VICAR TAKES FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH Trainer Carl Nafzger has started one horse in the Kentucky Derby. that was 1990 winner Unbridled. Nafzger may be considering putting his perfect Derby record to the test after Vicar (Wild Again)'s victory in yesterday's GI Fountain of Youth. The dark bay colt, second choice in the field of 10, led from the start with Cat Thief (Storm Cat) pressing the pace and Certain (Out of Place) in third. The three stayed in that order to the finish, with Vicar outlasting Cat Thief by a neck at the wire. After the win, Nafzger said, "I think we have something very special here." Both Nafzger and jockey Shane Sellers said having their colt relax was the primary goal of yesterday's race. "I was hoping that his ears would come up in the first turn and they did and that meant he was relaxed," explained Sellers. "He stayed relaxed until I called upon him at the quarter pole and I put him in a drive and I was hoping that he'd last until the end. He fought hard to hold off Cat Thief and naturally, the one (Certain) was coming late too, but neither one of them was going to get to him at the wire." The top three finishers may hook up again in the Mar. 13 GI Florida Derby. The Fountain of Youth, run as a Grade I

SILVERBULLETDAY TRIUMPHANT IN RETURN After a slight bobble at the start, Silverbulletday (Silver Deputy) gave the New Orleans fans little doubt of her dominance, powering her way to a 2 1/4-length victory in yesterday's GIII Davona Dale S. at Fair Grounds. The once-beaten Two-Year-Old Champion Filly had not raced since winning the GIII Golden Rod S. at Churchill last November. Content to settle off the pace, the filly took over at the top of the lane and drew off at will. "I made the lead a little easier than expected and she loafed a little, so I just hustled her a little," said rider Gary Stevens. "She had her ears straight up." The pair were joined in a stretch battle by Certain, who had remained tucked behind the dueling leaders for much of the race, with Vicar gutting out the neck victory. Holy Bull winner Grits'n Hard Toast (Bates Motel) raced well back early, rallied seven wide at the top of the stretch and was closing late. "The only thing different between this race and the Holy Bull, is the fact that I didn't tell Shane Sellers what to do," said winning trainer Carl Nafzger. "I told Shane to ride his race. I just wanted the colt relaxed. It looked like when Shane asked him, he responded," Trainer D. Wayne Lukas was not discouraged by Cat Thief's narrow loss. "He ran an excellent race," said Lukas. "He hung tough in the stretch and I think he'll continue to improve."

Shopping around for places to run his filly, trainer Bob Baffert, after seriously considering the Feb. 28 GII San Rafael S. against colts, decided on this spot, simply because his filly "needed to run." The Eclipse winner, lending new meaning to the phrase "Big Easy," did not have the cleanest of breaks, but she recovered nicely to settle in behind a moderate pace which saw the opening six furlongs go in 1:13.17. As the field reached the far turn, jockey Gary Stevens said "go" and the bay responded to overtake D. Wayne Lukas' Debit Account (Mr. Prospector) approaching the eighth pole and drew away to a professional victory. Baffert said of his champion, "She has that athletic move. They can cruise around, (and) even if they get boxed, they can push their way out of there."
