NUREYEV COLT TOPS INGLIS EASTER SALE

There seems little doubt the Nureyev colt from Miss Bold Appeal (Valid Appeal) (Lot 104) will fetch the top price at the three-day Inglis Australian Easter Sale which kicks off today. The half-brother to MGISW Jersey Girl will be offered by Roselands Stud during the first session. Roselands principal Lynden Burns has paraded his star colt more than 200 times. "He is as close as I have ever seen to his father, who is a lovely horse...this particular colt is almost a clone of his father," he said. "He's the first Nureyev to be offered in Australia and he is pretty special." Others highlighting a catalogue of 557 yearlings are a Danehill--Princess Tracy (Ire) (Ahonoora {GB}) (Lot 168) colt from the Arrowfield consignment whose full brother fetched AUS\$600,000 (US\$373,622) last season. A Danehill colt out of the dam of Saintly (Aus), All Grace (NZ) (Sir Tristram {Ire}), offered by Coolmore Stud is likely to dominate along with a Danehill colt from Dream Appeal (Valid Appeal). Freshman stallion Thunder Gulch is also capable of stealing the limelight from Danehill and Zabeel (NZ) with 34 yearlings catalogued. As for the buyers, Inglis spokesman Vin Cox said, "We've got a good bench present from Hong Kong and South Africa, but we expect the local market will carry this sale. But it is a really international catalogue--buyers from Europe, North America and Hong Kong recognize the shuttle stallions." Nobody inspects yearlings more thoroughly than trainer Gai Waterhouse and after doing the rounds she declared the half brother to Marauding (NZ) (Lot 394), a Danehill colt offered by Coolmore, among her picks. "In the last two years this has become a designer-label sale," she said. "The Magic Millions is where you go for early-maturing speed and you go to New Zealand for stayers. This is haute couture." Emboldened by the success of last year's high-flying Easter sale foray, South African expatriate James Bester is gearing up for another buy-up on behalf of owner Sabina Platter, whose horses race with trainer Chris Snaith in Cape Town, South Africa. Last year Bester surprised everyone emerging as leading buyer with five yearlings bought for AUS\$2.25 million (\$1.4 million) for Mrs. Platter. Nobody will be surprised if Bester is in the running for the Nureyev--Miss Bold Appeal colt. Last year Bester numbered the AUS\$800,000 (\$498,163) sales-topping Lure colt among five purchases.

WORLDLY MANNER TO SKIP SECOND TRIAL

The second trial race for horses from the Godolphin stable possibly bound for Churchill Downs will take place later this week at Nad al Sheba in Dubai, but it will not include Worldly Manner (Riverman), who will head straight to the May 1 Kentucky Derby, or Comeonomom (Jolie's Halo), who remains behind schedule. Godolphin's Racing Manager Simon Crisford said yesterday that the 1 1/8-mile race will take place Thursday. As opposed to the Mar. 21 trial, which was won by Worldly Manner, there will be a small field, with only three or four horses taking part. It will mainly serve as a Derby prep for Aliabr (Storm) Cat), runner-up in the first trial. As for Worldly Manner, Crisford said that he is doing so well there is no need to give him another race before the "Run for the Roses." "He doesn't need it," Crisford said. "He's on top of his game at the moment and is in tremendous condition. We're very pleased with him." Gll Remsen S. winner Comeonomom, also withdrawn from the first trial, still has not caught up to his more advanced stablemates. "We're a little bit disappointed with him," Crisford said. "He's not working as well as we had hoped he would. We've decided not to push him, so, effectively, we're ruling him out of the Triple Crown."

