#### STEVENS CONTEMPLATES ENGLISH MOVE

Top U.S. jockey Gary Stevens is returning to Britain to ride at Royal Ascot and the trip could be a prelude to a more permanent move, according to Tuesday's Racing Post. Stevens, who rode Predappio (GB) to victory in the 1997 Hardwick S., told the Post, "I'll be over for Ascot; beyond that I don't know what's going to happen. But it's not a question of if I'm coming to Britain, it's when." Stevens told the paper his English wife's desire to return home and his own desire for new professional challenges spurred his decision for the move.

**BROODMARE UP THE FLAGPOLE DEAD William** S. Farish's mare Up the Flagpole (Hoist the Flag) was euthanized at Rood and Riddle Equine Hospital Mar. 1 due to complications from internal bleeding, the Blood-Horse Online reported yesterday. The 21-yearold mare had problems before foaling a Kingmambo filly that night, and veterinarians were forced to deliver the foal by Caesarean section. "Dr. William Bernard did a nice job of saving the filly, but we had to put the mare down," Lane's End Farm Manager Michael Cline told the Blood-Horse. In her racing career, Up the Flagpole won seven races, including the GII Delaware H., and \$166,960. Of the first 10 foals she produced, all won. Her top runners were MGISW Prospector's Delite (Mr. Prospector), GSW Top Account (Private Account), GISW Runup the Colors (A.P. Indy) and GSW Flagbird (Nureyev), the Highweight Older Mare in England, Ireland and Italy at age four.

TEXAS A son of A.P. Indy--Summer Matinee (Summing) brought a final bid of \$110,000 to top Tuesday's Fasig-Tipton Texas Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale. He was purchased by Marilyn Kosin from the consignment of Jill Julian. Leland Cook purchased the highest-priced filly of the sale. By Roy out of Proudest Rose (Proudest Roman), she sold for \$100,000 from the consignment of Wayne Mataska, agent. The sale's average rose 45 percent from \$13,252 in 1998 to \$19,212 in 1999. Fasig-Tipton grossed \$3,304,500 from the sale of 172 two-year-olds. Last year's two-day sale grossed \$3,286,400 from the sale of 248 horses.

### Melbourne Cup Conditions Changes:

In an effort to prevent the controversy which surrounded last year's race, new conditions for the Foster's Melbourne Cup were announced yesterday. There were protests last year when the Victoria Racing Club gave British raider Yorkshire (Ire) a place in the field, instead of a locally trained horse who had been ahead in the balloting order. Club chief executive Brian Beattie said, "The new conditions make it clear that the committee will, if necessary, act to ensure that the best possible field is assembled in the race and that no horse is guaranteed a start. They also recognize performances in black-type races world-wide regardless of prize money. However, as in the past, the conditions provide for the handicapper's assessment of each horse to be an important measure of its relative position in the balloting order." An AUS\$200,000 (US\$124,541) boost to the prize money for the Melbourne Cup makes it Australia's first AUS\$3 million (\$1.9 million) race.
