CHARISMATIC'S CROWN HOPES

CRUSHED Charismatic (Summer Squall)'s Triple Crown hopes were dashed as Lemon Drop Kid (Kingmambo) and Vision and Verse (Storm Cat) drove past him during the stretch run of yesterday's GI Belmont S., but the disappointment dug even deeper when the hero of the Kentucky Derby and Preakness was pulled up just yards after the finish line with a condylar fracture of the left front cannon bone. The colt stood on three legs as Lemon Drop Kid, the Belmont winner by a head at 29-1, galloped back to accept his blanket of white carnations. Charismatic was loaded into the horse ambulance and driven back to trainer D. Wayne Lukas' barn on the Belmont backstretch. Veterinarian Dr. Jim Hunt described the injury, saying, "It's a complete fracture, the bone is broken to the outside. There's actually a piece of the bone that is loose. He's also sustained a vertical fracture of his lateral sesamoid. We can fix the condylar fracture with no problem. The sesamoid's a little bit trickier; it simply has to heal with time. He'll be heading for surgery, probably (Sunday or Monday). It's nothing life-threatening. Whether or not the sesamoid fracture heals will determine whether or not he comes back to race." Words could barely describe the dejection in the Charismatic camp. "All week we talked about how maintenance-free this horse was and how durable he is," Lukas said. "These things happen and we have to deal with them, but it's not an easy part of the game. I feel bad right now, but I'll feel a hell of a lot worse next week." Added owner Bob Lewis, "We are devastated by what happened. This is the very thing we all deplore. Thank God we had Chris Antley on that horse. The way he bailed off, he probably saved the horse from some very, very serious further damage. The prognosis is very positive. Just what his future may be, who knows?" Elated by the victory of their colt, owners Laddie Dance and his wife Jeanne Vance still took a moment to offer their sympathies to Charismatic's connections. "I feel very, very sorry for the Lewises," said Dance. "My heart really does go out to them," his wife added.

Lemon Drop Kid showed a lot of promise at two, winning the GI Futurity and running second in the GI Champagne, but at first had not fulfilled that promise at three. Fifth behind Menifee in the GI Toyota Blue Grass, he showed even less in the Kentucky Derby, running ninth. There were signs of life, however, in the GII Peter Pan S. last time out May 23. The bay ran a solid third over a sloppy track he really didn't like and earned himself another Classic bid. Rated in eighth as the filly Silverbulletday (Silver Deputy) dueled the surprisingly forward Charismatic on the front end, he closed ground on the inside on the turn, came with a three-wide bid in the stretch as Vision and Verse found room between horses near the rail and outgamed that one to the wire to take the photo. "He just needed a little time to grow up--you know, he's a May 28 foal," trainer Scotty Schulhofer said. "He peaked on the right day. We finally got our racetrack and a good, clean trip." As for what's next, Schulhofer said, "We're going to give him a nice long rest and probably see about the (Aug. 8) Jim Dandy or the (Aug. 28) Travers, for sure." Jockey Jose Santos added, "He was dead game in the stretch. He was underestimated--he proved he belongs with these." A record crowd of 85,818 was on hand for the Belmont, breaking the mark of 82,694 set in 1971. The commingled handle was a New York Racing Association single-day record of \$67,929,018, with a record \$36,333,231 wagered on the Belmont S. alone. Ontrack betting reached a new mark of \$10,035,906, with a record \$3,143,508 wagered on the Belmont S., breaking the standard set in 1987.

