LIL'S LAD RETURNS FRIDAY Lil's Lad (Pine Bluff), a top contender for last year's Kentucky Derby before being sidelined by injury, makes his 1999 debut in Friday's seventh race at Keeneland. Lil's Lad captured last year's GII Fountain of Youth S. and was runner-up in Keeneland's GI Toyota Blue Grass S. The four-year-old has not raced since finishing off the board in two New York allowance races last September. Lil's Lad will face nine rivals in Friday's seven-furlong allowance contest.

◆ TRIPLE THREATS ◆

General Challenge (General Meeting) worked a bullet six furlongs Monday at Santa Anita in 1:10. It was the colt's second blazing work with blinkers on as he prepares to run next in Saturday's GI Santa Anita Derby.

Meanwhile, controversy swirls over who will ride the once-beaten Bob Baffert trainee. Chris McCarron had been scheduled to ride General Challenge in the Santa Anita Derby and Gary Stevens was slated to ride **Real Quiet** (Quiet American) that same day in the GI Oaklawn H. Baffert decided not to run Real Quiet at Oaklawn and named Stevens to ride General Meeting. On Wednesday morning, Scott McClellan, agent for McCarron, met with the stewards and contended that he had a verbal agreement with Baffert for McCarron to ride General Challenge. Baffert also met with the stewards Wednesday and a resolution is pending.

At Aqueduct yesterday, GII Wood Memorial contender **David** (Mt. Livermore) worked six furlongs in a bullet 1:14 1/5 for trainer Mike Hushion.

Herat S. winner **Karley's Harley** (Harlan) breezed a half mile in :49 1/5 and is also probable for the Wood.

Bugatti (A.P. Indy), winless in six starts at two but two for three this year, prepared for the Wood with a five-furlong move in 1:02.

SAINT BALLADO FILLY TOPS OBS FINALE Hip number 450, a filly by Saint Ballado--Cope With a Lady (Copelan), topped the OBS March Sale of Selected Two-Year-Olds in Training yesterday in Ocala, Fl. with a final bid of \$370,000. The filly, who worked a bullet quarter-mile in :21 1/5 at Sunday's Under Tack Show, was consigned by Gold Crest Farm, agent, and Aaron and Marie Jones made the sales-topping bid. The two-day sale's average was down 8.1 percent from the record set during last year's March Sale. "Last year's sale was a tough act to follow, but we had a wonderful day of racing and there was considerable strength at the top of the market," said OBS Director of Sales Tom Ventura. "There was some weakness in the middle of the market, however, so we'll take a good look at the results and then get ready for the April Sale."

Japanese Champion to Eclipse:

The 1998 champion Japanese three-year-old **El Conador Pasa** (Kingmambo) is scheduled to arrive in France Apr. 15 for a European campaign which is likely to begin with an appearance in the G1 Coral-Eclipse S. at Sandown, England, July 3. Original plans called for the G1 Japan Cup winner to contest the July 24 G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot. Tony Clout, who will train the colt in France, told the *Racing Post*, "At the moment, the main goal in England is the Eclipse, but nothing will be decided until it is known how the horse has taken the journey from Japan and how well he has settled in here after two weeks." The ultimate 1999 goal for the once-defeated colt is the G1 Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp in October.

Champagne Retired:

Multiple Grade 1 winner **Champagne (NZ)** (Zabeel {NZ}--L'Quiz {L'Enjoleur}) has been retired from racing. The four-year-old mare, who suffered a leg injury while turned out, won last year's G1 Ansett Australia S. and was second in the 1998 G1 Melbourne Cup.
