HALL OF FAME NOMINEES ANNOUNCED The National Museum of Racing and Hall of Fame nominating committee released its list of 1999 nominees yesterday. California-based D. Wayne Lukas, Richard Mandella and Neil Drysdale were nominated during their first year of eligibility in the trainer category. Jockeys nominated include 6,000 race winners Russell Baze and Earlie Fires as well as the late Jack Westrope, who was the country's leading rider in 1933 and rode many high-profile horses until being fatally injured in a spill at Santa Anita in 1958. Belmont S. winner and Horse of the Year A.P. Indy heads the Contemporary Horse category, which also includes 1985 Champion Sprinter Precisionist and the winner of the 1979 Jockey Club Gold Cup, Exceller. The contemporary female horses nominated all accomplished their greatest feats versus the opposite sex. Dance Smartly won the Canadian Triple Crown, Miesque was a two-time winner of the Breeders' Cup Mile and Winning Colors won the Kentucky Derby. The Horses of Yesteryear category includes 1960 Handicap Champion Bald Eagle, Champion Two and Three-Year-Old filly Bowl of Flowers and the hardknocking handicap horse Gun Bow. A panel of over 130 racing writers, broadcasters and historians will vote for one winner in each category. The inductees will be announced during Kentucky Derby Week.

DAVIS GETS 3,000TH WIN Jockey Robbie Davis, who had been second nine times since getting his 2,999th win Sunday, finally got win number 3,000 aboard Inevitably Private in Gulfstream's fourth race yesterday. After beginning his career aboard Quarterhorses, Davis rode his first Thoroughbred at Turf Paradise in 1981 and moved his tack to New York in 1982. He was involved in a spill in 1988 at Aqueduct, in which his close friend, Mike Venezia, was killed. Davis didn't return to the saddle full time until 1992 and has been a top-10 rider on the New York/Florida circuit since. "It's nice to get it over with," exclaimed the 37-year-old as he was being congratulated by the Gulfstream jockey colony. He is the 90th rider to reach the 3,000-win plateau.

GODOLPHIN HORSES NOMINATED TO BLUE GRASS Godolphin yesterday revealed that its entries for the Triple Crown, Aljabr (Storm Cat), Always Believe (Carr de Naskra), Breathtaking View (Country Pine), Charmes (Personal Hope), Comeonmom (Jolie's Halo), Festive Bid (Festive), Prado's Landing (El Prado (Ire)) and Worldly Manner (Riverman), have all been entered in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. at Keeneland over nine furlongs on Apr. 10. Simon Crisford, the Godolphin racing manager, said, "The Blue Grass S. is a traditional trial for the Kentucky Derby and British challenger Bold Arrangement ran in the race before going on to finish second in the Kentucky Derby in 1986. Although we have stated that our plans are to head straight to the Kentucky Derby from Dubai, it is important that we keep all our options open, and it may well be that we will send a horse to this race.