Livermore--Lady of Choice (Storm Bird) selling as Hip #38; Rescue Ranger, a colt by Red Ransom--Spur Wing (Storm Bird) selling as Hip #128; Hip #142, a colt by Not For Love--Three Grand (Assert {Ire}); and Hip #202, a colt by Saint Ballado--Corporate Focus (Gilded Age). Three two-year-olds stopped the timer in :21 for a quarter. They were Hip #53, a colt by Mountain Cat--Lover's Hour (Bold Hour); Hip #115, a filly by Farma Way--Shivering Gal (It's Freezing); and Hip #216, a colt by Southern Halo--Desaucered (Dixieland Band). Wondertross was one of five Zito-trained Triple Crown nominees to work five furlongs Monday at Keeneland. "He went good, super, beautiful," Zito said of the GI Florida Derby runner-up. "He was well in hand. (Exercise rider) Jamie (Sanders) was just sitting there. I was happy with that." Zito also worked Apr. 18 GII Coolmore Lexington S. candidate Doneraile Court (Seattle Slew) in 1:02. GII Gallery Furniture.com S. winner Stephen Got Even (A.P. Indy) went in 1:00 4/5 and will train up to the May 1 Kentucky Derby. The Groom Is Red (Runaway Groom) (1:00 3/5) and Adonis (Kris S.) (1:00 3/5), both of whom are preparing for the Apr. 10 GII Wood Memorial, completed the Zito brigade. Adonis was equipped with blinkers for the work. "He went very nicely, very easily," Zito said. The ability to sire excellent fillies is one of the virtues of the Vice Regent branch of the Northern Dancer male line. Vice Regent's daughters featured Twice The Vice and Trumpet's Blare, as well as several Canadian champions, and Vice Regent's son Deputy Minister came up with Open Mind in his second crop and Go For Wand in his third. Open Mind and Go For Wand proved themselves the best of their sex both at two and three and it looks as though Deputy Minister's son Silver Deputy might also achieve this considerable feat through the splendid Silverbulletday.

Silverbulletday was a virtually unchallenged winner of the 1998 Eclipse Award for juvenile and it has been a similar story so far this year. Her seven-length Ashland S. victory improved her record to nine wins from 10 starts and her earnings now exceed \$1.75 million. This figure represents a remarkable contrast to the \$42,000 paid by the partnership of John B. Crook and Jeffry Morris for Rokeby Rose, carrying Silverbulletday in utero, at Fasig-Tipton's 1995 November Sales.

Even though Rokeby Rose was rising 19, she looked a potentially shrewd purchase because her previous mating with Silver Deputy had resulted in a colt which had sold for \$145,000 a few months earlier. Sure enough, Rokeby Rose's purchasers recouped her price several times over when her Silver Deputy filly was offered by Highclere at Fasig-Tipton's Selected Yearling Sale, realizing \$155,000.

Silverbulletday's exploits represent a fitting tribute to Paul Mellon, who died recently at the age of 91. As Rokeby Rose's name suggests, she was a product of Mellon's world-famous stud, which produced such stars as Mill Reef, Fort Marcy, Key to the Mint, Run The Gantlet, Quadrangle and Arts and Letters.

Arts and Letters became Horse of the Year back in 1969; despite being beaten by Majestic Prince in the Kentucky Derby and Preakness, he bounced back from those defeats to end his three-year-old campaign with a remarkable sequence of six wins over distances from one mile to two. Coincidentally, Arts and Letters was purchased in utero by Mellon when he paid \$175,000 for All Beautiful early in 1966. All Beautiful's attraction, apart from being in foal to the great Ribot, was that she was a winning daughter of Parlo, the champion three-year-old filly of 1954.

When Mellon sent All Beautiful to Quadrangle she produced the triple winner Rokeby Venus. It was a natural move to send Rokeby Venus to Tom Rolfe, one of Ribot's toughest sons, with Rokeby Rose the outcome. This close relative of Arts and Letters developed into a leading turf performer at four, notably winning the GII Flower Bowl H. over 1 1/4 miles. However, the fact that Rokeby Rose was sold by Mellon for only \$32,000 in 1992 tells its own story. She had failed to produce a stakes performer despite being mated to stallions of the calibre of Northern Dancer and Blushing Groom, but Silver Deputy has succeeded--at a fee of \$7,500--where those great stallions failed.

Silver Deputy's career consisted of two wins from two starts in the summer of his two-year-old season, before problems with one of his knees forced his retirement. Following in the footsteps of his great-grandsire Northern Dancer, he was moved south from his original base in Canada after his first juveniles did very well, his destination being Brookdale Farm in Kentucky.

Silver Deputy's first three Kentucky crops have thoroughly justified his move and Silverbulletday has helped fuel a rise in his fee from \$15,000 to \$40,000. It is going to be fascinating to see what Silver Deputy achieves with the better opportunities he is now receiving. It's going to be fascinating, too, to see which race Silverbulletday's connections choose for her. As a daughter of Rokeby Rose, she must have a chance of getting the Kentucky Derby trip, but the Kentucky Oaks and its nine furlongs looks to be a safer option.
