GODOLPHIN UNVEILS DERBY PLANS Sheikh

Mohammed yesterday revealed what could be a four-pronged Godolphin challenge on the Kentucky Derby. Prado's Landing (El Prado {Ire}), third in a Mar. 21 trial race at Nad al Sheba, will travel to Keeneland for the Apr. 10 GI Toyota Blue Grass S., while the trial winner Worldly Manner (Riverman) and runner-up Aljabr (Storm Cat) are likely go to the first leg of the Triple Crown without official prep races. Sheikh Mohammed said, "People criticize us for going straight to the Kentucky Derby and we know the Kentucky Derby is a very hard race to win. But this track here makes the horses fit. Lammtarra had won a small race and was sick when he came here, but he recovered and went straight to win the (Epsom) Derby. What I am trying to say is that we don't need a prep race, we will have a prep race here. There is everything--the cameras, the track, the lights--everything except the crowd. Godolphin is an international stable now and we will go wherever we can. I have not been to a Kentucky Derby, but I have studied all the races on film to try to find ways to go there." Comeonmom (Jolie's Halo), who missed the trial, is also possible to run for the roses without an official prep. The Sheikh explained, "Comeonmom is behind because his skin is not right, and he will need another three weeks. He will go in our second trial and whether he goes to America depends on him." Sheikh Mohammed has been represented in the Kentucky Derby before as he bought a half share in Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner Arazi from Allen Paulson before the colt disappointed at Churchill Downs in 1991. "We hoped Arazi would run well in the race...he didn't train on, but I am very pleased with the way these horses train and they will come to the races fit enough if they are good enough," the Sheikh continued. "We know it is very difficult and we know how important it is to win it. But we can't win it unless we try and if we don't win it, we will come back again and again."

Although the race is carrying a new name and Turfway Park has new ownership, one thing about the Northern Kentucky track's traditional Kentucky Derby prep remains the same: A field of extremely talented but inexperienced sophomores, each with something to prove, will either be made a contender or pretender by their performances in this race. Last year it was Northern California phenom Event of the Year, undefeated in only three starts, who won by five widening lengths and stamped himself the Kentucky Derby favorite. Unfortunately, he was injured just before the Derby and had to wait until this winter to show his stuff. This year, Epic Honor (Honor Grades) will look to duplicate the Bay Meadows-to-Turfway angle. He won the GIII Golden Gate Derby two back and most recently took the Golden State Mile Feb. 15. Bob and Beverly Lewis' Straight Man (Saint Ballado) is a lightly raced and lightning fast colt who has done nothing wrong in maiden and allowance wins from two starts at Santa Anita. According to exercise rider Larry Damore, "He showed a lot of class shipping here. This horse is just a freak." Trainer Bob Baffert will be flying in from Dubai an hour before post time in order to saddle the colt for the race. K One King (Apalachee) has won three in a row over local horses. He most recently took the John Battaglia Memorial S. by nine lengths in the slop Mar. 6. The colt was purchased by Allen and Madeleine Paulson for a reported \$1.7 million after that victory. MIGHT AND POWER INJURES TENDON Australian Horse of the Year Might And Power (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}--Benediction {Ire}, by Day is Done {Ire}) is extremely unlikely to race again after suffering a tendon injury in a track gallop Thursday at Rosehill in Australia. He was scheduled to gallop between races at Rosehill on Saturday. "It was the phone call I never ever wanted to receive," said owner Nick Moraitis. "I was devastated. I don't know if it's the end, all I can say is the horse is going for a long spell." Might And Power hasn't raced since winning the G1 Queen Elizabeth S. at Flemington last November and injury rumours surfaced when Moraitis decided to pass on the G1 Japan Cup. The six-year-old has won 15 of 35 outings for earnings of Aus\$5,226,286 (US\$3,254,428), placing him third on the all time Australian money winners list behind Octagonal (NZ) and Super Impose (NZ).
