POST DERBY WRAP-UP Trainer D. Wayne Lukas reported yesterday that his Kentucky Derby winner Charismatic (Summer Squall) and third-place finisher Cat Thief (Storm Cat) came out of the race in good order and will move on to the Preakness a week from Saturday. Prime Timber (Sultry Song), fourth in Saturday's race, will also move on to Baltimore as well and could be accompanied by Kentucky Oaks winner Silverbulletday (Silver Deputy), though she may be cross-entered in the May 14 GII Black-Eyed Susan S. Excellent Meeting (General Meeting) and General Challenge (General Meeting) are likely to be shipped back to California. Worldly Manner (Riverman), who was in contention to the eighth pole in the Derby, is also a Preakness probable. Godolphin racing manager Simon Crisford commented, "He (Worldly Manner) didn't get the trip, but he ran a fantastic race." Stablemate Aljabr (Storm Cat) is on his way back to Europe and will be pointed for the G1 St. James' Palace S. at Royal Ascot in June. Other Derby runners going to the Preakness are: Menifee (Harlan), Kimberlite Pipe (Take Me Out), K One King (Apalachee), Lemon Drop Kid (Kingmambo), Stephen Got Even (A.P. Indy), Adonis (Kris S.), and Vicar (Wild Again). Also probable are Gotham S. winner Badge (Air Forbes Won), Flamingo second Forty One Carats (Tactical Advantage), Derby Trial winner Patience Game (Woodman), Lead Em Home (Mr. Leader) and Torrid Sand (Line In The Sand).

I wasn't going to say we would win the Guineas because that's the worst thing in the world to say. He got slightly excited when I rang him, as he wasn't expecting anything until then."

Three weeks ago, Artax had the daunting task of chasing one of the country's biggest speedballs in the GIII Bold Ruler H. and had to settle for second, 2 1/2 lengths behind Kelly Kip as that one broke his own track record for six furlongs. Artax had shown no ill effects from that taxing effort, as he blazed four furlongs Apr. 26 in :45 3/5 in preparation for this event. The flashy dark bay broke alertly from his outside post to sit just off front-running Wouldn't We All, with GI Vosburgh S. winner Affirmed Success right behind in third. Jockey Jorge Chavez, riding Artax for only the second time (he was Affirmed Success' rider for all of last year), set his mount for the lead leaving the three-eighths pole with Affirmed Success glued off his flank.
