**LUKAS HEADS HALL INDUCTEES** Trainer D. Wayne Lukas, a dominant force in Thoroughbred racing for the past two decades, has been elected into the National Thoroughbred Racing Hall of Fame. Lukas was joined by jockey Russell Baze and Thoroughbreds Exceller, Miesque and Gun Bow in the '99 elections announced yesterday by National Museum of Racing and Hall of Fame President John T. Von Stade. The electees will be inducted in a public ceremony in Saratoga Springs, NY on Aug. 9. Through 1998, Lukas had won 513 graded stakes. That figure represents seven percent of all graded stakes run in North America during the last two decades. Lukas has trained 19 Eclipse champions, a record 13 Breeders' Cup winners, and 10 winners of Triple Crown races. He led all trainers in annual earnings in 14 of the last 17 seasons and in 1988 set a one-year record of \$17.8 million. "Nobody gets into the Hall of Fame by themselves," Lukas commented yesterday. "I have great clients who had faith in me and let me buy some of the best horses in the world. And I have had the privilege of working with some of the finest young men the sport has known. There are six alumni of my organization out there on their own, all are doing well and two (Dallas Stewart and Bobby Barnett) will lead horses over here to run against me in the Kentucky Derby." Lukas hopes his stable reaches the \$200 million earnings plateau in the next month. "That's a milestone that I believe is quite significant. Only one other man, the late, great Charlie Whittingham, has even hit \$100 million," Lukas said. Baze rode at least 400 winners for the seventh consecutive year in 1998. No other American rider has achieved that mark more than three times. For four consecutive years, he earned the Isaac Murphy Award for the rider with the nation's highest win percentage. Exceller was voted into the Hall of Fame in the Contemporary Male category. The Nelson Bunker Hunt colorbearer became the first horse to conquer two Triple Crown winners when he closed from 22 lengths back to defeat Seattle Slew and Affirmed in the 1978 GI Jockey Club Gold Cup. Miesque, elected in the Contemporary Female category, raced just twice in the U.S. and was named the country's top turf mare in 1987 and 1988 with back-to-back wins in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile. Handicap star Gun Bow, elected in the Horse of Yesteryear division, defeated five-time Horse of the Year Kelso twice in 1964 and captured the 1965 GI Metropolitan Mile.

### Valhol Cleared for Derby Run:

An Arkansas judge has cleared the way for Valhol (Diaz) to run in Saturday's Kentucky Derby, ordering the Arkansas Racing Commission to pay the disputed \$300,000 winner's share of the GI Arkansas Derby to owner James Jackson. The earnings had been withheld following allegations that jockey Billy Patin had carried an electrical device during the race. "Obviously we don't agree with the decision, but we are prepared to comply," said Oaklawn spokesman Terry Wallace. "It still has nothing to do with guilt or innocence, we're waiting on the stewards' hearing for that."

### Derby Drills:

The Bob Baffert pair of General Challenge (General Meeting) and Prime Timber (Sultry Song) both worked five furlongs yesterday. Santa Anita Derby winner General Challenge covered the distance in 1:00. The gelding went the first quarter in :23 3/5, the half mile in :48 1/5 and the final eighth in :11 4/5. Prime Timber, working in company, went a quarter in :24 4/5, :48 3/5 for the half mile and the final furlong in :12 to finish in 1:00 3/5. He was timed galloping out six furlongs in 1:13 2/5. "General Challenge was just cruising--he went around there so easy," Baffert commented after the works. "Prime Timber, he's different than General Challenge. We started him a little slower today, but he finished up strong. They're ready. I'm just going to lead them over there Saturday and all we need is a little luck."

GI Florida Derby winner Vicar (Wild Again) worked a bullet five furlongs yesterday in :59 4/5. "I got his last quarter in :23 and 4/5 and galloping out in 1:13 and 2/5," said trainer Carl Nafzger. "We were ready for a good work, he needed a good work and he should hit the feed tub good tonight. He's blowing good and pulled up good, and that's what we're looking for."

Adonis (Kris S.) drilled five furlongs over a sloppy Churchill track in 1:02 2/5. "I'm glad that's over," said trainer Nick Zito. "It's always scary working over an off track. Adonis went over it nice and I'm happy."

Valhol (Diazo) breezed a half mile in :48 1/5 with jockey Willie Martinez in the irons. The gelding galloped out five furlongs in 1:01. Martinez will likely have the Derby mount.

**Certain Out of Derby:**

"If everything were right, we'd probably be running. But everything isn't, and so we're not," trainer Leo Azpurura, Jr. explained after officially withdrawing **Certain** (Out of Place) from the Kentucky Derby picture. "I've been playing catch-up with this horse and it's not right--not right for the horse and not right coming up to a race of this magnitude." Azpurura said his colt may start next in the May 8 GII Illinois Derby.

**WEEKEND PEDIGREE PERSPECTIVES**

It is nearly a decade since the year of "Woodmania," which resulted from the appearance of Champions Hector Protector, Hansel and Mujtahid in Woodman's first crop. Since then--like most stallions who fight their way up from a relatively low fee--Woodman's career has been somewhat up and down. Towards the end of last year, however, there were signs that another purple patch might be on its way and over the weekend Woodman was represented by no less than four stakes winners. At Churchill Downs Saturday, **Patience Game (c, 3, Woodman--Starboard Tack, by Seattle Slew)** showed that he could soon take a position among the leading three-year-olds with an impressive victory in the Gill Derby Trial S. At The Curragh, **Major Force (c, 3, Woodman--Ready For Action, by Riverman)** captured the G3 Desert King EBF Tetrarch S., while **Campo Catino (c, 4, Woodman--Karri Valley, by Storm Bird)** won the Listed Mooresbridge S. And in Japan, **Raise Suzarun (h, 5, Woodman--Sintanous, by Danzig)** took the Oasis S., a Listed event at Tokyo.

