Taylor Made has purchased an interest in the three-year-old who will stand as the property of a partner-ship. No stud fee has been set. Exploit won the GIII Iroquois S. and the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. at two and began his three-year-old campaign with a win in the GII San Vicente. He suffered the lone defeat of his career in his last start, finishing second in the GII San Felipe S. Under the colors of Bob and Beverly Lewis, Exploit won five of six starts and earned \$396,254.

Derby Favorites Work:

GI Santa Anita Derby winner General Challenge (General Meeting) and stablemate and Santa Anita Derby runner-up Prime Timber (Sultry Song) had their first works over the Churchill Downs track yesterday. General Challenge worked five furlongs in 1:00 1/5 and galloped out six furlongs in 1:12 1/5 over a fast track. "He's amazing," said exercise rider Dana Barnes. "Sometimes when (trainer) Bob (Baffert) gives me the fractions (over the radio) and I think, 'There's no way, he's not going that fast, I don't believe you.' I look around to see if he's watching the wrong horse or something."

Prime Timber went five furlongs in 1:00 3/5 in company and galloped out in 1:13 2/5. "He has really improved," Barnes commented after the move. "He's grown up so much. Before, he would hang with a horse and today, he just opened up on that horse."

Desert Hero (Sea Hero), who completed the Santa Anita Derby trifecta, worked seven furlongs in a bullet 1:23 4/5 at Santa Anita. "He won," trainer Richard Mandella said of his charge's in-company work. "This was a good tightner for him."

Tranquility Lake has alway been a consistent sort, off the board only twice in her 10-race career to date, and never off the board on the grass, where she brought a 6-2-2-2 record into this event. A pace-pressing second (placed third), beaten only 1/2 length in the GI Del Mar Oaks last summer, the bay returned to the turf to take an optional claimer in her most recent start Mar. 7 by an easy five lengths, that on the heels of a fourth-place finish in the GI La Cañada S. on the main track. La Madame (Chi) (Mocito Fogoso {Chi}) looked to be the main speed in the field, but she did not break well, allowing Eddie Delahoussaye a five-length lead aboard Tranquility Lake after six furlongs in a very moderate 1:12.89. As the field rounded into the stretch, all Eddie D. had to do was stay on his filly as she extended her lead and proved much the best under a hand ride. Virginie, making only her second start in the U.S. closed from the back of the pack to gain the place. Was Delahoussaye surprised to find himself on such a lonely lead? "I thought she'd [La Madame] be out there, but once she wasn't and she wasn't near me, I said 'Hey, we're on our way.' When she switched leads and kicked on, I thought it would really take something to out run her," said the winning rider. Trainer Julio Canani gave no immediate indication of where his filly would next start.

Whereas another recently retired horse by Skip Trial and out of a Diplomat Way mare made a name for himself on the main track, Federal Trial is fast becoming one of the rising turf stars in America. Never off the board in five previous turf starts, Federal Trial made everyone sit up and take notice with his victory at 20-1 in the GIII Canadian Turf H. at Gulfstream Park Jan. 23 and followed that effort with a front-running allowance triumph Feb. 26. Federal Trial broke alertly and assumed a stalking position just off front-running Auroral (Cormorant, sixth) through the opening six furlongs. As the field left the far turn, jockey Robbie Davis aboard the Goldfine-trainee went after and easily disposed of Auroral, held a one-length advantage over local favorite and rallying Sharp Appeal at the furlong grounds and was able to hold that one at bay for his second graded stakes victory.

Swingin On Ice, carefully managed in her threeyear-old campaign, was a one-length winner in her lifetime bow at her winter base in New Orleans, and proved that the victory was no fluke, as she came back to take a "non-winners of one other than" allowance by four lengths in front-running fashion Mar. 22, both of those efforts at six furlongs. A pair of breezes since her arrival in Lexington showed that the filly had adapted well to her new surroundings, a bullet four furlongs in :47 Apr. 13 had her on her toes. On a crisp afternoon in the Bluegrass, Secret Hills showed the way from the gate, as Swingin On Ice had a "slippery" start, stumbling and bumping with Appealing Phylly, before getting into stride. Robby Albarado, riding Swingin On Ice for the first time, guided the sophomore off the rail at the threeeighths pole, advanced five wide and was able to run down Secret Hills with 100 yards to run and came home impressively to win in stakes-record time. Albarado was impressed with the performance. "I don't want to take anything away from the horses that were in front of me, but I felt I could take them anytime I wanted," said Albarado. "When I called on her, she just exploded," he added. GI Frizette winner Confessional (Holy Bull), the 7-10 favorite, pressed the early pace, but faded badly to finish sixth, beaten over nine lengths.
