Trainer Alex Hassinger Jr. will decide "in a day or two" whether his charge will wear blinkers in the June 5 Belmont. "He's worked well both with and without them, so I'm weighing my options," he said.

Lemon Drop Kid Preps:

Lemon Drop Kid (Kingmambo), third in the GII Peter Pan S. last out, worked six furlongs in 1:13 2/5 under jockey Jose Santos Monday. "He went the first quarter in :25 and change and finished up real strong," trainer Scotty Schulhofer said. "He's doing as good as a horse can coming up to the race."

Zito Duo on Work Tab:

Trainer Nick Zito worked both of his Belmont candidates yesterday morning, with Stephen Got Even (A.P. Indy) going a half in :47 2/5 and Adonis (Kris S.) getting the same distance in :47 3/5. "Stephen looked real good," Zito said. "I was pleased with the way he finished up. His Preakness (where he was fourth) was so much better than the Derby and he's come out of it super. Adonis looked super also. This work should have him tight for the Belmont."

The second choice stepping up to the graded ranks, she rated in fourth to the far turn, then swept by the field to take a clear lead into the stretch and was never threatened in an eyecatching effort. "She was impressive and so far she is living up to our expectations," trainer Jimmy Toner said. "She has a really big kick. This is the first time we really asked her to run her best." The 6-5 favorite Snow Polina (Trempolino), a stakes winner last season in France who was making her second U.S. start, broke in a tangle, was rushed up to set the pace for a mile, but weakened in the drive to be fourth.

A lot of faith, rather than a lot of money, is sometimes all that a breeder needs to produce a top performer. John Toffan and Trudy McCaffery's belief in Smokester has been rewarded with Free House, while Lucille Geranis' loyalty to her Grade II winner Sir Leon has supplied her friend Barbara Smollin with Sir Bear. This very dependable gelding took his career earnings to \$1,360,659 last Saturday when he added his name to the long and illustrious list of winners of the GI Met Mile, which is pretty good going for a gelding whose sire commanded a fee of only \$1,000 at Farnsworth Farms in Florida in the early 1990s.

Sir Leon certainly served Mrs. Geranis very well on the racetrack. Picked up for only \$20,000 as a two-year-old in Florida, despite a quality pedigree, Sir Leon went on to win over \$450,000 during a roller-coaster career. A stakes winner over seven furlongs at Hialeah at three, Sir Leon lost his form at four, but made up for lost time with a very busy five-year-old campaign. From a total of 24 starts that year, he notched five wins and five seconds, narrowly getting the better of Jade Hunter in the GII Seminole H. over nine furlongs and twice finishing runner-up to Skip Trial.

Those efforts were enough to earn him a weight of 112 on the Blood-Horse Free Handicap for older males and he bounced back at seven, after a lacklustre six-year-old season, to repeat his Seminole H. success and his Free Handicap rating.

It is easy to see why Mrs. Geranis would want to give her old servant his chance at stud. There is plenty to like about Sir Leon's pedigree, not least the fact that he is a member of the first crop by Private Account. Although Private Account looks destined to be remembered primarily as an excellent sire of fillies, he also sired plenty of very good sons, such as Personal Flag, Private Terms, Valley Crossing, Corporate Report, Unaccounted For, Secret Hello, Miserden and Public Purse.

Another of Sir Leon's potential attractions was the fact that he comes from the same outstanding European female line as those outstanding brothers Kris (GB) and Diesis (GB), both of whom have excelled as stallions. His dam, Oh So Sweet, was a sister to Sweet Moss, a leading middle-distance three-year-old in England in 1964.

However, persuading breeders to support Sir Leon has proved quite a struggle despite his modest fee. His largest book of mares up to 1997 was the 33 mares he attracted in his fifth season in 1994, and his first four years as a stallion resulted in a total of only 35 named foals, with Sir Bear belonging to his small third crop.

Sir Bear's breeders, Mr. and Mrs. Smollin, have the added satisfaction of also having bred his dam, Spicy Pearl. This four-time winner produced Sir Bear as her first foal and her subsequent matings with Sir Leon have resulted in another winner, Lady Pearl, and a yearling colt. Now her son's achievements have earned her a transfer from Florida to Kentucky to visit Dixieland Band this year. The Smollins must now be thanking their lucky stars that Spicy Pearl was led out unsold at a mere \$3,900 at Ocala in January, 1996.

Sir Leon is inbred 5x4 to Nasrullah and Spicy Pearl brought another line of this immortal stallion to Sir Bear's pedigree, because she is by Bet Big (by Distinctive, by Never Bend, by Nasrullah). This could be a very big week for Distinctive, because he is the broodmare sire of Beat All, the Dynaformer colt who will start as one of the favorites for the Epsom Derby on Saturday, provided he recovers from a bruised foot.

The favorite couldn't find that decisive kick which had seen him land three races this season--stablemate Andreyev just shaded him in the dying strides for third. Winning trainer Ben Hanbury said, "I think we will go for the [G2] Cork & Orrery S. [at Royal Ascot, June 17], as I don't think I entered him in the King's Stand S. He slipped a disc in the [G2] Diadem S. at Ascot last season and was very lame. The vet said he would never race again and Sheikh Hamdan tried to sell him as a stallion. But there were no offers so he stayed in the yard and the owner's Australian 'back man' sorted him out." Winning rider Richard Hills added, "He's a big, tough typical sprinter with a bit of his father, Dayjur, in him. We've always believed the horse had ability and he has really proved himself today."
