CHIP TO BE OFFERED AT CALDER SALE In what they are calling the shortest Horses of Racing Age Sale on record, Fasig-Tipton and Carolyn and Sonny Hine will sell multiple graded stakes winner Chip (Norquestor) on Tuesday, Mar. 2, immediately before that day's two-year-olds in training session. "There couldn't be a better time or place to sell her," said trainer Sonny Hine of the six-year-old mare. "She won three of her four graded stakes in Florida, the Thoroughbred world is right there at Calder for the Fasig-Tipton sales and the March 2 date gives her buyer nearly all of the 1999 breeding season to work with." Chip has recorded nine wins from 22 career starts and earned \$416,622. Most recently second in a Jan. 29 Gulfstream allowance, Hine said it is possible that she will start once more before being sold.

CHURCHILL RELEASES PRELIMINARY FU-TURE BOOK FIELD A preliminary field of 24 betting interests, chosen by the committee of Daily Racing Form writers Brad Free and Mike Watchmaker and Churchill Downs News and Information Director John Asher, was released yesterday for the first-ever Kentucky Derby Future Book wager. The entries are headed by the undefeated Exploit (Storm Cat), one of six Bob Baffert-trainees in the pool. He is the lowest price of the individual betting interests at 8-1, but track handicapper Mike Battaglia has installed the group of all other three-year-olds not listed in the first 23 as the 6-1 favorite. Three fillies made the listings as well, with Silverbulletday (Silver Deputy) at 10-1, Honest Lady (Seattle Slew) at 30-1 and Excellent Meeting (General Meeting) at 15-1. If any of the horses are injured before the wagering period begins, they will be replaced by alternates selected by the committee. "There's no standout in this year's group of Derby contenders and it looks like it could be the most wide-open Derby we've seen in years," said Battaglia. The final field for the first pool is set to be unveiled Feb. 16 for wagering which will take place between Feb. 18 and 21 at sites around the country. Subsequent pools will be offered Mar. 11-14 and Apr. 8-11.
