Banshee Breeze (Unbridled) during the month, James B. Tafel has been named the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association "Owner of the Month" for February. Tafel races Banshee Breeze, last year's champion three-year-old filly, in partnership with Jayeff B Stables. A retired magazine publisher from Illinois, Tafel has been in the Thoroughbred business since 1982. Of his star-filled stable's future, he said, "You know the vicissitudes of this business. But if everything stays just right and the Lord protects us, we're going to have a super year."

RECORD CROWD AT CHELTENHAM FESTIVAL

FINALE A record crowd of 50,472 saw nine-year-old See More Business (Ire) (Seymour Hicks (Fr)) come home a one-length winner over Go Ballistic (GB) (Celtic Cone {Ire}) in yesterday's \$407,874 G1 Cheltenham Gold Cup in Cheltenham, England, the featured event on the final day of the 1999 National Hunt Festival. The gelding, off the board after an unlucky trip as the second choice in the race last year, was off at 16-1 to take the 3 5/16-mile steeplechase this time around. Trainer Paul Nicholls credited an equipment change with the upset result. "He had been getting lazy and so I tried blinkers on him and he was transformed," Nicholls said of the jumper, who was just one-for-four on the year coming into the Gold Cup. The 5-2 favorite Florida Pearl (Ire) (Florida Son {GB}) was another 17 lengths back in third. "He wasn't as fluent at one or two of the fences as he has been in the past and that used up a lot of energy," explained trainer Willie Mullins. "He had nothing left coming up the hill." The on-track Tote handle was also a single-day record, with \$4,955,697 bet, up 12.3 percent from last year's Gold Cup program.
