EVENT OF THE YEAR OFFICIALLY RETIRED MGSW Event of the Year (Seattle Slew--Classic Event {Mr. Prospector}) has now been officially retired, according to *Daily Racing Form*. The four-year-old, injured in the May 1 GII Mervyn LeRoy H., will stand the 2000 breeding season at owner/breeder John and Betty Mabee's Golden Eagle Farm in Ramona, California. Event of the Year captured the GII Jim Beam and the GII Strub S. and earned \$1,095,200.

SPONSOR FOR WOODBINE MILE The GI Woodbine Mile has been renamed the Atto Mile after the Ontario Jockey Club formed a marketing partnership with Canadian insurance brokers, Atto Insurance. The race will be run Sept. 19 with a record purse of CAN\$1 million. "We increased the purse to \$1 million this year in anticipation of teaming up with a high-quality sponsor to make this truly one of the world's top international races," said OJC President and CEO David Willmot. "We at Woodbine could not be happier, embarking on this partnership with Atto Insurance."

FASIG-TIPTON ONE DAY IN NOVEMBER Fasig-Tipton will offer a single-session selected sale on Sunday evening, Nov. 7. The sale will feature broodmare prospects, in-foal mares and weanlings. Fasig-Tipton will change its Fall Open Mixed Sale to Monday, Dec. 13. Entries for that auction close Oct. 7. Regarding the plans, company president Walt Robertson said, "The November schedule, with Breeders' Cup racing and sales, has often required us to juggle dates from year to year. For our open sales consignors and buyers, it has not allowed us to build any consistency or momentum. Several years ago we faced a similar situation with our Fall Yearling Sale in Lexington. Establishing its own time and identity allowed the sale to expand and prosper considerably. We feel the same will be true following these changes in our Fall Mixed dates."

PRIX DU CHEMIN DE FERD DU NORD-G3 results:

Favored Field Of Hope had not been seen on the racecourse since a fifth-place finish to France's top miler Gold Away (Ire) in the G2 Prix du Muguet at Saint-Cloud Apr. 24, but her prolonged absence was not a factor as she disposed of some useful sorts in cheeky fashion. Settled in fourth on favorable ground conditions, Field Of Hope always traveled smoothly as Otavalo (Diesis {GB}) set the pace from Hoh Chi Min and Alliteration. Turning into the straight, Otavalo was struggling to contend with the challenge of Alliteration, who took the lead entering the final furlong but was immediately tackled by Field Of Hope, who eased to the lead close to home for a cozy neck victory. Winning trainer Pascal Bary said, "In order to see her run her true race, Field Of Hope must meet a course on the soft side. She will return in the G2 Prix d'Astarte in six weeks for the opening day of the Deauville meeting [Aug. 1], but she will only run if the ground is soft."

Safety Vests Mandatory for Aussie Exercise Riders:

Exercise riders in Australia must wear safety vests beginning Jan. 1, the Australian Racing Board ruled yesterday. Thoroughbred Racing Board chief steward Ray Murrhiy said, "The vests only have to save one person from serious injury and they'll be worth it." Safety vests for jockeys became compulsory on Dec. 1 last year and despite heat concerns, several leading riders have credited the vests with saving them from serious injury in race falls.

Stormy Weather for Australia's Stradbroke Meet:

Brisbane, Australia's AUS\$1 million (\$646,287) Stradbroke H. meeting, which begins Saturday, will go ahead despite the torrential rains which have hit the area. The track at Eagle Farm is listed as heavy, and trainers of the horses entered in the 1400-meter Stradbroke H., or the Derby or Oaks, are saying it will be "a lottery" Saturday. Eagle Farm received a further 10 millimeters of rain overnight Thursday, bringing the total rainfall since last Saturday to 78 millimeters. David Hall, who saddles Oaks favorite Episode (Aus) (Scenic {Ire}), said, "It'll be a case of the last survivor wins, and it doesn't have to be the best filly." Hall praised the Queensland Turf Club (QTC) for rescheduling the race after it was one of four features washed out at Eagle Farm last Saturday, but added that, as of Thursday, he still hadn't officially been told by the club that the Oaks was back on. Episode is attempting to become only the third filly in modern times to win three Oaks on the Australian racing calendar.



Weldon Welcome in Ireland:

Kevin Weldon, stall superintendent at Monmouth Park, has been made an honorary citizen of Tralee, Co. Kerry, Ireland. Weldon was honored for his fund-raising work in New Jersey's chapter of the Jeanie Johnston Project. The project involves the construction of a full-size sailing replica of the famous Irish emigrant barque which carried passengers from southwest Ireland to Baltimore, New York and Quebec during the famine years. The ship is being constructed by young people from North and South Ireland. The New Jersey committee is expected to raise \$25,000.

Mossflower Back on Work Tab:

Mossflower (Affirmed), winner of last year's GI Hempstead H., breezed three furlongs in :37 at Belmont Park on Sunday. Unbeaten in six starts, the five-year-old mare has been off since that Grade I score last June. "She did not suffer an injury," explained trainer Richard Schosberg. "Her ankles were bugging her last fall. She wasn't going to make it to the Breeders' Cup, so there was no point to train her further. We gave her an extended vacation over the winter. At this point, I'm looking at her possibly returning to the races in the late summer or fall."