Woodman is out of a mare inbred to genetic relatives from the La Troienne family--his dam, Playmate, having the three-parts sisters Busanda and Striking 2 x 3--and La Troienne would appear to have played a major part in Woodman's two weekend pattern race scorers.

Patience Game follows Japanese Champion Sprinter Hishi Akebono as the second stakes winner by Woodman out of a Seattle Slew mare. Seattle Slew is out of a mare inbred to sisters (Busher and Striking) from the La Troienne family, and the cross of Woodman over a Seattle Slew mare gives La Troienne's great granddaughter, Glamour, 4x5 and Busanda and her three-parts sisters Busher and Striking 4x5x6x6.

Major Force is also bred on a cross which has previously worked well for Woodman, as he is out of a mare by Riverman, also broodmare sire of Woodman's Champions Hector Protector and Bosra Sham as well as his stakes winner Magic of Sunrise. Woodman's son Hansel sired Group 1 winning filly Loving Claim out of a mare by Riverman's son, Irish River (Fr), and the cross of Woodman with a mare by Mill Reef (who, like Riverman, is a son of Never Bend) came up with Champion English Two-Year-Old Mujtahid, so it certainly seems as if Woodman and Never Bend have an affinity. Perhaps the key is that Never Bend brings in La Troienne's son Bimelech. In fact, Never Bend's granddam Be Faithful is by Bimelech out of a Blue Larkspur mare, and so bred on a reverse cross to Busanda's dam Businesslike, who is by Blue Larkspur out of a half-sister to Bimelech.

There are few combinations which hit the mark as consistently as the one between Nijinsky II and Red God (the dam's of Nijinsky II and Red Gold both have Menow combined with Bull Dog), and the pairing was represented by a pair of group winners at Sandown Park on Saturday when **Fantastic Light** (c, 3, Rahy--Jood, by Nijinsky II) took the G3 Thresher Classic Trial and **Generous Rosi** (c, 4, Generous {Ire}--Come On Rosi {GB}, by Valiyar {Ire}) won the G3 Marriott Hotels Gorden Richards S.

Although Rahy has a reputation as a "filly sire," it is worth noting that **Fantastic Light** is the fourth stakes winning colt or gelding (three group or graded) to be bred on a Rahy/Nijinsky II cross. **Fantastic Light** is also bred on very similar lines to that excellent international campaigner Swain (Ire) (Nashwan), as both are by sons of **Blushing Groom** and Swain's dam **Love Smitten** is a sister to **Fantastic Light's** second dam **Kamar**.

**Generous Rosi** also has an interesting pedigree. In addition to being the product of a Nijinsky II/Red God cross, his second dam **Victory Kingdom** is by a son of **Northern Dancer** out of a mare by a son of **Bull Page**, and therefore bred along very similar lines to Nijinsky II, who was by **Northern Dancer** out of a **Bull Page** mare.

Another cross which works well with Nijinsky II is the combination with **Tom Fool** (another Menow/Bull Dog horse). The Nijinsky II/Tom Fool combination is found in the G3 Prix de Fontainebleu victor **Indian Danehill** (c, 3, **Danehill--Danse Indienne**, by **Green Dancer**) as **Danehill's** second dam is by the **Tom Fool** stallion, **Buckpasser**. A brother to the highly-promising but ill-fated **Indian Jones**, **Indian Danehill** is the fourth group or graded winner by **Danehill** out of a Nijinsky II line mare. The mating also gives inbreeding to **Northern Dancer**, something which seems to work well for **Danehill**, almost certainly because his granddam is a half-sister to **Northern Dancer**.

The other variation of the theme--**Tom Fool** and **Red God**--combine in the pedigree of the G3 Peter Sandrovitch Leicestershire S. victor **Warningford** (h, 5, **Warning {GB}--Barford Lady {GB}**, by **Stanford {Ire}**). **Warningford** is almost a complete outcross, but does have the three-quarters related **Tom Fool/Spring Run** 5 x 4 (**Spring Run** being the dam of **Red God**).

Winner of the valuable **Lady Angela S.** at **Woodbine** was the closely inbred **Millashand** (f, 3, **Regal Intention--Soiled Dove**, by **Bold Ruckus**). **Millashand** has **Vice Regent** 2 x 4 (**Vice Regent** is sire of **Regal Intention** and also of **Millashand's** third dam) and also has a daughter of **Vice Regent's** grandsire, **Nearctic**.

The **Goldfinch S.** winner **Kyle's Lady** (f, 3, **Kyle's Our Man--Brilliantly**, by **Rich Cream**) has a play on a very successful pattern--inbreeding and linebreeding to the **Hyperion/Beau Pere** nick. **Kyle's Our Man** is out of a mare by **Graustark**, a horse whose dam, **Flower Bowl**, was by **Alibhai** out of a **Beau Pere** mare. **Kyle's Lady's** granddam is by **Your Alibhai**, another **Alibhai/Beau Pere** cross, giving **Kyle's Lady** the three-quarters genetic relatives 4 x 3.

**Gold Away** (c, 4, **Goldneyev--Blushing Away** by **Blushing Groom {Fr}**) is turning into a very smart miler and is decisive victory in the G2 **Prix du Muguet** was his second pattern win in two starts this year. **Gold Away** is the product of a rather clever mating as he has the close genetic relatives **Tudor Gleam** (fourth dam of **Goldneyev**) and **Aimee** (granddam of **Blushing Groom**) 5 x 4.
