18 IN EPSOM DERBY Fears of very soft ground at Epsom for the two-day Vodafone Derby meeting, which starts today, appear unfounded after the course enjoyed a relatively dry day yesterday. The official going remains good to soft, good in places. Andrew Cooper, clerk of the course at Epsom, said, "It has been a good day here and we have escaped the worst of the rain." As is the usual practice, an eight-yard wide strip of ground has been saved from the six-furlong marker to the winning post on the far rail for Vodafone Derby Day tomorrow. This ground has not been raced on since late August last year. The Vodafone Derby is Europe's richest race, with a total of £1,065,000 (\$1.7 million) in prize money, with £611,450 (\$982,249) to the winner. Only three dropped out of the Derby field at yesterday's declaration stage: High King (Ire) (Fairy King), Markan (Affirmed) and Williamshakespeare (Ire) (Slip Anchor (GB)). The field includes a three-tiered challenge from Godolphin, with outsider Rhagaas (GB) (Sadler's Wells) set to accompany ante-post favorite Dubai Millennium (GB) (Seeking the Gold) and Adair (Theatrical {Ire}). Rhagaas was initially expected to go for the French Derby but Wednesday's rainfall has prompted the switch, which has also seen a similar move for Ed Dunlop-trained Zaajer (Silver Hawk). Tchaikovsky (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) is set to go if the ground does not get fast while stable companion Saffron Walden (Fr) (Sadler's Wells) and All The Way (Ire) (Shirley Heights {GB}) could miss the Classic if there is more rain. "We realize we risk being fined, but because of the declarations being today we have to keep our options open," said Saffron Walden's trainer, Aidan O'Brien. "We want to do the right thing for the horses because anything could happen weather-wise over the next couple of days." Full Epsom Derby field p. 2

Claxon, daughter of the 1994 Oaks beaten favorite Bulaxie, lines up with a strong chance having won the listed Lupe S. in good style at Goodwood May 19. Kilting was reported to have outworked Zahrat Dubai in a recent exercise, causing her odds to tumble from 25-1 to 7-1. She has it all to do on her bare form--a third in the Listed Pretty Polly S. at Newmarket May 2--but one should never underestimate any product of the welloiled Godolphin machine. Sunday Picnic bids to become the first Japanese-bred winner of a European Classic and has solid claims based on her best form in France, most notably taking the G3 May 10 Prix Cleopatre. Although this ain't no picnic, she is not without a chance.

He won the Gl Canadian International at Woodbine last October, but disappointed in his most recent start when seventh in the GI Breeders Cup Turf at Churchill Downs Nov. 7. Daylami had an excellent 1998 season and returned to racecourse action with a good second to Shiva in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh May 23. Silver Patriarch, last year's winner, has shown this season that he retains all his ability with a fine win in the G2 Jockey Club S. at Newmarket Apr. 30. His never-saydie attitude suggests that he will not go down without a fight. Dream Well, the 1998 French and Irish Derby winner, came right back to form with a good second to the match-fit Dark Moondancer in the G1 Prix Ganay at Longchamp May 2.

Stronach to Buy Monmouth and Meadowlands?

Yesterday's Newark Star Ledger reported that lawyers for Frank Stronach have met with members of Governor Christie Whitman's administration to discuss the sale of Monmouth Park and the Meadowlands. Both tracks are owned by the state. While stating that the administration is not actively trying to sell the tracks, Peter McDonough, a spokesman for Whitman, told the Ledger, "The Governor is looking at the long-term future of the Meadowlands (sports complex) and the future of racing. She's concerned about the long-term viability of the racing industry." The New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority purchased Monmouth Park for \$50 million in 1986. "Basically, this is a fishing expedition," Stronach attorney Joel Sterns told the paper. "But hopefully it will catch some fish." Stronach's Magna International, Inc., purchased Santa Anita Park in December for \$126 million.

Split Samples Positive:

The results on the split samples of trainers Mark Hennig and Todd Pletcher's horses came back yesterday. The second result showed the level of cocaine in Henning's horse was 50 nanograms and in Pletcher's was 20 nanograms. Attorney Joel Turner, who represents both said, "I talked to Dr. Tom Wood (director of Industrial Lab in Denver, Colorado) and he said the results were ridiculously low." Although Debbie Miller, director of the Florida Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering, suspended Hennig and Pletcher for trace levels of cocaine in horses they ran in South Florida on May 12, Federal Court Judge Kimba Wood overturned the suspension on May 26 in the Southern District Court of New York, allowing the two to continue training. Trainer David Donk, suspended in Florida along with Hennig and Pletcher, was never served papers in New York and has continued to train there.

Purse Raise at Woodbine:

The Ontario Jockey Club and the Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association have announced a 10-percent purse raise for Thoroughbred racing at Woodbine, effective June 9. The increase will add more than \$2 million to the overnight purse distribution over the year. It will now top the \$36 million mark.
