Bombard (Lord At War {Arg}) raced in second for much of the race as Mukhalif was settled in the front rank behind the leaders. Approaching the final quarter, Mukhalif quickened well and soon led, staying on too strongly for Iscan, who traveled well on the inside, but could not match the finishing kick of the winner. The home challenge was headed by Antoniocastiglione (Pursuit Of Love {GB}), who came from the pack, but badly hampered the fast-finishing Best Grey and, having finished third, was disqualified and placed fourth. Olivier Peslier, rider of Antoniocastiglione, was fined 3,000,000 lira (\$1,628) for his troubles. Three Group stakes winners in Europe looking for their first U.S. black-type wins battle for favoritism in the stakes formerly known in as the Hollywood Turf Cup. The winner of the G1 Prix Ganay at Longchamp last April, Astarabad (Alleged) finished up his European campaign with a sixth in the Oct. 3 G2 Prix Dollar. He has been fifth in each of his North American starts, the Oct. 18 G1 Canadian International and the Nov. 28 GII Citation H. and is unraced since. A Group 2 winner in France when trained by Christiane Head, Majorien (Machiavellian) was an allowance victor in his stateside debut Feb. 18 at Santa Anita for Neil Drysdale and followed that up with a second-place finish in the GII EI Rincon H. April 4. He looks to earn his first U.S. stakes win off the eight-week layoff. Special Quest (Fr) (Rainbow Quest) won the G2 Prix Noailles at three and has two California allowance wins to his credit in a fourhorse American career. His latest victory was Apr. 25 at this distance over this course.

Campaigned on the turf his first four starts, Swamp broke his maiden by seven lengths at Aqueduct in his only start at two. Third Jan. 11 at Gulfstream in his three-year-old debut, he then reeled off two Grade III stakes wins in the Feb. 15 Palm Beach at Gulfstream and the March 20 Everglades at Hialeah. Sixth in the April 10 GII Wood Memorial in his most recent outing and only start on the main track, he had trained at Fair Hill in the meanwhile and returned to his preferred surface to score a course-record setting win as the odds-on choice. "We tried him in the Wood Memorial as an experiment," said trainer John Kimmel, "but the track was hard that day and he didn't like it. Now, it seems silly to take him off a surface he's done so well on. His pedigree doesn't scream turf, but he trained well on wood chips and I noticed that horses with an affinity for wood chips have an affinity for turf." Kimmel said that the colt would be sent back to Fair Hill to train for a possible start in either the July 25 GIII Kent Breeders' Cup at Delaware or the July 18 GIII Lexington at Belmont.


