SUCCESSFUL SURGERY FOR CHARISMATIC After a 2 1/2-hour surgery, Dr. Stephen J. Selway emerged to report his patient, Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner Charismatic (Summer Squall), will be "just fine." The colt, injured during a third-place finish in Saturday's Belmont S., had four screws inserted in his left fetlock joint to repair a condylar fracture. "It was not the worst injury of this kind I've ever seen, but it was a nasty one and certainly not an average one," Selway said yesterday. "What happens usually with these is that the fracture spirals to the front; this one spiraled to the back." The veterinarian added, "Let me say that this (fetlock) join was pristine. There was no evidence of any pre-existing condition." Selway believes the condylar fracture happened first, perhaps in the final furlong of the 1 1/2-mile race. Then, "as the horse went on, the damaged piece hit the sesamoids and caused them to fracture. The sesamoids are the reason this horse won't race again." Meanwhile, Belmont S. victor Lemon Drop Kid (Kingmambo) was resting up in his stall yesterday after Saturday's win. "He's fine, but he's tired," said Randy Schulhofer, assistant to his father Scotty. "A mile and a half is a long way to go. He ate all his feed last night and this morning, and came out with no problems other than just being tired." The younger Schulhofer said plans call for Lemon Drop Kid to remain in light training and then to be pointed towards the GII Jim Dandy at Saratoga Aug. 8 and the GI Travers on Aug. 28. Trainer Bill Mott said the Travers would also be the long-term goal of Belmont runner-up Vision and Verse (Storm Cat). The Jim Dandy-Travers route is also the one tentatively mapped out for the Nick Zito-trained Stephen Got Even (A.P. Indy), fifth in the Belmont. Champion filly Silverbulletday (Silver Deputy) was en route to Churchill Downs yesterday morning. Trainer Bob Baffert listed the July 10 GII Monmouth Breeders' Cup Oaks as a possible next start for the Belmont's seventh-place finisher.

A surprise second at even money in the G1 Prix Lupin at Longchamp May 16, was avenged in breathtaking manner as Montjeu stole away with France's premier Classic. Having lost his unbeaten record to Gracioso on unsuitably fast ground, Montjeu found the underfoot conditions to his liking as he gave Cash Asmussen his fourth French Derby winner this decade and provided trainer John Hammond with his second win in the race. Nowhere To Exit raced straight into a two-length lead and still led as the field turned for home, but Montieu appeared on the scene going extremely well at the twofurlong marker. Once Asmussen pressed the button 11/2 furlongs out, the reaction from Montjeu was immediate as he accelerated clear for an easy win. A beaming Michael Tabor explained why the winner raced here instead of at Epsom, "I think it's better playing at home rather than away. After speaking to John Hammond, we decided that this was the place to come and it has been proven correct. We could go for the Irish Derby or the Arc, but he is a horse that will improve in time." Cash Asmussen added, "We came across very firm ground last time, but he didn't know how to fight, I had always won easily on him. The other day he learned something, and instead of laying down, he rose up today and did what he can do."


