ZITO GETS "EVEN" IN GALLERY

FURNITURE.COM Fired by Gallery Furniture boss Jim McIngvale just about a year ago, trainer Nick Zito exacted his revenge at Turfway Park yesterday, sending 7-1 Stephen Got Even (A.P. Indy) to a 2 1/2-length victory over 7-2 K One King (Apalachee) in the \$750,000 GII Gallery Furniture.com S. "He never ceases to amaze me, this horse," Zito said. "There's no question this is a top colt. This was only his fourth start and it was real impressive. I think when we go further he's going to get even better." The Brooklyn-bred horseman, with a pair of Kentucky Derby trophies already on the shelf, has the deck stacked in his favor for a third. Zito also has the fastclosing GI Florida Derby runner-up Wondertross waiting in the wings for the Apr. 10 Gl Toyota Blue Grass S. "I've been trying all spring to get myself into position (for the Derby)," he said. "I really want to be strong in the Derby. Over the years, (Bob) Baffert and Wayne (Lukas) have had a pretty good hand, and I just want to be equal with them when I go in this year. I think I've got a pretty strong hand right now." It wasn't entirely a rocking chair ride, but jockey Shane Sellers had little more to do than sit back and relax as Stephen Got Even, forced to race six-wide around both turns, rallied from just off the pace in his stakes debut to make it three-for-three in route attempts. "I don't think we saw the best today out of this horse," Sellers insisted. "He ran through the lane really green. Every time I went to hit him, he hit another gear, but he ducked from the stick so I had to grab him. Believe me, I never got to the bottom of him and that's very encouraging." Trainer Bob Baffert flew in from Dubai to saddle 2-1 favorite Straight Man (Saint Ballado), but the bay, also taking on stakes company for the first time after winning his first two starts, tired badly after setting a pedestrian pace and finished fourth. "On the backstretch, I was getting my winner's speech ready, but that's horse racing," Baffert said. "They were just walking out there and he was relaxed. He was laying in perfect position, then he got tired. The track is a little loose and he's not used to that. He'll go to Churchill and he'll have plenty of time. He may run in something like the Lexington S. (GII, at Keeneland Apr. 18)."

Silver Charm (Silver Buck) is undefeated over this track, is coming off a very good third in the GI Santa Anita H. and also has a little bit of history on his side. The last time a Kentucky Derby winner met an Epsom Derby winner, the 1923 Kentucky Derby winner Zev defeated the English hope *Papyrus in a race at Belmont Park. Last year's Epsom Derby winner High-Rise (High Estate {Ire}) appears to be Godolphin's best hope for World Cup glory. The bay, last out seventh in the Oct. 4 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, has reportedly taken to the surface very well. The other U.S. representatives are Malek (Mocito Guapo {Arg}), fourth in this race last year, and GI Belmont S. winner Victory Gallop (Cryptoclearance). While Victory Gallop has only a Gulfstream allowance prep for this event, Malek was second in the Jan. 10 Gll San Pasqual H. and Feb. 7 Gll San Antonio H. Running Stag (Cozzene), a live longshot who showed strong late runs in his four U.S. dirt starts, was fourth, beaten 1 1/2 lengths by Silver Charm, in Churchill's GII Clark H. Nov. 27 last out.

Stephen Got Even hasn't put a hoof wrong since making his two-turn debut in his second start. The bay broke his maiden at Gulfstream Jan. 30 and was sent onto the Triple Crown trail after adding an allowance score over the track Feb. 27. Breaking from the far outside in this eight-horse field, he was hung out to dry on both turns while sitting just off front-running favorite Straight Man (Saint Ballado) and second choice K One King, but overcame the lost ground, driving to the lead at midstretch and drawing away in the final furlong for a decisive score. Jockey Shane Sellers, the regular pilot for GI Florida Derby winner Vicar, picked up the mount from world traveler Jerry Bailey. "I didn't want to go that wide," Sellers admitted, "but I had been sitting on (K One King's) flank and he was hung out wide by (Straight Man). I had to play the hand that was dealt me. But when you're on the best horse, as I was today, you can overcome it. He ran a monster race." Trainer Nick Zito will put his head together with winning owner Stephen Hilbert's team before deciding if the colt will race again before his date in the May 1 Kentucky Derby. "That's a tough question...I will have to talk to Mr. (Tim) Sams, Mr. Hilbert's manager," he said. "(Stephen Got Even) ran pretty well fresh. We've got a ticket right now and, a lot of times, if you've got a ticket you take it...maybe I'll go to this Broadway show right from here. We'll see." Runner-up K One King likely will go straight to Churchill Downs. "It was a very good experience for him and he needed it," said trainer Akiko Gothard. "Right now I think we will train him right up to the Derby. I think he still has room to get better and I think this race will move him up."

As always, the Slipper was a roughly run affair and High Rolling's jockey Glen Boss was livid returning to scale, fuming, "It is the roughest run race in the world and if something is not done then someone will be killed."
