MYSTERY STORM FILLY POSTS FASTEST OBS

WORK No Mystery, a filly from the first crop of Mystery Storm out of Vagabunda (Salutely) stopped the clock in :34 to post the fastest three-furlong work during the third day of the Under Tack Show for Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's Annual Spring Sale of Two-Year-Olds in Training. The filly, from the consignment of Desmond Castle Farm, agent, will sell Wednesday as Hip No. 685. A filly by Kipper Kelly--Striking Belle (Strike the Anvil) put in the fastest eighth of a mile, getting the distance in :10 2/5. Consigned by Woodside Ranch, she will sell as hip number 598. Four juveniles shared top honors at two furlongs, working in :22. They were hip number 648, a filly by Silver Ghost--Time For Honor (Blue Sword); hip number 723, a colt by Rizzi--Wyndham Green (Irish Tower); hip number 778, a filly by Rizzi--Appealing Ms Sword (Crusader Sword); and hip number 845, a colt by Peteski out of the stakes winning mare Breech (Relaunch). The final session of the Under Tack Show begins today at 9:00 a.m.

AARON AND MARIE JONES NAMED TOBA

"OWNERS OF THE MONTH" Aaron and Marie Jones have been honored as the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association's "Owners of the Month" for March after seeing a pair of their three-year-olds win stakes. Prime Timber (Sultry Song), one of the favorites for this year's Kentucky Derby, took the Mar. 13 GII San Felipe S. and went on to be second in the GI Santa Anita Derby Apr. 3. Forestry (Storm Cat) captured the Mar. 28 San Pedro S. The Joneses raced, owned or bred more than 50 stakes winners in the 1980s including Lemhi Gold, champion older male of 1983, and Tiffany Lass, champion three-year-old filly of '86. They left the business for several years as Aaron Jones fought a successful battle against cancer, but have been back in action for two years and now have almost two dozen broodmares and are the majority owners of the stallion Saint Ballado. "This time around, we're just going to enjoy ourselves," said Mr. Jones.

Squeak (GB) (Selkirk) picked up a pair of Grade I victories last year, both at the Santa Barbara distance. The five-year-old took the GI Beverly Hills H. in July and ended the year with a six-length decision in the GI Matriarch; she is three-for-five lifetime at 1 1/4 miles, but has yet to hit the board in two previous Santa Anita starts. **Virginie (Brz)** (Legal Case {Ire}) has yet to be beaten, taking seven straight in her native Brazil before shipping to the States and fighting her way through heavy traffic to post a neck victory in a Mar. 13 Santa Anita allowance. She has won three times at this distance, including the G1 Brazilian Oaks. **See You Soon (Fr)** (Kaldoun {Fr}) is two-for-two on the year with wins in the Jan. 16 GII San Gorgonio H. and Mar. 20 GII Santa Ana H., but is 0-for-six at this route.

GII Hialeah Turf Cup:

Federal Trial (Skip Trial), first or second in seven of his eight career starts, has been perfect in his last three. He ended 1998 with a decisive Churchill allowance score Nov. 26, then came back to take the Jan. 23 GIII Canadian Turf H. and a Feb. 26 Gulfstream allowance and looks to continue the streak after a short break. Morning-line favorite **Panama City** (El Gran Senor) started the season with a decisive victory in the Jan. 10 GIII Mac Diarmida H., the finished third in his latest, the Mar. 6 GII Pan American H., both at Gulfstream. The speedy **Sharp Appeal** (World Appeal) has been held winless in his five starts since returning from an 8 1/2-month absence in December. His last win came in the '98 Bougainvillea H. over this course; he was third in this year's edition last out Mar. 28.

Confessional (Holy Bull) cruised to a 10 1/2-length romp in the GI Frizette last year, but failed to fire in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies and finished ninth. She came back running in her three-year-old bow, leading gate-to-wire to take a Mar. 10 Gulfstream allowance by daylight, and makes her second start of the campaign here. **Appealing Phylly** (West by West) ended her juvenile season with an easy win in the seven-furlong GIC Glorious Song S. at Woodbine, then came back after more than three months off to be second in the six-furlong Jeano S. at Gulfstream Feb. 24. She pressed the pace and tired to be fourth in her latest, the Mar. 29 OBS Championship S. at a mile and a sixteenth, but drops back to a sprint and has worked sharply at Keeneland. **Golden Temper** (Forty Niner), never worse than second in five starts, ran into buzz saw Three Ring in her most recent outing and finishing second, beaten 14 3/4 lengths in the Feb. 21 GII Davona Dale S. at Gulfstream.

Riverboat Legislation Could Prompt Arlington Reopening:

A proposal making its way through the Illinois State Capitol that could offer tax relief for racetracks has officials at Arlington International Racecourse in Chicago optimistic that they could reopen in 2000, the *Blood-Horse* online reported yesterday. The track was dark in 1998 and will not race this year. The legislation would move an idle riverboat casino license to northern Cook County and use a part of the proceeds for race-track tax relief. Arlington owner Richard L. Duchossois is reportedly optimistic that the legislation will pass, and Arlington will apply for dates next year if it does.

Palace Revolt Dies in Foaling:

Palace Revolt (Fast Gold), a two-time stakes winner of \$170,178, died after foaling a colt by Quiet American Apr. 7. Owned by Roy Jackson's Lael Stable of Unionville, Pennsylvania, the 11-year-old mare was boarded at Sanborn-Chase in Nicholasville, Kentucky at the time of her death. The colt was reported to be doing well.
