J.T. LUNDY ARRESTED ON BRIBERY CHARGES

A Houston federal grand jury has indicted former Calumet President J.T. Lundy on charges of bribing a bank to secure loans for his then-failing thoroughbred stable, the Associated Press reported yesterday. Lundy was arrested Tuesday night in Miami. The sixcount indictment, which names Lundy and Calumet's former Chief Financial Officer Gary Matthews, charges the two with one count each of conspiracy to defraud a financial institution, scheme to defraud, bank bribery and three counts of false statements to bank officials. The charges stem from the accusation that Lundy offered at least \$1 million to loan officials at the now-defunct First City Bancorp of Houston in exchange for approval of a \$50 million loan. First City was Calumet's biggest creditor when the farm filed for bankruptcy in 1991. The bank recieved \$20 million of the \$36.5 million insurance settlement that was distributed following the mysterious death of top sire Alydar. Last November, a former Calumet groom received a prison sentence after his conviction for lying to a grand jury investigating the stallion's death. Assistant U.S. attorney Julia Hyman declined to comment to the Associated Press on whether prosecutors believe Alydar's death was engineered to help pay off First City.


