal was finalized Friday afternoon, and the four-year-old filly will race in Tanaka's colors this afternoon. Perdomo will saddle her for the La Cañada, but she will be transferred to the barn of trainer Ben Cecil after the race. The Cal-bred was purchased for \$3,500 as a yearling. She has compiled a record of four wins, three seconds and three thirds in 11 starts for earnings of \$238,638. She was second in the GI La Brea S. and GII El Encino S. in her last two starts. "I wasn't even thinking about selling her, but I said maybe after (the La Cañada) we can talk," said Perdomo. "But they wanted her for the race (today) and we were able to work something out."

GODOLPHIN CONFIRMS EIGHT FOR KENTUCKY DERBY Simon Crisford, the Godolphin racing manager, confirmed yesterday that eight of its colts have been nominated to the Triple Crown. The eight are: **Aljabr** (Storm Cat), **Always Believe** (Carr de Naskra), **Breathtaking View** (Country Pine), **Charmes** (Personal Hope), **Comeonmom** (Jolie's Halo), **Festive Bid** (Festive), **Prado's Landing** (El Prado {Ire}) and **Worldly Manner** (Riverman). "Worldly Manner and Comeonmom both continue to please the Godolphin team in their early build-up towards the Kentucky Derby," said Crisford. "The Godolphin team are planning to run the Triple Crown entries in two trials before final decisions are made about which of them will represent Dubai in the 'Run for the Roses.' All the Godolphin entries are making good progress at this time."

Looking for his first win since taking the GII Bernard Baruch H. at Saratoga last July, Yagli had put together a skein of seconds in his last three, the Sept. 26 GII Belmont Breeders' Cup, Nov. 7 GI Breeders' Cup Turf and Dec. 12 GI Hollywood Turf Cup. His rabbit, Rice (Blushing John), failed his assignment in the Turf Cup, fighting his rider in sixth behind a pedestrian pace that compromised Yagli's late run, but came through this time. Rice led through a mile in a rapid 1:35 2/5 as his stablemate bided his time at the back of the pack before slipping through an opening in the stretch and outrunning Wild Event to the wire for the score in a time three-fifths faster than the previous course record. "Rice did his job today," winning trainer Bill Mott said. "He did well to hang on for fourth." As for Yagli, Mott said, "He was probably the horse to beat in the Breeders' Cup. He had the 13 hole, had to go wide throughout and there was a soft pace. There was a soft pace at Hollywood, too. He will go on the shelf now and be freshened. It's a long year. We want to come back here for the Breeders' Cup." Rice could go next in the GII Pan American H. Mar. 6.

Event of the Year, sidelined for nine months after winning the GII Jim Beam S. for his fourth straight Mar. 29, came back to his first losses, running third in the Dec. 26 GI Malibu S. and second in the Jan. 16 GII San Fernando Breeders' Cup H. Favored to make it back to the winner's circle this time, he sat off a strong pace set by Artax and blew past that rival on the final turn to win convincingly. Trainer Richard Mandella is confident his colt is back to top form. "It's very rewarding," he said. "He's a very good horse, he just had a little learning to do. It's very likely that we'll go on to the Santa Anita H. (GI, Mar. 6)." Owner John Mabee joked, "Maybe we should make a stallion out of him now. I probably turned down \$20 million as a stallion last year." Dr Fong, the winner of the G1 St. James's Palace S. at Ascot last June, was making his first start on dirt. He challenged the winner in the stretch, but tired late to be second. Run Man Run (Theatrical {Ire}), winner of the Malibu S., was vanned off the track with a strained left front suspensory ligament. The injury was not life-threatening.

Bob and Beverly Lewis have yet another rising star, whose "exploits" will be closely monitored over the next few months. Exploit concluded a successful 1998 with a pair of graded-stakes victories at Churchill--the GIII Iroquois S. on Breeders' Cup day and the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. three weeks later--before being put away to prepare for his three-year-old campaign. He indicated his readiness for this start with a near-bullet five furlongs Feb. 2 in :58 2/5. With the field reduced to three with the defection of Futural (scratched due to a fever), Yes It's True was sent to the front, with Chris McCarron asking just enough from Exploit to prevent his front-running rival from gaining the rail and Aristotle content to track the top two from the outside. As the trio moved for the top of the stretch, Exploit made his bid along the inside, with Yes it's True laboring in between and the fresh challenge coming on the outside. Aristotle joined Exploit at the eighth pole, but it was the latter, exuding class, who made it home first. "When you see them hook up like that, you say 'Let's see how good he is.' The good horses, they keep going," trainer Bob Baffert said. "This horse doesn't like to lose." As for the future, Baffert said, "I want to run him in either the San Rafael (GII, Feb. 28) or the San Felipe (GII, Mar. 13) and then the Santa Anita Derby (GI, Apr. 3)."

It's not often that a starting gate is filled with Grade I winners, but such is the case with the San Antonio. Last year's GI Santa Anita H. hero Malek (Mocito Guapo {Arg}) ran a very strong race to be second in the Jan. 10 GII San Pasqual in his first race since his fourth-place showing in the 1998 Dubai World Cup. The bay should appreciate the extra sixteenth of a mile of today's race. Free House (Smokester) made only four 1998 appearances and has not been out since a second-place finish in the Oct. 17 GII Goodwood Breeders' Cup over this dirt, where he is three-for-six, including the 1997 Santa Anita Derby. Cavonnier (Batonnier) completed a miraculous comeback with a gutty victory in the restricted Ack Ack H. here Dec. 27. The gelding blew out smartly for this on Feb. 4, going four panels in a bullet :46 3/5.
