REAL QUIET TOPS MASSCAP WEIGHTS Last year's Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner Real Quiet (Quiet American) will be the starting highweight in the May 29 Gll Massachusetts H. at Suffolk Downs. The four-year-old, fresh off a victory in the GI Pimlico Special, has been assigned 121 pounds, two less than stablemate Silver Charm, who is not expected for the \$600,000 race. He is scheduled to work Monday at Churchill Downs, fly from Louisville to New York Wednesday and van to Boston Wednesday afternoon. Behrens (Pleasant Colony), winner of the GI Oaklawn H. last time out, gets in with 118 pounds. The others listed as likely for the 1 1/8-mile test are Running Stag (Cozzene), 113; Brushing Up (Broad Brush), 112; and Galloping Gael (Lost Code), 111. Brushing Up, fifth in the Pimlico Special, breezed five-eighths in 1:02.09 at Aqueduct yesterday morning. He will have two equipment changes for the MassCap. "The blinkers go back on and the tongue tie goes back on," said trainer Victor Simone.

LEWIS TURNS DOWN BELMONT BET First, Bob Lewis, co-owner of Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner Charismatic (Summer Squall), offered to bet \$100,000 with trainer Bob Baffert, who is toying with running his near-perfect filly, Silverbulletday (Silver Deputy), in the June 5 Belmont S. Baffert turned him down. Now Jimmy Stone, one of the owners of Menifee (Harlan), runner-up in both the Derby and the Preakness, wants to bet Lewis \$100,000 that his colt will outrun Charismatic in the Belmont. "I like my horse and issue a personal challenge to Bob Lewis," said Stone, an oil-driller from New Orleans. Lewis said no to Stone's proposal. "I don't want to detract in any way from the magnificence of the Belmont S. and the Triple Crown," Lewis said. "The bet I suggested with Baffert is different. He also trains a lot of horses for me and that was an in-house thing. I've got all the confidence in the world in Charismatic, but if Menifee should happen to beat us in the Belmont, he'll prove that he's the best horse that day and I'll be the first to congratulate him."

Having had to borrow a set of Michael Kinane's breeches, jockey Olivier Peslier collected his second straight Irish 2000 Guineas (following Desert Prince {Ire} last year) and it could not have been easier as the Aidan O'Brien-trained Saffron Waldon is now a perfect three-for-three this season. Bookmakers slashed his odds for the G1 Vodafone Epsom Derby June 5 to 7-1. A maiden winner on his second lifetime start Mar. 28, the Niarchos-bred colt stepped up to win the Icon 2000 Guineas Trial S. at Leopardstown Apr. 18. Off at 12-1 in his Classic debut, he settled in the rear as his stable companions Lucky Legend (Fairy King) and Marius Petipa (Nureyev) cut out the pace and still looked to have plenty to do a quarter mile out. There Mus-If (Lahib) and Newmarket 2000 Guineas runner-up Enrique went to the front, with Orpen also closing. But at the furlong marker, Saffron Waldon cruised up to join the leaders and quickened away in great style, with Enrique battling on hard for second. O'Brien confirmed a bid for Epsom Derby glory. "Saffron Waldon did it really well today, quickening like a good horse and lengthening really well. Olivier Peslier, who gave him a glorious ride,

said he has loads of speed and settled really well today.

He certainly has plenty of speed in the family and has

always shown us a high cruising speed," he said.


