KRONE TO ANNOUNCE RETIREMENT Jockey Julie Krone will announce her retirement at a press conference today at Aqueduct, sources have told the Thoroughbred Daily News. Krone will likely ride for the last time Apr. 18 at Lone Star Park outside Dallas, Tx where she will be aboard Desert Demon for trainer Michael Stidham in the Lone Star Derby. Should Desert Demon graduate to any of the Triple Crown races, Krone will delay her retirement until after the three-race series is over. When reached yesterday, Krone would neither confirm nor deny that she was retiring, but hinted that the end is indeed near. "I couldn't be happier with the way I've been riding lately, but there's no doubt that I'm facing some tough decisions about my future." Krone said. "Mentally, I'm doing great, but, physically, all these years of riding and all the accidents have taken a toll on me." Despite missing the beginning of the meet while recovering from a broken knee, Krone is coming off a solid season at the Fair Grounds, where she won 76 races from 392 mounts. She became the only woman jockey to win a Triple Crown race after guiding Colonial Affair to victory in the 1993 Belmont S. and her 3,540 career victories easily make her the leading female rider of all time.

# **BROCCO COLT TOPS SECOND EASTER**

SESSION The second session of the three-day Inglis Easter Yearling Sale at the Newmarket sale complex in Sydney, Australia concluded last night on a strong average of AUS\$109,622 (\$68,262) for 86 sold and 20 passed in, bringing the sale's overall average to AUS\$121,653 (\$75,754), up 12.6 percent from last year. But expectations of high prices--as has been the case during the glamour night session in previous years--were not fulfilled. The top price on the night was a relatively modest AUS\$340,000 (\$211,719) for a Brocco colt out of Stormy Hill (Aus) (Danehill), who won a Group 2 event while racing in South Africa. Randwick trainer Graeme Rogerson was the most active buyer with seven lots, bringing his tally to 10 for more than AUS\$1.5 million (\$934,057). The sale is expected to gather momentum again today with several highly regarded yearlings yet to go under the hammer.
