Kentucky Derby and Preakness runner-up **Menifee** (Harlan) got his first look at the Belmont track Thursday after shipping in from Churchill Downs on Wednesday. The colt jogged yesterday and is scheduled to gallop this morning.

Port Bayou Update:

Port Bayou (Ghazi) may still make the trek from Ireland to New York despite a sore back. "It was just a little injury," trainer Dermot Weld said. "It probably happened when he was rolling in his stall. But he's doing real well. We're still taking all the precautions. He'll have a light workout tomorrow (Friday) morning. We'll make a decision about the Belmont after that." The colt will likely ship to New York on Tuesday.

Zito Duo Works:

Trainer Nick Zito, who has been second in the Belmont S. four times in eight tries but has yet to win it, worked both of this year's candidates at Belmont Park Wednesday. Stephen Got Even (A.P. Indy), fourth in the Preakness, went five furlongs in 1:00 4/5, while Adonis (Kris S.), sixth in the second leg of the Triple Crown, went the same distance in 1:02 4/5. "I think we're back in the game with both horses," Zito said.

Belmont Questionables:

Lead Em Home (Mr. Leader), winner of the Sir Barton S. on the Preakness undercard, is now doubtful for the Belmont S. Gll Saratoga Special winner Prime Directive (Tactical Advantage) remains probable for the race and is scheduled to work this morning. Trainer Mike Whittingham is uncertain if his California-bred Walk That Walk (Skywalker) will ship to New York.

Racing keenly in the early stages, he eventually settled in second as King Country (Fairy King) set a good pace with Massimo restrained in midfield and Tycoon's Dolce at the rear. Rounding the last turn, Russian Revival appeared to be going best of all and jockey Ray Cochrane sent him to the head of affairs entering the final quarter, quickening into a clear lead soon after. Cochrane continued to keep the leader up to his work as he ran on strongly for an unchallenged three-length win. Tycoon's Dolce was delivered down the wide outside for her run and passed half the field to claim second in the dying strides. A smiling Cochrane said, "He has only run once this season." because the ground in England has been soft. We came here as the ground was good, as soft going doesn't suit him. I was just sitting, biding my time before I asked him to go and win his race and he did it nicely. If you can win here over seven furlongs, you could go anywhere over six. I think he will drop back to six for his next race."



RAWESOME (f, 2, Wild Again--Gene's Lady {MGSW, \$946,190}, by What A Pleasure)

Louie Roussel is familiar with rising stars. It was this time 11 years ago when the colt that he and partner Ronnie Lamarque had purchased for \$300,000 as a two-year-old, a three-year-old called Risen Star, accounted for the final two legs of the Triple Crown, culminating with a 14 3/4-length victory in the Belmont S. Roussel could have another, this time with the two-year-old filly Rawesome.

"She has unlimited potential," he said.

The filly was purchased for \$65,000 at last year's Keeneland September sale.

"She had a wonderful way of moving," Roussel said. "We were thrilled to get her for \$65,000."

The dark bay came to hand very quickly for the trainer, as evidenced by a series of morning drills which included a brilliant three-furlong move from the gate in :34 3/5 May 15.

Her first start came on the evening of May 20 in Lone Star Park's third race against 11 rivals. Breaking alertly under Ron Ardoin, Rawesome settled just outside the pacesetters, took over once into the stretch and galloped home a handy 5 3/4-length winner in new track record time while being eased down at the wire.

The race impressed assistant trainer Bobby Kelly. "She won easily and did it the right way," Kelly said. "She lay third and came running at the end. They wouldn't have gotten by her if they had gone around again."

Roussel has had a couple of precocious two-year-old fillies over the last couple of years, including the now-sidelined Arrested Dreams (Dehere), who won the first three starts of her career (all at Lone Star Park) before missing by a nose in the GI Matron last fall at Belmont.

The excitement in the Roussel barn, which had Rawesome pointing towards an appearance in the GIII Debutante at Churchill Downs June 26, has been tempered somewhat by the fact that the filly came away from the race with bucked shins and will be away from the track for about 40 days, according to Kelly. But keep an eye out for her this fall.
