IT'S BEHRENS IN BEANTOWN The NTRA Champions on FOX series resumed yesterday afternoon with the 60th running of the Massachusetts H. at Suffolk Downs in East Boston. The event marked the first meeting between FOX points leader Behrens (Pleasant Colony), away from the races since his victory in the Apr. 3 Gl Oaklawn H., and Real Quiet (Quiet American), victor in his last of the GI Pimlico Special May 8. It was the foreign invader Running Stag (Cozzene) who set a leisurely pace as Behrens raced in third position in the four path throughout and Real Quiet settled between those two in second. As the field turned for home, Running Stag continued on stubbornly, with Behrens gaining with every stride as Real Quiet retreated to third. With 70 yards to run, it was still Running Stag, but a determined Behrens had aim on the leader and gradually wore him down for a narrow victory. "I knew I had this horse in real good shape. We had him tight. The rest was up to the horse," said winning trainer H. James Bond. "We thought Real Quiet was the horse to beat and we kept an eye on him the whole time. We didn't expect Running Stag to go to the lead." Third in the 1998 GI Woodward, Running Stag may have added a new trick to his repertoire, according to trainer Phillip Mitchell. "We changed tactics in this race and it worked beautifully. I think we might have a horse that we want to keep on the front end from now on," he said. Jockey Gary Stevens, who was bound for England after the race, said of Real Quiet's performance, "He wasn't used to the racetrack. It's a little deeper and more sandy. The horse pulled up fine. He was just struggling when I put pressure on him." With the six points earned for this victory, Behrens has now amassed 28 points, eight more than Free House and Puerto Madero (Chi). The next race in the champions series is the GII Stephen Foster H. from Churchill Downs June 12 which is expected to attract Silver Charm and Victory Gallop.

Sir Bear came into the Met Mile with a perfect twofor-two record at the distance and had picked up his first Grade I victory in the Cigar Mile at Aqueduct last November. Third behind Behrens in the Gl Gulfstream Park H. in February with Jerry Bailey in the irons and in the GIII Widener H. in his last start Mar. 20 with Richie Migliore up, the veteran gelding teamed with John Velazquez this time. The two sat sixth as Lil's Lad (Pine Bluff), three-year-old Cat Thief (Storm Cat) and 7-5 favorite Affirmed Success (Affirmed) vied for the early lead. Affirmed Success took over after six furlongs in 1:09.12, but the early pace took it's toll on him, too; he gave way to Crafty Friend as they raced into the final furlong. Ultimately it was Sir Bear who kept on grinding, driving to the front in the waning yards to win going away. "Johnny rode him so perfect, as if he'd ridden him every time before," trainer Ralph Ziadie said. "When I saw Sir Bear start picking it up at the half-mile pole, I called him a winner. He was so sharp. He loves New York, and he's like vintage wine--the older, the better." The winner could go next in the GII Brooklyn H. June 12. "If we decide on the Brooklyn, we'll keep him here," said Ziadie, adding, "If not, we'll bring him back." As for the favorite, coming off a second in the May 2 GI Carter H., trainer Rick Schosberg said, "I'm very disappointed. (Jockey Mike Smith) should have waited a little longer, but he got a little anxious."

Also Ran: Brushing Up, Galloping Gael, Personal Moon. After a disappointing campaign in 1998, Behrens has matured into a top threat in this year's handicap division. The five-year-old began this season with secondplace finishes in the Jan. 9 Gll Broward H. and the Jan. 30 Gl Donn H. at Gulfstream Park before earning a welldeserved Grade I victory four weeks later in the Gulfstream Park H. The imposing bay resurfaced Apr. 3 at Oaklawn Park, coming from off the pace to win the Gl Oaklawn H. going away by 2 1/2 lengths. Real Quiet rebounded from a loss in the GIII Texas Mile to defeat Free House in a thrilling edition of the GI Pimlico Special last out, setting up a clash of the titans in Boston. The field of six broke in a virtual line and Shane Sellers aboard Running Stag took advantage of the lack of pace, sending his European-based runner for the lead. He dictated a moderate pace, with Real Quiet and Behrens running as a team in second and third, respectively. Turning for home, it was still Running Stag stubborn on the lead with Behrens looming up alongside and Real Quiet, under a drive, beginning to retreat. Behrens engaged Running Stag inside the final 70 yards and outgutted his rival to the wire for his third consecutive victory. Despite the loose-on-the-lead Running Stag, winning jockey Jorge Chavez refused to alter his approach to the race. "I was worried about Real Quiet." he said. "I ran the type of race that I expected. When Real Quiet started backing up, I said 'I've got this race'." Winning conditioner H. James Bond was also pleased with the decision to rate off the pace. "We were carried out a little bit on that first turn, but Jorge had him on the best part of the track and the horse cooperated. Jorge knows this horse well," Bond commented.

Old Trieste, 10th in last year's Kentucky Derby, ended his '98 campaign with three straight graded stakes wins, taking the June 21 GIII Affirmed H., July 19 GII Swaps S. and Sept. 6 GII Del Mar Breeders' Cup H. The speedball had not been out since, despite numerous attempts to bring him back earlier this season. The second choice on his return, the chestnut set the pace while sitting off the rail, opened up on his rivals after one crack of the whip and won easily under a Chris McCarron hand ride. "It was a very impressive turn of foot he gave me after he ran as fast as he did down the backside," McCarron said. "He gave me some goose bumps. He developed foot problems (last year). (Trainer Mike Puype) would give him some time, then the problem would kick up again. He made about five decisions to stop and give this horse a little bit more time for that foot to heal. It was obviously the right thing to do." Puype added, "It was awesome. He is just a lot of horse and if you knew even half the problems that he's been through...he's just amazing." The colt is expected to make his next start in the June 27 GI Sempra Energy Hollywood Gold Cup. Even-money Puerto Madero will also be back for the Gold Cup. Making his first start since running fifth in the Mar. 6 Santa Anita H., he closed some ground in the stretch to be third. "Obviously, he's not back to being as good as I think he is," said trainer Richard Mandella. "He just ran even. We'll just have to keep tinkering and hope we can bring him forward."

Kalanisi took his unbeaten record to a perfect three-for-three with this narrow victory and may now head for the G1 St. James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot June 15. Peculiarity set the pace from Killer Instinct (Zafonic), with Kalanisi racing in third. Around the turn, Killer Instinct tried to close on the leader while Kalanisi lost ground in scrimmaging, causing him to lose a shoe. Unbalanced after the incident on the turn, Kalanisi looked well beaten at the two-furlong marker, but suddenly found an extra gear 1 1/2 furlongs out and quickened brilliantly to fly home, catching Mensa in the shadow of the winning post. The highly-touted Killer Instinct tailed off to finish fourth.
