#### TEAM EUROPE TAKES INTERNATIONAL

JOCKEY CHALLENGE Kieren Fallon's two wins led Team Europe to a decisive 49-35 victory over Team USA in the second annual British Airways International Jockey Challenge, held yesterday at Santa Anita Park. Olivier Peslier got Team Europe off to a flying start, taking the first leg of the four-race series with a frontrunning score aboard 7-1 Sir Dennis. Fallon then won with 3-1 Dixieland Sham and 19-1 A King's Presence, giving Team Europe an insurmountable 44-19 lead after three races. Kent Desormeaux saved the home team from a whitewash with a victory in the final race aboard 6-1 Twilight Affair. "I was fortunate to have some good rides today," said Fallon. "I credit my coming over here four or five years ago to (the late trainer) Rodney Rash. He taught me everything I know. He's probably the main reason why I'm here." Fallon (22 points) was the individual winner, followed by Desormeaux (18), Peslier (15), Alex Solis (9), Cash Asmussen (7), Michael Kinane and Julie Krone (5) and Russell Baze (3). Team USA won last year's competition, 48.5-35.5, after sweeping the top four spots in the final race.

#### **OBS MARCH UNDER TACK PREVIEW RESULTS**

During Sunday's second session of the Under Tack Preview for the Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's Annual March Selected Sale of Two-Year-Olds in Training, Hips 229-557 took to the track. Fast times were at a premium, as the two-year-olds were forced to buck strong headwinds down the stretch gusting to 25 miles per hour. With a guarter mile in :21 3/5 into that stiff headwind, Exciting Story, a colt by Diablo--Appealing Storm (Valid Appeal), posted the fastest work at the distance. The full brother to stakes winner Diablo's Story sells next Wednesday, March 31, as part of the Mark Casse consignment. A pair of youngsters shared honors for the session's fastest eighth mile work. The Devil's Bag filly Purgatory, consigned by Southern Cross Farm as Hip 413, and a Saint Ballado filly to be sold by Gold Crest Farm as Hip 450, both sped the distance in :10 2/5. The day's fastest 3/8-mile work was recorded by another Mark Casse consignee, as Rich Timber, a chestnut colt by Rizzi--Timber Ghost (Great Above) selling as Hip 305, drilled in :35 1/5. The regular Under Tack Show is set for March 27-28, with the March Sale scheduled for March 30-31.

Single Empire had been winless in five starts since taking the G1 Derby Italiano in May, 1997. The chestnut had started only once before in the U.S. in his most recent outing, a second-place finish in the GIII Carleton F. Burke H. over the Santa Anita turf Oct. 25. Off five months since that effort, he returned here to track the pacesetters early before swinging four wide into the stretch, where he rallied gamely to just get up by a nose. Winning trainer Neil Drysdale said of Single Empire, "He had been working very well. He was a little fresh today because he hadn't run since October. This was the plan all along. We ran him off the plane at Oak Tree (in the Carleton F. Burke), then we wanted to give him a little time and bring him back here. Kessem Power got the jump on us, but we won't pick up any weight for the (April 18, Grade I) San Juan Capistrano, will we? I like to look on the bright side." Trainer Mike Mitchell said Kessem Power will show up for a rematch with Single Empire in the San Juan Capistrano.

WORLDLY MANNER TAKES GODOLPHIN DERBY TRIAL A private trial race was held yesterday at Dubai's Nad Al Sheba racecourse for Godolphin's Kentucky Derby hopefuls, involving Triple Crown nominees Aljabr (Storm Cat), Always Believe (Carr de Naskra), Breathtaking View (Country Pine), Charmes (Personal Hope), Festive Bid (Festive), Prado's Landing (El Prado (Ire)) and Worldly Manner (Riverman), plus three others. Last year's GII Del Mar Futurity hero Worldly Manner, ridden by Jerry Bailey, won the trial race by just over a length from Aljabr, ridden by John Velasquez, with the pair comfortably ahead of the others. The nine-furlong trial on dirt was run in 1:46.59. Godolphin Racing Manager Simon Crisford commented afterwards, "Worldly Manner had the superior finish over Aljabr and we thought it was an impressive performance. Both of them are on schedule for the (May 1) Kentucky Derby. This was the first of two prep races they are going to have, with the other one being at Nad Al Sheba in April. We have not decided on the jockeys for the Kentucky Derby yet--it is way too early and we obviously have to see what commitments they

Over a surface dampened by a steady rain yesterday, heavily-favored Apremont dueled on the lead right from the start, blasting through the opening four furlongs in :44 3/5, with Badge biding his time towards the rear. As the field left the three-eighths pole, Mr. Katowice (Katowice) came in on second choice Successful Appeal (Valid Appeal), causing that one to take up sharply, while Badge, bumped soundly in the traffic, split rivals on the turn and moved towards the lead. #### Jockey Dies in Hong Kong:

Apprentice jockey Wai "Willy" Kan, the first female to ride in the Hong Kong Derby, died in Prince of Wales Hospital yesterday from injuries suffered in a spill during a race at Hong Kong's Sha Tin Racecourse earlier in the day, according to the Associated Press. The 20-year-old Kan was aboard Happy King, who clipped heels with another horse and stumbled, throwing Kan to the track, where she was struck by several trailing horses. Racing, which took place in intermittent heavy rain, was called off after the jockey's death. Kan had ridden in Britain last year, winning a race at Haydock Park for David Nicholls.
