PUERTO MADERO OUT OF DUBAI WORLD CUP Trainer Dick Mandella reported yesterday that GI Santa Anita H. fifth-place finisher Puerto Madero (Chi) (Gallantsky) was a "little stiff" yesterday morning and had filling in an ankle. The five-year-old will undergo X-rays at Santa Anita and is definitely out of the Mar. 28 G1 Dubai World Cup. In other Big 'Cap news, Free House (Smokester) came out of his wire-to-wire score in fine shape, trainer Paco Gonzalez reported yesterday. Runner-up Event of the Year (Seattle Slew) was in excellent condition Sunday morning and Mandella said he would meet with owner John Mabee to discuss a long term plan for the colt with the GI Breeders' Cup Classic as the ultimate goal. "It's nice to have one who's actually eligible," joked Mandella. Third-place finisher Silver Charm (Silver Buck) emerged from the race in good condition and is still being considered for Dubai, according to assistant trainer Eoin Harty.

REAL OUIET SECOND IN RETURN Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner Real Quiet (Quiet American) finished second in yesterday's GIII New Orleans H. at the Fair Grounds. It was the four-year-old's first start since missing the Triple Crown by a whisker last June. Sent off the 1-2 choice, Real Quiet pressed the slow pace set by Take Note Of Me (Notebook), made a four-wide move on the far turn and was outfinished by second choice Precocity (Aferd). "Off a layoff like that, he's going to be a little rusty," said trainer Bob Baffert. "He showed up. That's all you can ask. I liked the way he fought back. It looked like he wasn't going to get anything, but he came back on." Jockey Kent Desormeaux said, "I don't think (Precocity) caught Real Quiet on his day. But, you have to be at your best to beat the likes of this horse. The winner is no slouch; he's a very good horse." Baffert and Pegram will be back in New Orleans next weekend to saddle Silverbulletday (Silver Deputy) in the Mar. 13 GIII Fair Grounds Oaks. New Orleans H. chart page 3

Manistique won the first three races of her career last summer by a whopping 31 lengths combined, the third of those victories coming by 10 lengths in the GII Hollywood Oaks. A disappointing third-place effort in her next outing, the GI Alabama S. at Saratoga, was later attributed to a displaced palate and the big filly went to the sidelines to recover. Her three victories in as many starts since her return this past December have been equally spectacular, as she has completely dominated the competition, including a powerful 2 1/2-length victory in the GII La Cañada S. here Feb. 7 in her last. The only thing missing from her resumé was a Grade I success, but she would need not wait long for that. Sent off the overwhelming favorite in the compact field of four, jockey Gary Stevens on Manistique was satisfied to allow an eager Magical Allure to cut the early fractions and, as the field reached the far turn, Magical Allure snuck away to a two-length advantage. Rounding into the stretch, it was clear that Stevens always had the measure of Magical Allure as he ranged up alongside her at the eighth pole and guided the winner home. Trainer John Shirreffs said, "She seemed really focused in her race. She cruised around there, stalked Magical Allure and, when Gary asked her to pick it up, she picked it up willingly. And that was it--she just toyed with them from their." Prospects for a match-up in the GI Apple Blossom against Eclipse winner Banshee Breeze are not likely, as Shireffs indicated that he will point the winner to the GI Milady May 31 or the GI Vanity June 26.
