SECOND TIME'S NOT THE CHARM Unheralded Almutawakel (GB) (Machiavellian), from the vast barn of trainer Saeed bin Suroor, sprung a 44-1 surprise in the \$5 million G1 Dubai World Cup at Nad-al-Sheba vesterday, defeating American-based Malek (Chi) (Mocito Guapo {Arg}) by three parts of a length. Last year's Belmont S. winner Victory Gallop (Cryptoclearance) was another 3/4 of a length back in third. The biggest disappointment of the day was the lackluster performance of defending champion Silver Charm (Silver Buck), who recovered quickly from a stumbling start and was in striking position with three furlongs to run, but flattened out and finished a distant sixth. Jockey Gary Stevens said of Silver Charm, "He didn't jump well and I knew I was in trouble after an eighth of a mile. He was moving soundly under me, but never gave me a good feel. I tried to make headway at the half-mile, but nothing happened, so I just took care of him as he's been such a good servant to us." The victory capped a career day for jockey Richard Hills who also had the winning mount aboard Altibr (Diesis {GB}) in the \$500,000 Dubai Duty Free some 45 minutes before the big race. Almutawakel took up a stalking position from the outside behind front-running Central Park (Ire) (In The Wings (GB)) for the opening five furlongs. The eventual winner made steady progress while still on the outside, hit the front with a quarter mile to run and withstood all challenges in a determined victory. Of his winning trip, Hills said, "We were very content to stay slightly on the outside. He really tried hard for me in the last furlong." The Englishman added, "It doesn't get any better than this. This is a dream come true for me." The victory was the second World Cup title for the Godolphin "home team" which sent out Singspiel (Ire) to win the 1997 World Cup. "It was a great performance by horse and jockey," said Sheikh Mohammed al Maktoum, hosting his fourth World Cup. "That the winner was trained by Godolphin makes it even better. I thought High-Rise (Ire) (High Estate {Ire}) and Daylami (Ire) (Doyoun {Ire}) would improve from the trial, but maybe they don't like the sand." Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid al Maktoum, owner and breeder of the winner, added, "That was a very long final quarter-mile. I always told them to keep this horse in training as a four-year-old. I knew he needed time and didn't want him to be over-raced as a three-year-old. It's a great thrill to win this race and I must congratulate my brother Sheikh Mohammed for all the work he has put into the race."

Lightly raced Almutawakel, homebred by Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid al Maktoum and carrying his colors, gave the Maktoum family its second World Cup win under a perfectly time ride by Richard Hills. Seventh in the G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas at Newmarket last May, Almutawakel captured the G1 Prix Jean Prat at Chantilly and was second in the G1 Grand Prix de Paris. Shipped to Dubai for the winter, he had impressed in workouts leading up to this event, winning the trial for local horses. Settled in fourth while Central Park (Ire) (In the Wings {GB}) set a strong pace from Malek, Silver Charm (Silver Buck) and Daylami (Ire) (Doyoun {Ire}), Almutawakel closed on the leaders at the five-eighths pole and pursued Central Park into the stretch, grabbing the lead at the quarter-pole. Victory Gallop made good progress from the rear and made a strong move to challenge the leader while Malek came again. Almutawakel battled on and had enough left in reserve to withstand Malek while Victory Gallop's run petered out. Winning jockey Richard Hills said, "Everything went right, we got into the right positions at the right time. He was always traveling well and dug deep when it mattered." Malek represents the third runner-up finish for trainer Dick Mandella in the four-year history of the race, but he was not disappointed with his trainee's effort. "I am extremely pleased with the way he ran," said Mandella and jested of his "bad luck." "If I keep writing it on the board, I might get it right," he said.

Stravinsky Defeated in '99 Bow:

Stravinsky (Nureyev), early favorite for the Sagitta 2,000 Guineas at Newmarket, suffered a quick fall from grace with the bookmakers after a narrow loss to Tarfaa (Ire) (Nigh Shift) in his 1999 debut in a conditions race yesterday at The Curragh in Ireland. According to trainer Aidan O'Brien, Stravinsky, third in last year's G1 Dewhurst S., did not take to the soft ground. Bookmakers Coral dropped the former Guineas favorite from 5-1 to 12-1, with Mujahid (Danzig) now the 7-2 choice. The Tote has removed Stravinsky from its book altogether.

Under Pat Day, Parade Ground was tenth early and had only two rivals beaten at the threeeighths marker, but once into the stretch, Day cut his mount loose and the colt stormed powerfully down the center of the racetrack to lead inside the final 100 yards and win going away under a hand ride.

What a difference a year makes. Lord Smith would sooner forget his 1998 campaign, which saw him go winless in five starts, with only a minor placing in the GIII Cinema H. at Hollypark to show for his efforts. Since hitting the track in 1999, the gelding was a perfect three-for-three, including a pair of allowance victories, and his first graded stakes triumph in his most recent effort, a very game performance in the GII Arcadia H. at one mile over the Santa Anita turf Mar. 6. The rival he outgamed in that event was the turf star Hawksley Hill, who was back to challenge again, this time without blinkers. Jockey Garrett Gomez took advantage of what appeared to be a paceless field and put Lord Smith on the front, leading his 11 rivals through three-quarters in a pedestrian 1:15 2/5. Hawksley Hill for his part was saving ground, waiting for just the right time to launch his assault on the lead. By the eighth pole, it was still Lord Smith by two, with Hawksley Hill, now in the clear, gobbling up ground with every stride, and though he got to the neck of his rival in deep stretch, he could not get by that one and Lord Smith recorded his fourth consecutive victory. Gomez said of his mount, "The other colt (Hawksley Hill) came up to us like he did the other day, but when it comes down to fighting, my colt's a pretty good fighter." Next up, Lord Smith vs. Lennox Lewis?
