Godolphin Duo Work:

Team Godolphin's two Kentucky Derby contenders both worked seven furlongs yesterday at Churchill Downs. Worldly Manner (Riverman) covered the distance in 1:29 4/5. Clockers caught the colt's first quarter in :28 2/5, the half in :54 and out a mile in 1:43 4/5. Jockey Jerry Bailey was aboard for the work. "I thought it was a good work," commented assistant trainer Tom Albertrani. "He started off a bit steady and picked it up well and finished up strong." Stablemate Aljabr (Storm Cat), working in company and with exercise rider Brian Procter up, went the seven furlongs in 1:31. Fractional times were: quarter in :28 2/5, 1:04 3/5 for five-eighths and 1:18 4/5 for six furlongs. No rider has been named on Aljabr, but if Excellent Meeting (General Meeting) runs in Friday's Kentucky Oaks, Kent Desormeaux will likely have the Derby mount on Aljabr.

Menifee Drills:

GI Toyota Blue Grass S. winner Menifee (Harlan) worked five furlongs in 1:00 yesterday at Churchill. "He had running on his mind, which is what you like to see coming into a big race like this," said trainer Elliott Walden after the move.

Derby or Oaks Hopeful Excellent Meeting Works:

Excellent Meeting (General Meeting), who is still possible for the Kentucky Oaks or the Derby, breezed five furlongs yesterday at Churchill:59 1/5. "I liked her work," said trainer Bob Baffert. "I think both fillies (Excellent Meeting and Silverbulletday {Silver Deputy}) will run in the Oaks. But we may cross enter Excellent Meeting in the Derby. Both of them have been so impressive in their works here. The key here at Churchill Downs is the turns and both fillies smoke around the turns. It's more difficult for a big, long-striding horse like General Challenge (General Meeting)."

Tuzla had won five of her last six outings coming into this race, including a pair of Grade II events, the Dahlia H. at Hollywood Park Dec. 13 and Santa Anita's Buena Vista H. at this trip as the overwhelming choice Feb. 27. Tuzla was taken back to run in eighth position for the opening half mile of this effort, some six or seven lengths from pacesetting Commitisize (Explodent). With only three rivals beaten with two furlongs to run, jockey Brice Blanc sent Tuzla into action with a five-wide move, overtook Rob 'n Gin inside the eighth pole and had just enough left to hold off the late charge of Poteen for the victory. "She's a very easy horse to ride," jockey Brice Blanc said of the winner. "I felt like I only had to point her in the right direction. She relaxed nicely and when I asked her to pick it up, she took off and gave me everything she had. I am not that special and I had to do nothing great. I just had the right horse today." About the decision to run Tuzla against the boys, trainer Julio Canani added, "I don't mind facing the boys because I know they're going to give her wight. The Breeders' Cup Mile is a strong consideration. Her best distance is eight furlongs on the grass." Canani said Tuzla will likely aim for the June 6 GI Gamely H. at nine furlongs over the Hollywood

Victory Stripes won a Group 1 event in her native Argentina in only her third lifetime start, and has tasted success in this country in restricted and other non-graded events, including her last start, a pacepressing, 7 1/2-length decision against overmatched foes in the Santa Lucia H. Mar. 18 at Santa Anita. Magical Allure, most recently second in the GI Santa Margarita, looked to be the speed of the speed, but it was the Argentine-bred just to her inside who showed first from the gate and took the field through a very comfortable :47 2/5 half mile, with Magical Allure positioned just off her flank in second. Leaving the five-sixteenths pole, Magical Allure actually stuck a head in front and maintained a narrow advantage to the eighth pole, but Victory Stripes dug in and gradually wore down her rival for the victory, her first in North American graded-stakes company. Winning rider Chris McCarron, recording his third straight victory in the Hawthorne, said, "My mare was very, very quick away (from the gate) today. She's always possessed good speed, but for a period there we were trying to rate her and she may prefer this style more." The 1998 Kentucky Oaks winner Keeper Hill (Deputy Minister), making her first start since coming home third in the Breeders' Cup Distaff, trailed throughout in a disappointing performance. Said rider David Flores, "She never picked up the bridle and she felt different today. She just never gave an intention to run."

Remaining unbeaten after three starts, Montjeu confirmed the promise of his two-year-old form with a highly encouraging seasonal debut. A winner on his debut at Chantilly Sept. 18, Montjeu then won the Listed Prix Isonomy at Longchamp Oct. 18 and now has a choice of targets, the Prix du Jockey Club (French Derby) at Chantilly June 6, or the Epsom Derby June 5, for which he was a recent £8,000 (\$4,340) entry. Spadoun (Kaldoun (Fr)) raced to a clear six-length lead from the outset with Montjeu, ridden patiently, at the rear. Hitting the two-furlong marker, Sendawar quickened into the lead but, almost immediately, Montjeu appeared on the outside going ominously well, quickened inside the final furlong and ran on strongly to win by a comfortable length. "I can say that I am spoiled to have such a horse in training," said winning conditioner John Hammond. "We will make a decision in time regarding the Epsom Derby, but only after having talks with his owner, Mr. Tabor. If he is to have one more run between now and Epsom or Chantilly, if we go for the French Derby, it will probably be in the (G1) Prix Lupin at Longchamp (May 16)."

The win not only secured Horse Chestnut the Triple Crown for threeyear-olds, but also earned a R1 million bonus for owners Harry and Bridget Oppenheimer, With Weichong Mawing in the irons, Horse Chestnut came into the half-mile straight some five lengths off the leaders, but quickened in brilliant style to grab the lead with a quarter mile to race and strolled away to win eased down at the line.