BELMONT BITS AND PIECES Vision and Verse (Storm Cat), winner of the GII Illinois Derby last out, nearly gave trainer Bill Mott his first Classic win. The colt sat just off the speed early, found running room just outside of Silverbulletday (Silver Deputy) as the filly tired at the top of the stretch and missed by a head after battled Lemon Drop Kid (Kingmambo) through the final furlong. "He was doing super coming into the race and the race unfolded nicely for him," Mott said. "He was dead game in the stretch and I thought we were going to get there." Added jockey Herbie Castillo Jr., "He just kept running hard the whole way. I was so close to winning it. This horse has come a long way in the last few months and he belongs with these." Silverbulletday, trying colts for the first time, tired to be seventh. "We were taking a shot," trainer Bob Baffert said. "If she could slow (the fractions) down, get a half in :49 and change, she'd have something to kick home. But when they turn for home after a mile in 1:36, they're just tired. I'm going to freshen her up now, hope she'll talk to me. Thank God she can't talk, or she'd be yelling and screaming at me. But I'm going to give her a lot of kisses and a lot of love and she is not going to run for a while." Menifee (Harlan), the second choice at 5-2, pressed the pace, but faded to be eighth. "It's been a long road," said trainer Elliott Walden. "And it's a tough road. He never gave any indication that anything was wrong. We just had a tired horse today." GII Peter Pan S. winner Best of Luck (Broad Brush) came from the back of the pack to get fourth. "The distance was all right, he just didn't quite fire," said jockey Jean-Luc Samyn. "He didn't finish as well as he usually does."

CAREER OVER FOR LIL'S LAD? Lil's Lad (Pine Bluff) will likely be retired, co-owner Murray Durst reported yesterday. The four-year-old colt is coming off the worst performance of his career, finishing seventh, beaten 22 lengths, in the GI Metropolitan H. "The horse is fine, but I've got to stick with (co-owner) Will (Farish)," Durst said. "He's smarter than I am. I don't want to retire him, especially if there's nothing wrong with him. They can't find anything wrong with him. They think he's gotten sour." If retired, Lil's Lad will finish his career with a record of 13-5-3-0 and \$589,930 in earnings. He won last year's GII Fountain of Youth and crossed the wire first in the GI Florida Derby, but was disqualified and placed second.

An estimated crowd of 100,000 attended Epsom yesterday to watch Oath (Ire) give trainer Henry Cecil a fourth Epsom Derby victory and rider Kieren Fallon his first. All The Way (Shirley Heights (GB)) led soon after the start, coming under pressure as the field approached Tattenham Corner. Once into the straight, he was passed by Daliapour, who led by a length from Oath entering the final quarter. Kieren Fallon started driving and his mount struck the front 11/2 furlongs out and, despite lugging to his left slightly, ran on strongly to earn Classic glory. Daliapour kept on well to be a comfortable second with Beat All, Gary Stevens up, getting third in the dying strides. Cecil, who landed the Vodafone Oaks Friday with Ramruma, the Sagitta 1000 Guineas with Wince (GB) and was second with Enrique (GB) in the Sagitta 2000 Guineas, said, "Epsom used to be a bit of a problem place for us, as far as having winners was concerned, but once you have won one you can feel confident that you can win another." This was a 22nd British Classic success for Cecil, whose three domestic Classic wins this season match his 1985 achievement. He is now the fifth most successful British trainer ever in terms of Classics won and the leading Classic winner of the 20th century.

I'm looking forward to the big sprint races down the line." Trainer D Wayne Lukas agreed. "This horse is really getting good. He's tough when he runs in that six-furlong to one-mile range."

New York State Assembly Blicking TVG in New York:

The Chairman of the New York State Assembly Racing and Wagering Committee has taken to steps to thwart TVG from setting up shop in New York. In a letter Chairman Alexander J. Gromack sent to New York State Attorney General Eliot Spitzer, Gromack suggests that existing racing legislation in New York should be changed in ways that would prohibit TVG from conducting telephone wagering within the state. "The industry within this state has expressed a very real fear to me that the transmission of pictures of unlimited out-of-state races into homes of New Yorkers would create a substantial incentive to bettors here to open accounts with out-of-state telephone wagering operators," Gromack wrote. The six OTB franchises in New York state are believed to be behind Gromack's push to keep TVG out.
