SILVER CHARM ARRIVES IN DUBAI Silver Charm (Silver Buck) arrived in Dubai Friday morning to defend his crown in the \$5 million G1 Dubai World Cup on Mar. 28. The five-year-old grey champion touched down at Dubai International Airport at 5:20 a.m. local time. Also aboard the flight from Los Angeles to Dubai via Amsterdam was 1998 GI Santa Anita H. winner Malek (Chi) (Mocito Guapo (Arg)). Both horses were settled into the Dubai World Cup Quarantine Centre within an hour of landing. "Silver Charm traveled well," Eoin Harty, assistant to trainer Bob Baffert, reported. "It was a long trip and he seems to have come through it in great shape. We walked for about 15 minutes, gave him a feed and put him to bed." Fellow World Cup candidate Running Stag (Cozzene) also arrived in Dubai Friday morning.

"INTERNATIONAL" STARS AT SANTA ANITA SUNDAY Four of Europe's best riders will meet a like number of American jockeys Sunday in the second annual British Airways International Jockey Challenge at Santa Anita Park. The European team of Cash Asmussen, Kieren Fallon, Michael Kinane and Olivier Peslier will meet a squad made up of Russell Baze, Kent Desormeaux, Julie Krone and Alex Solis. The four-race Challenge will include one sprint and one distance race each on turf and dirt, and have been set as races four through seven on Sunday's card. Riders will receive 10 points for a win, five points for a second, three points for a third, two points for a fourth and one point for a fifth. Last year, Team USA swept the top four spots in the final leg of the contest to defeat Team Europe by 13 points. "We had such a tremendous response to last year's competition," Santa Anita Vice President Clifford Goodrich said. "This event has certainly grown in stature after last year. We hope to build the Jockey Challenge into something that will be watched by Thoroughbred racing fans around the world." According to the odds at the MGM Grand in Las Vegas, Team USA is the favorite to take the Challenge for the second time, while Baze is the 5-2 choice to earn the overall individual title.
