#### FREE HOUSE INJURED IN PIMLICO SPECIAL

Trainer Juan "Paco" Gonzalez reported that GI Pimlico Special runner-up Free House (Smokester) couldn't put any weight on his left hind leg yesterday, although X-rays had come back clean. The five-year-old, who lost to Real Quiet (Quiet American) by a neck as the heavy favorite in Saturday's race, is scheduled to fly back to Southern California Tuesday. "He's not in any distress," said Gonzalez. "When we get back home, he'll have a nuclear scan which should tell us more. It covers the whole body. We're still hoping it's just a muscle pull higher up on the leg."

#### **Badge To Get Final Work Today:**

The final Preakness work for GII Gotham S. winner Badge (Air Forbes Won) was postponed from yesterday to today because of the muddy track conditions at Aqueduct. Trainer Joe Aquilino also confirmed that Robby Albarado would ride Badge in the Preakness. Other Preakness hopefuls scheduled to work today are: Patience Game (Woodman), Menifee (Harlan), First American (Quiet American) and Worldly Manner (Riverman).

#### Morse Sends Torrid Sand Despite Uncertainty:

Trainer Randy Morse has decided to ship Torrid Sand (Line In The Sand) to Pimlico Wednesday, despite the fact that further legal proceedings in the Valhol case could affect his earnings and force him out of the Preakness field. As of today, Torrid Sand has earnings of \$141,000, which includes second money from the Arkansas Derby. However, if the case is appealed, that money may not be credited to the horse's earnings, which would eliminate him from the field. "I just wish they would clear the whole thing up," said Morse. "Every day something changes and I don't know where we stand." Should Torrid Sand not be eligible for the Preakness, Morse said he would go in the Sir Barton S. the same day.

#### Vision and Verse Possible for Belmont:

GII Illinois Derby victor Vision and Verse (Storm Cat), is "possible" for the GI Belmont S. June 5, according to assistant trainer Ralph Nicks. "Why not," said Nicks. "The horse will be a little fresher than everybody else."

Winner of the Prix Juigne, a race for unraced colts and geldings, at Longchamp Apr. 11 on his only previous appearance, Falcon Flight made the necessary leap in class to land his first group race in good style from the unlucky State Shinto. Golden Marvel (Linamix (Fr)) was rushed straight into a six-length lead from Wild Arms (Pistolet Bleu {Ire}), who refused to settle, with State Shinto in third, Falcon Flight fourth and Vanishing World restrained in last as the field raced in a line. Turning into the straight, Golden Marvel still led but his advantage had been reduced to one length at the quarter-mile mark. State Shinto and Falcon Flight were both ridden to challenge the leader and held office entering the final furlong where Thierry Jarnet, aboard State Shinto, dropped his whip when about to make his bid. Falcon Flight took advantage on his outside and ran on slightly the better to win going away in the final 25 yards. Winning owner Jean Luois Bouchard, who has owned or part-owned three of the last five French Derby winners (Celtic Arms, Ragmar and Dream Well), may have another live contender for this year's renewal at Chantilly June 6, and confirmed, "It looks like we have found another good one for the (French Derby). This horse might be lacking some experience with only two starts, but we have to go for it. It will be an exciting four weeks to come and we will make all of them run for the money."

Port Bayou may have earned a shot at the third leg of the American Triple Crown, the G1 Belmont S. June 5, after pulling off a comfortable defeat of the previously unbeaten Tchaikovsky. After breaking his maiden at Galway in September in his second start, Port Bayou went on to finish second in the G3 Juddmonte Beresford S. in mid-October and filled the same spot in the Davenport Hotel Eyrefield S. in November. After beginning the year with a win in a conditions event at Cork Apr. 5, he ran third in the R & A Bailey Ballysax S. here Apr. 18. Sent straight to the front and setting a snail's pace early, Port Bayou only quickened up three furlongs out around the final turn and went clear. Tchaikovsky tried to close a furlong and a half out, but Port Bayou strode on well for a comfortable score. Winning trainer Dermot Weld was not surprised by the win and said, "Port Bayou is tough and consistent and has continued to improve. We knew he would get the trip. He is an American-bred horse and will handle the dirt." Whether or not he does head for the Belmont S., Port Bayou will also target the G1 Budweiser Irish Derby June 27. While bookmakers extended Tchaikovsky's odds for the Vodafone Derby at Epsom to 50-1, his trainer Aidan O'Brien was not too dismayed. "It was nothing more than a six-furlong race really, because they went so slowly early on, so we decided to drop him in and teach him something," he said. "The way the race worked out, I am not really that disappointed. Michael Kinane was not too downhearted either."

Lukas To Tackle European Racing:
