Having finished fourth to yesterday's G2 German Oaks winner Flamingo Road (Ger) in the Listed Diana-Trial/Las Vegas-Slenderella-Rennen at Mulheim May 1, Nagoya scored her first win of the season in good fashion here to deny the fast-finishing Janestra. Festaiola (Slip Anchor {GB}) led from Nicely (Bustino {GB}) in second, as Nagoya, pick of the paddock beforehand, raced in mid-division with Janestra at the rear. Approaching the three-furlong marker, Festaiola and Nicely began to weaken as Signorina Cattiva and Barafamy (Barathea (Ire)) quickened at the head of affairs. Nagoya was asked for her effort 1 1/2 furlongs from the finish and she quickened impressively into the lead. Nagova ran on well as Janestra finished strongly on the wide outside, but the runner-up was left with too much to do late. Both of the John Dunlop-trained fillies stayed on well at the finish, with Signorina Cattiva just prevailing by a nose for third.

Father-son trainer-jockey team Barry and Michael Hills combined to win their second Irish 1000 Guineas with 16-1 outsider Hula Angel. Her convincing success couldn't be a surprise to those who remembered her win in the G2 Rockfel S. at Newmarket in October, when French 1000 Guineas winner Valentine Waltz (Ire) and Newmarket 1000 Guineas winner Wince (GB) finished second and seventh, respectively. Without a run prior to the Newmarket 1000 Guineas May 2, Hula Angel still ran well to be sixth. Carambola (Danehill) set the early pace while 5-4 favorite Wince (Selkirk) was tucked in on the rails in midfield and Hula Angel, forced to race on the outside of the field, was out of contention for the first half-mile. Two furlongs out, Carambola still led with Wince beginning her move and Hula Angel coming with a strong move on the wide outside. She hit the front with 100 yards to run and had just enough left in reserve to hold off the flying Golden Silca. Barry Hills said, "When she ran in the Newmarket Guineas, she found the ground too fast, but I thought she'd improve and I was confident she'd run a good race. She will probably go for the [G1] Coronation S. over a mile at Royal Ascot [June 16], but I'm hopeful that she'll stay a mile and a quarter and possibly the [G2] Nassau S. at Goodwood [July 31] is a target over that trip." Michael Hills added, "I got a good position and she was always cruising and really picked up well in the straight. I'm confident that she'll get a mile and a quarter." After Wince returned from her disappointing fifth-place effort, trainer Henry Cecil said, "She is not quite sound."

Croco Rouge, third to Dark Moondancer (GB) in the G1 Prix Ganay at Longchamp May 2, used an electrifying burst of speed in the final furlong to return to the winner's circle for the first time since landing the G1 Prix Lupin at Longchamp last May. Renazig (Polish Precedent), pacemaker for Gold Away, was sent straight to the lead and set a generous pace while Croco Rouge raced in sixth, traveling well within himself. Turning into the straight, Renazig still led but El Condor Pasa was going particularly well in third on the outside. Passing the quarter-mile marker, Gold Away took over with El Condor Pasa waiting to make his move, which he did 11/2 furlongs out, taking what looked to be a winning lead. Croco Rouge, who appeared to be boxed in against the rail, got a beautiful split at the furlong marker and, once clear, quickened in tremendous style to lead in the final 50 yards for an impressive win. Winning trainer Pascal Bary said, "We really expected this success and this horse has never run a bad race. He had come on a lot for his run in the Prix Ganay and he loves to be ridden this way, coming from behind the other horses. We will wait and see how he comes out of this race, but I would love to run him in the G1 Irish Champion S. [at Leopardstown, Sept. 11].

Cerulean Sky, a disappointing sixth in the G3 Prix Vanteaux at Longchamp May 2, returned to form in no uncertain matter here, when she emerged from the pack and ran on strongly for an impressive win. Cerulean Sky was reserved off the pace in eighth as Sallivera (Sillery) set about her pacemaking duties with relish with Mother Of Pearl (Sadler's Wells) in second closely followed by Juvenia. The picture of the race changed soon after entering the stretch as Sallivera made a controversial move away from the rail, allowing her stable companion Juvenia racing room. In so doing, she caused interference to Mother Of Pearl, who tried to recover and was ridden to lead briefly at the quarter-mile marker, but Juvenia held the call 11/2 furlongs out. Her lead was only brief as Cerulean Sky, who had made progress into fourth, burst from a pocket to lead at the distance and ran on well for an easy two-length success. The stewards inquired into the incident early in the straight but allowed the result to stand. Winning trainer Robert Collet explained, "We were very disappointed after her last run and now we are on top of the world again. She will now run in the [G1] Prix de Diane [French Oaks, Chantilly, June 16]."

Ahead by a Century Tiller Swingin on Ice (El Prado {Ire}), unbeaten in three career outings, captured the Apr. 17 Gll Beaumont at Keeneland in her last start. Roaring Twenties (Dixieland Band), fourth in the GIII Ontario Lassie last November in her second career outing, opened 1999 with an Apr. 23 maiden win at Aqueduct and followed that effort with a 2 3/4-length allowance victory at Belmont last time out May 12.
