BAFFERT CLARIFIES BELMONT POSITION Bob Baffert, the trainer of *Silverbulletday* (Silver Deputy), said he felt he had misspoken one day after *Charismatic* (Summer Squall)'s owner Bob Lewis proposed a \$100,000 apiece horse-for-horse bet in the June 5 Belmont S. Lewis made the proposal after reading that Baffert had said his filly was "the best three-year-old in the land." But Baffert said yesterday, "I want to retract the statement. She's the best three-year-old filly in the land and we could find out if she's the best three-year-old in the land by running in the Belmont, but I don't know if we want to do that to her." Baffert also said he didn't mean to imply that he would keep *Silverbulletday* out of the Belmont to give *Charismatic* and Lewis, for whom he trains, an easier shot at a Triple Crown sweep. "That would never keep me out," said Baffert. "I tried to beat him in the Preakness. If I run in the Belmont--and I'm still hashing it over--we're going to try to win. I don't want this to turn into a personal issue." As for the filly's Belmont status, he said, "I don't know if I'm going to run her; we'd have to see how many would go in there, figure out (if she'd like) a mile and a half and see how she's training. I was just leaving the window open, and Bob Lewis told me he'll still love me if I beat him. He wants me to run her in there because he wants the Belmont to be the best race possible." Lewis echoed those sentiments. "Whether we win, lose or draw, we owe it to the public to put the best horses of the three-year-old crop on the track," said Lewis. "Since I've just won the Kentucky Derby and the Preakness, I hope we have the chance to run against her. I want to do everything to encourage (owner Mike Pegram) and he to run that great horse in the Belmont."
