SECOND EMPIRE RETIRED Second Empire {Ire} (Fairy King--Welsh Love {Ire}, by Ela-Mana-Mou {Ire}), Ireland's champion two-year-old of 1997 and the highweight three-year-old in Ireland from seven to nine-and-a-half furlongs last season, has been retired after a recurrence of the muscle problem in his hindquarter which compromised his '98 campaign. The four-year-old, who had been in training at Aidan O'Brien's Ballydoyle Stables, was found to be lame Thursday morning. "Everyone here at Ballydoyle is extremely disappointed, because we all know he had so much unrealized potential," O'Brien said. "But his muscle problem was making him very difficult to train and it wouldn't be fair to the horse to try to persevere with him." Unbeaten in three starts as a juvenile, Second Empire captured the G3 Prix des Chenes and G1 Grand Criterium. He went on to win the G3 Ridgewood Pearl Desmond S. and finish third in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas, G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp and G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at three, but had been off the board in his two outings this year. He goes to the breeding shed with four wins and three thirds in 11 starts and earnings of \$356,323. Stud plans have not been finalized.

LIL'S LAD TO LANE'S END Lil's Lad (Pine Bluff--Totemic, by Vanlandingham), retired after a disappointing seventh-place finish in the May 29 GI Metropolitan H., will stand the 2000 breeding season at Lane's End Farm near Versailles, Kentucky. Runner-up in the GI Champagne S. at two, the colt was one of the Triple Crown favorites after taking the GII Fountain Of Youth S.; he also finished first in the GI Florida Derby, but was disqualified and placed second, then was injured after finishing second in the GII Toyota Blue Grass. He won a Keeneland allowance in his four-year-old debut, but came out of the Met Mile with swelling in the same ankle from which he had chips removed last year. He retires with five wins and three seconds from 13 starts and a bankroll of \$589,930. His stud fee has yet to be announced.

The 1997 Kentucky Derby winner **Silver Charm** (Silver Buck) opened the year with a victory in the GII San Pasqual H. in January, but hasn't been out since running sixth in the Mar. 28 Dubai World Cup. Also unraced since the World Cup is that race's third-place finisher **Victory Gallop** (Cryptoclearance). The 1998 Belmont S. winner will be making only his third start of the year. The Bobby Barnett-trained entry of **Precocity** (Aferd) and **Littlebitlively** (Lively One) took turns beating 1998 Derby winner **Real Quiet**--**Precocity** in the GIII New Orleans H. and **Littlebitlively** in the GIII Texas Mile --but both are coming off losses. **Precocity** was a nosed-out second in the May 29 GIII National Jockey Club H. while his stablemate ran second by the same narrow margin in the May 31 Lone Star Park H.

GOODRICH TO LEAVE SANTA ANITA Clifford C. Goodrich, executive vice president and general manager at Santa Anita Park, has tendered his resignation, effective June 30. "(Frank Stronach, chairman of the Los Angeles Turf Club) and I jointly agreed that it would be in both of our best interests to seek a successor to my position," Goodrich said. "I have felt the need for some time to move on to other ventures, and with the change in ownership ensuring Santa Anita's continuation as a racing venue, this seems like the appropriate time for me to make that transition." Goodrich has been with Santa Anita since 1980.

SALT LAKE TO SHUTTLE TO ARGENTINA Salt Lake (Deputy Minister--Take Lady Anne, by Queen City Lad), winner of the GI Hopeful, GII Cowdin and GIII Tremont Breeders' Cup at two and the GII King's Bishop S. and GII Fall Highweight H. at three, will shuttle from Walmac Int'l to stand the 1999 Southern Hemisphere breeding season at Haras Vacacion in Argentina. The 10-year-old sired four stakes winners from his first crop, including 1996 GI Champagne S. winner Ordway. His third crop, three-year-olds of 1999, included Fantasy Lake, Canada's champion two-year-old filly last season. Salt Lake will head to South America in early July, returning to Walmac to stand in 2000.

ERHAAB TO SHADWELL Epsom Derby winner Erhaab (Chief's Crown--Histoire {Fr}, by Riverman), who has stood at East Stud in Japan since his retirement in 1994, has been bought back by his breeders, Shadwell Farm, and will return to Kentucky in mid-September. The eight-year-old will not shuttle to Australia as had been previously announced. In addition to his 1994 Derby victory, Erhaab captured that year's G2 Dante S. and earned \$899,306.

