Ireland's first Classic of the year is essentially a rematch between the G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas winner Island Sands and the neck runner-up Enrique. Considered by many to have been given too much to do by jockey Kieren Fallon and hampered slightly when starting his run last time out, Enrique can turn the tables as he will be positioned, in this smaller field, in closer proximity to the front-running Godolphin colt. The dual juvenile scorer Island Sands confirmed the promise of his Dubai trial form in winning the English 2000 Guineas. Orpen's run in that race was too bad to be true and he should be able to give a much better showing here. He beat only one home at Newmarket, having raced too keenly for his own good. He appears to be the stable's choice, but it would be foolish to ignore any Aidan O'Brien runner. Saffron Waldon, Marius Petipa and Lucky Legend therefore merit a mention.

Dropping down to face allowance foes here, the half to Proper Dance (Nureyev), GSP, \$168,306; and Private Interview (Nureyev), GSP, \$144,450, led from gate to wire for a 7 1/2-length triumph as the 2-1 chalk. New York Delays Suspensions:

The New York State Racing and Wagering Board, which suspended the licenses of trainers Mark Hennig and Todd Pletcher early Thursday, May 20, delayed the suspensions later in the day, allowing the two to run horses at Belmont Park yesterday and today. "The Racing and Wagering Board decided to give them 48 hours notice about the suspension," said State Steward John Joyce. "If they can't get an appeal in Florida before Friday afternoon, we won't allow them to run on Sunday." Hennig said their lawyer, David Romanik, was appealing the Florida Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering's decision in Leon County Circuit Court. "We were ready to appeal on Friday, and were just waiting for a letter from Dr. Sams, (of Ohio State's School of Veterinary Medicine). By the time it was faxed, the judges in Tallahassee took off for the weekend. We'll go into court first thing Monday morning," Hennig said. He and Pletcher are also going into Federal Court in New York. Attorney Sue Nun said, "We are going to seek a restraining order (against the suspensions) in the Southern District Court of New York." David Donk, the third New York trainer to be suspended in Florida, still hasn't been served with papers at Belmont, so the stewards are allowing him to run horses.

GISW Cetewayo (His Majesty), winner of last year's GI Sword Dancer H. at Saratoga and runner-up in the GI Turf Classic at Belmont after falling in the GI Man o'War S., makes his first start of the season in today's \$75,000 Riggs H. at Pimlico. The five-year-old, runner-up in the '98 Riggs, has not been out since finishing sixth in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf last November. Jockey Edgar Prado rides the Kentucky-bred for trainer Michael Dickinson.

Gary Stevens Bids U.S. Adieu after MassCap:

In his final ride before heading to England, jockey Gary Stevens will partner Real Quiet (Quiet American) in the May 29 GII Massachusetts H. at Suffolk Downs. The pair will face English invader Running Stag (Cozzene) in the \$600,000 event. That colt, seventh in the G1 Dubai World Cup last out, flies from England to New York today and will van to Boston after clearing quarantine Monday. "He has been training really well," trainer Philip Mitchell said. "His training tells us we should be able to take a crack at the MassCap." Jockey Shane Sellers will have the mount.

Trainer Colin Hayes Dead:

Trainer Colin Hayes, who had been battling heart problems, died early Friday morning at home in South Australia. Paying tribute to the venerable 75-year-old horseman, Australian Prime Minister John Howard said, "He was certainly a giant of Australian racing and a thorough gentleman, a wonderful person to meet, a really engaging person." Hayes obtained his first horse, Surefoot, for about \$14 in 1947 and led him home on a bicycle. His first stable was named Surefoot Lodge and from it he won 17 of his 28 Adelaide training premierships. During his 40-year career, Hayes trained the winners of more than 5,300 races. He bought Lindsay Park in the mid-1960s, building a training and breeding center that would emulate the best European principles. He set up a second stable at Flemington and was Melbourne's leading trainer from 1977 to 1990, the year he retired. He also had a large involvement in the next six training titles, which were won by sons David and Peter. Hayes won the Melbourne Cup twice, with Robert Sangster's Beldale Ball (GB) in 1980 and with Sheikh Hamdan al Maktoum's At Talaq in 1986. Said Sangster, "C.S. was a visionary who never lost touch with what he did best, and that was train horses. He loved them and it was always obvious that he did. He was also a man who was at home in the company of anyone, from royalty to the rag-and-bone man. The C.S. Hayes legacy will be acknowledged for generations, not only in Australia, but around the world." Hayes' funeral will be held in Adelaide next Tuesday.
