NINISKI DEAD Dual classic winner Niniski (Nijinsky II) died last fall, Lanwades Stud in Newmarket revealed vesterday. The sire of French Derby winner Hernando (Fr) was put down Nov. 21 last year at the age of 22. Niniski was purchased as a yearling for \$90,000 at the 1977 Saratoga Sales by Robin Hastings of the British Bloodstock Agency for owner Lady Beaverbrook. He was trained by Dick Hern to win both the G1 Irish St. Leger and G1 Prix Royal-Oak. In 1981, he retired to Lanwades Stud. His first runner, Petoski (GB) won the Champagne S. at Salisbury in his debut and later landed the 1985 G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. Niniski was retired from stallion duties in 1994 because of age-related fertility problems. He produced nine individual Group 1 winners, including Kala Dancer (GB) (Dewhurst S.) and Minster Son (GB) (St. Leger). He has been buried at Lanwades beside a half-size bronze of him by sculptor Philip Blacker. Dick Hern said, "I never trained a gamer or more genuine racehorse than Niniski. He was also extremely sound and easy to train."
