The bay captured Del Mar's Gl Ramona H. at 13-1 last August, but was 7-5 taking the Jan. 16 GII San Gorgonio H. in her first outing of '99. Given a couple of months off after that start, she had worked sharply for her return and ran back to those trials, saving ground on the first turn, angling to the outside to stalk the pace in fifth down the backstretch, then rallying three-wide into the lane to gain the lead in deep stretch and draw clear. "It was just really fun," winning jockey Kent Desormeaux said. "Going down the backside, they picked it up nicely and I was able to let her get comfortable. But from the three-eighths pole to the quarter pole she loomed up behind 'em and was saying, 'Jock, come on, please just turn me loose.' When I did, it was like, 'Yes, let's go get 'em.'" The French-bred goes next in the Apr. 17 GII Santa Barbara H., where she will meet last year's champion turf mare Fiji (GB).

Second sprinting in his first two appearances last November at Churchill, Etbauer broke his maiden in his three-year-old bow going 1 1/16 miles over this track Feb. 10 and came right back to take an Oaklawn allowance at a mile Mar. 3. The second choice in his stakes debut, the bay came away from the gate cleanly, dueled head-and-head through a half in :46.11, took a clear lead after six furlongs in 1:10.92, opened up by three lengths at the top of the lane and then was all out to hold off the late surge of favored Desert Demon for the victory. "I really haven't done a lot getting this horse up to this race," winning trainer Steve Wren admitted. "We have had a quarter crack problem with him. The patch was just put on yesterday." Said jockey Mike Smith, "Heading into the final turn I was feeling very confident and was only worried about (jockey Jule Krone aboard Desert Demon). I was looking around trying to see where she was, but I couldn't find her. Through the lane I had to stay busy because my horse started looking around." Krone added, "At the quarter pole I had to make a sudden and sharp move and...that cost my horse a lot of momentum and may have cost him the race. I could never make up the difference." The top two are likely to meet again in the GII Arkansas Derby Apr. 10.