FASIG-TIPTON CATALOGUES 400 FOR SUMMER SALE Fasig-Tipton will offer 400 yearlings during its Selected Summer Yearling Sale in Lexington. The two-day auction will be held July 21-22, with bidding beginning at 11 a.m. The sale kicks off with 154 yearlings in its *New Sire Showcase*, featuring the offspring of first and second-crop sires such as Cherokee Run, Cobra King, French Deputy, Grindstone, Maria's Mon and Mr. Greeley. Established stallions like Gone West, Seeking the Gold, Silver Deputy and Summer Squall will also be represented during the sale. Catalogues will be available June 18, but can be accessed at www.fasigtipton.com starting June 14.

Sir Bear (Sir Leon) returns off short rest after taking the GI Metropolitan H. May 29. The six-year-old gelding has been off the board in only one of his last 12 starts, all stakes, and all but one graded. Social Charter (Nureyev) takes a three-race win streak into this affair, most recently scoring by 6 1/2 lengths in the May 16 GIII Eclipse H. at Woodbine. Golden Missile (A.P. Indy) defeated Sir Bear in the GIII Widener H. at Hialeah in March and is coming off a second-place finish in a Belmont turf allowance May 14. Running Stag (Cozzene) ran one of the best races of his career only two weeks ago, running second to Behrens in the May 29 GII Massachusetts H.

Eagle Farm Track Upgrade:

Stewards issued a surprise upgrading to slow for the Eagle Farm surface, which hosts the G1 Stradbroke H. today in Brisbane, Australia. Trainer Grahame Begg, who has three runners including Bonanova (NZ) (Star Way {GB}) in the race, said, "You couldn't scratch any horse from what I saw of the track (Friday), but obviously it's going to cut up badly." Trainer Paul O'Sullivan, who has Greta Hall (NZ) (Kaaestad {NZ}) in the Stradbroke, added, "It's a calculated gamble not to scratch, but there are seven figures to think of."

Quarantine Quagmire:

The New South Wales Agriculture Department is investigating a mix-up in blood tests which allowed an Australian Thoroughbred suffering from equine infectious anaemia (EIA) to be imported to New Zealand. Patrick Hogan, studmaster at leading sire Zabeel (NZ)'s home, Cambridge, says he's "appalled" that the country's \$100 million export industry was placed in jeopardy by the blunder. The pregnant mare was destroyed Tuesday night after New Zealand Agriculture officials were advised of a mix-up in blood-test results, which left the wrong horse in quarantine. The degenerative EIA is not present in New Zealand and the last recorded case of the disease in New South Wales occurred in 1986, but it has been found more recently in Queensland.

Brocco to Shuttle to Japan:

Arrowfield stallion Brocco (Kris S.--Anytime Ms., by Aurelius II) will shuttle to Japan's Shadai Stallion Station, where he'll stand for about US\$16,420 as the second Australian-controlled horse, after End Sweep, to stand in Japan. Arrowfield chief John Messara said Shadai had bought a one-third interest in Brocco. "Australian breeders operate in a global environment--we must be market competitive by maximizing returns on our stallion investments as well as minimizing the outflow of dollars to foreign stallion owners," he said. Messara added that interest in Brocco has been "intense" since the eight-year-old's progeny went under the hammer in the United States for record prices. Brazenfaced sold for \$2 million at Barrett's March sale and a second Brocco colt went for \$1.1 million at Fasig Tipton's two-year-olds in training sale. Brocco had 13 yearlings sell for \$1,875,000, an average of \$144,231. He is fully booked standing at AUS\$15,000 (US\$9,852) for his fifth season in Australia. Foreign Report cont. p6

Retired jockey Darren Beadman has been asked to assist two young riders currently serving penalties on conduct charges, Thoroughbred Racing Board Chief Steward Ray Murrhly said yesterday. The unorthodox move comes in the wake of Hong Kong stewards ordering an apprentice to attend an Outward Bound course after he was found guilty of an elbow incident during a race. Beadman, who stopped riding to become a Christian minister, agreed to talk with Jackson Morris and Bob El'Essa. "I rang Darren the other day and asked if there was any chance he could have a chat with the boys and try and help them get back on track," said Murrhly. Morris was suspended for three months after making a verbal attack on barrier attendants and El'Essa was banned for two months after verbally abusing an Australian Jockey Club official during morning trackwork.

No NTRA Hub for TVG:
