PIMLICO SPECIAL A "QUIET" AFFAIR It was the third Saturday of May 1998 when Real Quiet (Quiet American) won the Preakness S. on his way to a narrow miss in the Triple Crown. It took 51 weeks and a return trip to Maryland, but the Bob Baffert trainee is back on the win side of the ledger after a hard-fought victory in yesterday's GI Pimlico Special, surviving a scintillating stretch battle with Free House (Smokester), the likeable winner of his last start, the Mar. 6 GI Santa Anita H. The two hooked up at the top of the stretch and were inseparable to the finish, with last year's three-year-old champion ultimately wearing down his rival in the waning yards for the win while carrying four fewer pounds than the runner-up. "I knew I had a lot of horse coming into the stretch," said winning jockey Gary Stevens. "(Jockey) Chris (McCarron) and I were playing a little game of cat and mouse to the eighth pole. I didn't know if we'd get there in time, but it was a great horse race."

TEAM EUROPE TAKES SHERGAR CUP Team Europe produced the equivalent of a chip in from a bunker at the 18th hole to take horse racing's own version of the Ryder Cup at Goodwood, England yesterday. The inaugural running of the Blue Square Shergar Cup pitted a string of horses representing the Daily Mail European team of owners against a string carrying the colors of the Dubai Shopping Festival Middle East team, with each team sending out five horses in a total of six races on the card. Coming from behind, the European team filled five of the six scoring places in the concluding \$160,643 Dubai City of Gold Shergar Cup Classic to dramatically overhaul their opponents. Handsome Ridge (GB) (Indian Ridge {Ire}), ridden by European jockey captain Olivier Peslier, led home a one-two-three for his side, beating Running Stag (Cozzene) by half a length with another two lengths to Border Arrow (GB) (Selkirk). Europe carried the day, gaining a 126 to 120point win. Robert Sangster, head of the European team, said, "We hoped there would be a lot of swings and roundabouts and that has happened." Sheikh Mohammed, honorable in defeat, admitted he thought it had been sealed for the Middle East. "I really thought that we were so far ahead coming to the last that they would not catch up. The Shergar Cup was successful and we are very pleased. We look forward to coming back next year," he said.

Real Quiet got a well-deserved break after his excrutiating loss in last year's Belmont S. and Bob Baffert was careful in choosing a return spot for the good-looking bay. Ultimately, the colt boarded a plane bound for the Mar. 7 GIII New Orleans H.; he raced close to the pace that day before just failing to resist the late run of Precocity (Afred) in a second-place finish. The GIII Texas Mile was next on the dance card and with Gary Stevens in the irons for the first time, the '98 Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner ran a bang-up race at a distance not his favorite, finishing just a neck behind Littlebitlively. He was the second choice on his return to Pimlico. Favored Free House broke sharply, but Fred Bear Claw came up the inside to engage the strapping gray and negate the easy lead. Real Quiet was content to bide his time in third, three lengths off the top pair at the half-mile pole. Rounding the far turn, Stevens sent his mount after Free House. who had left Fred Bear Claw behind. The two raced inseparably down the lane, but it was Real Quiet who got to the wire first in a thrilling finish. Said Stevens, "Nobody gave up, but you knew nobody would." Baffert concurred. "You almost hate to see anyone lose in a race like that. (Real Quiet) obviously needed those races. It's great to see him back in top form," he said. Chris McCarron aboard Free House offered no excuses, saying, "We hooked up at the top of the stretch and I thought I was going to shake him loose. This animal performed very well today." Baffert will confer with owner Mike Pegram before deciding on a next start.

Bill Mott sent El Amante (Wild Again) to Chicago to contest the 1996 Illinois Derby off a convincing win in that winter's GIII Flamingo S. He was made the favorite, but settled for second that day. Vision and Verse came to hand this winter for Mott, breaking his maiden Jan. 16 and scoring a three-length victory in "non-winners of two lifetime" company with blinkers added before a solid third-place finish in the Flamingo in his last start Apr. 3, but was a longshot to give Mott his Illinois Derby score. Yankee Victor (Saint Ballado) and Etbauer (Silver Deputy) locked horns through a lively six furlongs in 1:10 2/5, while Vision and Verse settled in midpack for Heriberto Castillo. Turning for home, Yankee Victor held a tenuous lead, while Vision and Verse, steadled in traffic on the turn, angled out for room in the stretch. He began to inch towards the leader, hit the front inside the final eighth and was able to hold off late charges from Prime Directive and Pineaff, who came from next-to-last and last respectively. Castillo said, "He was on the bridle, but at the same time I was glad to see it because he is the kind of horse you have to ask." Assistant trainer Ralph Nicks indicated that Vision and Verse's next start could come in the June 5 Belmont S. or the GII Ohio Derby July 24.

"Meeting" To Take Place In Preakness?:

Could the first rematch of the Bob Baffert filly titans come in the Preakness? It is a possibility, according to the trainer, who advised Pimlico that he is planning to run both Excellent Meeting (General Meeting) and GI Kentucky Oaks winner Silverbulletday (Silver Deputy) in Saturday's fixture. "But I could change my mind," he warned. Baffert will cross-enter both fillies in Friday's GII Black-Eyed Susan S. and await the results of the Preakness draw before making a final decision. If she runs, Silverbulletday would be going for a second straight in the Preakness for the Mike Pegram/Bob Baffert team. Baffert is likely to send Kentucky Derby fourth Prime Timber (Sultry Song) in the Sir Barton S. on the Preakness undercard.

K One King Officially Out:

Trainer Akiko Gothard has officially ruled K One King (Apalachee) out of consideration for next Saturday's Preakness S. "He was on the track this morning and went fine, but I could see that he was favoring a leg," she said. "I called the owner (Madeline Paulson) and recommended that we not run him. The owner said to do whatever I thought was best."

Derby Winner, Stablemate To Arrive Midweek:

Trainer D. Wayne Lukas plans to ship Kentucky Derby winner Charismatic (Summer Squall) and Cat Thief (Storm Cat) to Pimlico this Wednesday. Prior to their departure, the pair is scheduled to have one more work at Churchill Downs, either tomorrow or Tuesday, depending on the weather, according to Lukas. "I can't believe how well they are doing, especially the winner. I said last week that he seemed to be exploding and he's still doing that. He's doing super and so is Cat Thief," he said.

Zito Hopefuls Get Feel For Track:

The Nick Zito-trained duo of Stephen Got Even (A.P. Indy) and Adonis (Kris S.) arrived in Baltimore Friday afternoon and were out yesterday under the cover of fog for light gallops. "They will work either Monday or Tuesday," Zito commented. "It will be basically maintenance. If they go fast, it will be on their own. We came up here early because it has worked for us in the past," the trainer added. Zito won the 1996 Preakness with Louis Quatorze and the '96 Pimlico Special with Star Standard.
