DERBY PREPS: THE DAY AFTER A day after three major preps for the May 1 Kentucky Derby, the winners, and some of the losers, had roses on their minds. "I told everybody that I heard there was a \$500,000 maiden race at Oaklawn," said trainer Dallas Keen whose Valhol (Diazo) earned the first win of his threerace career in Saturday's GII Arkansas Derby. "Now, I can tell them I'm going to run in a \$1 million race at Churchill Downs for non-winners of two on May 1." Still possible for the Kentucky Derby are Arkansas alsorans Certain (Out of Place) (second) and last year's juvenile champion Answer Lively (Lively One) (fifth). Answer Lively displaced his palate in the race, according to trainer Bobby Barnett. "Everything looks real good this morning," Barnett said. "We'll go to Kentucky. When we get to training up there, we'll make a decision." The morning after trainer Elliott Walden's lightly raced colt Menifee (Harlan) won the day's premier Derby prep, the GI Toyota Blue Grass, the colt was bright-eyed and gobbling up carrots. "He's doing great," Walden said. "It looks like he came out of it in good shape and everything is great." Menifee will likely ship to Churchill Downs today. "It was a great feeling (winning the Blue Grass), but now it's time to get ready for the Derby," Walden added. Other Blue Grass runners expected to vie for the roses include, Cat Thief (Storm Cat) (second), Vicar (Wild Again) (third), Kimberlite Pipe (Take Me Out) (fourth) and Lemon Drop Kid (Kingmambo) (fifth). Wondertross (Chief's Crown), sixth as the beaten favorite at Keeneland, was taken to Hagyard-Davidson-McGee equine hospital Sunday morning for evaluation of possible colic. The colt's Derby status depends on how quickly he can be returned to trainer Nick Zito's barn. Adonis (Kris S.), winner of Saturday's GII Wood Memorial at Aqueduct, came out of the race in fine shape. "He's looking great, he doesn't look tired at all," said Zito assistant Drew MacMillan. "He ate all his night feed and it doesn't look like the race was a huge exertion for him." Trainer Joe Aquilino wouldn't rule out a Derby trip for Wood fourthplace finisher Badge (Air Forbes Won) while John Shirreffs' assistant Gary Benson said the Derby was the next likely start for third-place finisher Cliquot (Bertrando). Wood runner-up Best of Luck (Broad Brush) will aim for the May 23 GII Peter Pan. In other Derby developments, Chris McCarron will ride the Zito-trained GII Gallery Furniture.com S. winner Stephen Got Even (A.P. Indy).

Good and Tough, second in last year's GIII Swale S., raced second in the GIII Hallandale H. and third in the GII Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup Sprint Championship H., before earning his first win of the year in the Mar. 12 Deputy Minister H. in his last start. The colt settled just behind the early pacesetters, moved up along the rail in the stretch and finished as much the best under a hand ride. "When we hit the turn, I had to make a choice," commented winning jockey Shane Sellers, "I looked up and saw that Craig (Perret on Crucible) had a lot of horse left and I knew if I went then I would have a dogfight on my hands for the three-eighths of a mile. So, I just decided to sit back and wait. Fortunately, the hole opened up just right for me down on the fence and I was able to get through."

Classic Cat, winner of last year's GII Lexington S. and GII Ohio Derby and third in the Preakness, returned from a six-month layoff to win the Mar. 12 Tokyo City Cup H. for new trainer Bob Baffert. The prohibitive favorite against just three rivals, the colt began vying for the lead while three wide down the backstretch, took a short advantage turning for home and kicked clear under a hand ride. "He was just kind of loafing along early," explained winning rider Gary Stevens. "I probably could have let him drop back a little more, but I didn't want Budroyale to get away from me and make my horse do too much. He just stayed real steady all the way and galloped our nice after the race." Baffert added, "He's only going to get better and distance is not a problem for him. He's nice to have, especially with Silver Charm on the shelf for a little bit."

Spadoun, whom Slickly had beaten in his winning debut at Deauville in Aug. and who subsequently won the G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud, went straight to the front from the stalls and was several lengths clear after a half-mile, extending this lead to more than 10 lengths at one stage, with Slickly travelling easily in second. Spadoun's lead was reduced to a couple of lengths by the final turn and with 500 metres to run Slickly came alongside, easily taking the lead and racing home clear of State Shinto, who came out of the pack to finish well for second spot without in any way challenging the winner. Owner-breeder Jean-Luc Lagardere's racing manager Roland de Longevialle, said, "Slickly had proved to us at home that he was able to play with the best. He is not entered for the Epsom Derby and the French Derby is his main target. He may run again, either in the (G2) Prix Hocquart at Chantilly May 9 or in the (G1) Prix Lupin here on May 16."

Blue Grass Highlights Record Day at Keeneland:

Keeneland set six records for pari-mutuel handle on Toyota Blue Grass Saturday. The \$12,729,595 was the all-time highest single-day mutuel handle record, besting the \$11,071,353 wagered on live and simulcast racing on Breeders' Cup Day 1996. The on-track handle, \$3,046,816, was also a record figure, surpassing the \$2,813,224 bet on Blue Grass Day 1992. The Blue Grass win-place-show handle and exacta pool from all sources were also records, as were the trifecta and superfecta pools from all sources. Nationally, Keeneland was part of a record Big Three Pick Three wager, which included the Blue Grass, the Wood Memorial from Agueduct and the Arkansas Derby from Oaklawn. The wager had a total handle of \$1,042,447, surpassing the previous record of \$824,912 set in 1997. Saturday's attendance at Keeneland was 25,325--seventh highest in Blue Grass Day history.

Lexington S. Works:


