VALHOL CONNECTIONS PLAN TO FILE SUIT With the Arkansas Racing Commission delaying the

Valhol (Diazo) hearing until May 5, which is four days after the Kentucky Derby, owner James Jackson and trainer Dallas Keen are prepared to file suit in order to get their disputed GII Arkansas Derby winner into the field. The hearing to investigate whether or not jockey Billy Patin carried an illegal electrical device in the Arkansas Derby was delayed at the request of Patin's attorney. Meanwhile, Jackson made it all but official yesterday that Patin has been dropped from the team. With no resolution coming out of Arkansas before the Kentucky Derby, Jackson's attorneys are expected to file suit tomorrow to force Churchill Downs to recognize the \$300,000 in purse money from the Arkansas Derby, which the colt may need to get into the field. Attorneys for Keen and Jackson will contend that there is no stipulation in Arkansas racing regulations for withholding payment of a purse unless a drug positive is involved. As for Patin, he galloped Valhol yesterday at Churchill Downs, but might not be seen there for a while. "I doubt very seriously Bill Patin will ride," Jackson said. "Mr. Patin left (Louisville) and went back to Louisiana. I guess he's not planning on coming back." In still another twist to this strange case, Keen went on the offensive yesterday and his target was Oaklawn Jockey Club President Charles Cella. "I think (the investigation) is something personal with Cella," he said. "From what I've heard, Mr. Cella lost the grading on some of his races. The Arkansas Derby is down to a Grade II. He feels threatened that a maiden came in and won his race. This isn't a normal maiden, though."

Churchill Worktab:

Preparing for an attempt to become the first Champion Two-Year-Old to win the Derby since Spectacular Bid, Answer Lively (Lively One) drilled five furlongs yesterday in 1:01 2/5 under jockey Craig Perret. Perret, who will have the mount in the Derby as well, said, "He worked real good and got over the surface well. It was more of a maintenance work. He moved fine. Now it will be up to him when the bell rings."

The Thoroughbred Corp.'s Desert Hero (Sea Hero) went six furlongs in 1:14. "It was a good move," said trainer Richard Mandella. "I don't know if I'll do anything else with him coming up to the race. I'll just play it by ear."

After a highly consistent but somewhat frustrating season last year when runner-up in the G1 Prix Jean Prat, G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp and G2 Prix du Rond-Point, Gold Away began this season with a comfortable win in the G3 Prix Exbury here Mar. 13. Assisted from the front by pacesetting stable companion Special Discount (Nureyev), the colt raced in second until well into the straight, quickened well at the 400meter point and was soon clear. He won eased down from Lone Bid, who finished well, but without being any danger. Winning trainer Criquette Head said, "This is a tough, consistent horse with a powerful physique. He had a hard season last year and did very well. He's also a very genuine, hard-working horse and he pleased me very much today. We may send him to England now for the G1 Juddmonte Lockinge S. over a mile at Newbury May 15, although he may stay here in France for the G1 Prix D'Ispahan at Longchamp May 23. But that's over a longer trip and he's really a miler, as he's proved again today."

GIII Rebel S. winner Etbaur (Silver Deputy), in a move that jockey Francisco Torres called "awesome," went six furlongs in 1:14 2/5. "It was just what I wanted," commented trainer Steve Wren. "He finished strong. I just wanted to put some gas in him."

Although it's looking more and more like she will bypass the Derby in favor of Friday's Kentucky Oaks, Silverbulletday (Silver Deputy) looked like she could handle the boys when she worked an impressive six furlongs in 1:12 2/5.

GIII Louisiana Derby winner Kimberlite Pipe (Take Me Out) zipped five panels in 1:00 under exercise rider Diane Powlin. "He worked awesome," said trainer Dallas Stewart. "It was a nice, solid move, and that is what we're looking for. It's a good move over this surface."

GII Gallery Furniture.com S. winner Stephen Got Even (A.P. Indy) drilled five furlongs in company in 1:02 2/5. "I was impressed," said jockey Chris McCarron, who will have the Derby mount. "Obviously we weren't looking for fast today. This was a get-acquainted move."

Barry K. Schwartz's Three Ring (Notebook), the only filly who is a definite starter, worked five furlongs in 1:01 2/5. Wearing blinkers, the filly went in splits of :24 and :49. "She handled the track well and I couldn't be more pleased with the way she's coming up to the race. I wanted to come here with a fresh horse, not one all beaten up. I wouldn't trade her for any horse in the race," said trainer Ed Plesa.

For the first time in recent memory, there is only one English-trained runner challenging the locals for Italy's second Classic of the season, despite their good record in the race. The race itself looks a wideopen affair, as the home-trained contingent doesn't appear to have a star in their midst. Peter Chapple-Hyam transports World Alert, still a maiden after three starts but a promising second in a conditions event at Newmarket Apr. 13. The probable favorite will be Strawberry Fields, ridden by Frankie Dettori. winner of the Listed Premio Rumon at Rome Oct. 4 and the G2 Premio Guido Berardelli at the same course Nov. 15. After a disappointing seasonal reappearance, he won the Listed Premio Daumier, a traditional Parioli trial, at Rome April 11. He needs to have soft or heavy going to be seen at his best. Tendor, winner of the Listed Criterium Partenopeo and third behind Strawberry Fields in the Premio Rumon, was a fast-closing third in the Premio Daumier on heavy going, but has shown all his best form on good going. With the going currently described as good, he would have a chance of reversing the form with Strawberry Fields. Timboroa, a dual-course winner, is held in high regard by his trainer Roberto Brogi. Luigi Camici, trainer of the second and fourth finishers in last week's fillies' equivalent, saddles Max Ruocco and Ugolino Di Nerio; the latter, who also has a liking for good ground, would seem to be the stable's number one choice.



Favored Glamis, wearing blinkers for the first time, was settled at the back of the field and was easily held by the first two. Sheikh Maktoum's Racing Manager Joe Mercer said, "A photographer took a shot at the first winning post and Darryl Holland said that Fantastic Light simply stopped. Fortunately he won, though, and I think he could be a very useful mile- and-a-quarter horse. We weren't too confident beforehand, but I knew that the soft ground would suit him. He is not entered in the Vodafone Derby and will not be entered, because he will not get a mile and a half."
