VICTORY TAKES FOSTER IN A GALLOP

Not every racehorse handles the surface at Churchill Downs, but Prestonwood Farms' 1998 Belmont S. winner **Victory Gallop** (Cryptoclearance) is not one of them. His two starts in Louisville resulted in his narrow loss to **Real Quiet** in last year's Kentucky Derby and a close-up fourth in the 1998 Breeders' Cup Classic. The diminutive bay added to his already-impressive list of accomplishments, employing a powerful burst of energy from the three-eighths pole to the eighth pole to take the GII Stephen Foster H. by five lengths from **Nite Dreamer** (El Prado {Ire}). Stablemate **Connecting Terms** (Private Terms), entered by trainer Elliott Walden as a rabbit, was involved in fast early fractions, as jockey Jerry Bailey aboard **Victory Gallop**, third in the Dubai World Cup Mar. 28 in his last start, was some 12 lengths back after a half mile. As the field rounded the far turn, **Victory Gallop** was still last, but in gear and picking off horses. His momentum carried him to the lead at the furlongs grounds and he coasted under the line with little encouragement from his rider. An awe-struck Jerry Bailey, regular rider of the last four Champion older horses commented, "He broke alertly, but dropped further back than I thought he'd be. When we got to the far turn, he gave me the most powerful move around a turn from any horse I have ever been on." Walden was equally enthusiastic about his colt's performance. "This horse has been training great. I've been waiting to run him and been excited about it. I don't know a horse in the world who would've beat him today." Walden's short-term goal for the summer is the Aug. 29 GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar, with a possible start in the Aug. 1 GI Whitney H. at Saratoga. **Silver Charm** (Silver Buck), also making his first start since a sixth-place finish in Dubai, was in his customary wide stalking position down the backstretch, but flattened out in the stretch to finish fourth. "What can I say?" said jockey Chris Antley, aboard the big gray for the first time. "He was laying where he should've been, but just didn't fire." Trainer Bob Baffert tried to remain optimistic after the race. "It wasn't a horrible race for him, but it was better than Dubai," he said. "I loved the way he has been training and the way he looks. I hate to make excuses, but today he ran even. It will take him a while to get back."

Victory Gallop's travels have been well chronicled over the last year or so. Second in both the 1998 Kentucky Derby and Preakness, he foiled **Real Quiet's** bid for the Triple Crown with a dramatic nose victory in the Belmont. After a brief rest, he engaged **Coronado's Quest** in a couple of memorable battles in the GI Haskell and GI Travers, finishing second each time and ran well to be fourth in the Breeders' Cup Classic to close the year. The bay took a Gulfstream allowance with ease to begin 1999 and faltered late to finish third in the G1 Dubai World Cup Mar. 28, his most recent racetrack appearance. Many American horses that have trekked to the Middle East have come back sour and have needed time to reacclimate. **Victory Gallop's** performance to take the Stephen Foster was anything but sour. Content to trail behind a swift pace set by **Nite Dreamer** and rabbit **Connecting Terms** early, jockey Jerry Bailey pushed the button on the Belmont champ and he responded with a burst of energy which carried him by horses one by one to hit the front at the eighth pole and was ridden out in a virtuoso performance which shattered the track record by over one second. **Nite Dreamer**, best known for his near miss in the 1998 Louisiana Derby, stalked the pace duel and finished well to be second without threatening the winner.

Running Stag looked like a horse that was outclassed last season, when he was soundly beaten in the Woodward, Jockey Club Gold Cup and Breeders' Cup Classic, all Grade I races. The colt was shipped out of the U.S. after his disappointments and made his 1999 debut in the Dubai World Cup Mar. 28, where he finished a badly-beaten seventh. After a second place finish in the Shergar Cup Classic in England, he returned to American soil and ran a game second in the Grade II Massachusettes H. at Suffolk Downs May 29. Unlike the Mass 'Cap, the bay stayed off the pace for three-quarters of a mile in this heat, started his advance entering the turn and put in a devastating five-wide rally to draw off with ease. Winning trainer Philip Mitchell commented, "Nothing takes anything out of this horse." He added that he had told jockey Shane Sellers, "All you have to do is just sit and wait and by the time you get the quarter (mile pole) you can just go and party with him." Sellers said, "Today he was just real relaxed and he made a huge move on the turn. He just overpowered those horses in the stretch." As for the future of Running Stag, Mitchell said, "The aim now is to win a Group 1 in Europe. Taking him back to the grass is really the kindest thing to do with this horse. We'll supplement him for the Eclipse at Sandown, which is a Group 1 race."

Cerulean Sky (Darshaan {GB}) won the G1 Prix Saint-Alary at Longchamp May 23 having earlier in the season won the Listed Prix La Camargo at Saint-Cloud Mar. 16. Calando (Storm Cat), winner of the G3 May Hill S. at Doncaster in September returned to finish third, beaten 2 1/2 lengths to Valentine Waltz (Ire) in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French 1000 Guineas) at Longchamp May 16, her only previous start this term. Karmifira (Always Fair), winner of the Listed Prix Finlande at Longchamp Apr. 8, finished runner-up in the Pouliches, a half-length ahead of Calando. Star Of Akkar (Distant Relative {Ire}), supplemented to this classic, won the G3 Prix Vanteaux at Longchamp May 2, beating All Glory, Louve and Cerulean Sky. Owner Frank Stronach finally won his first Canadian Oaks in 10 tries, and he did it in style: his homebred fillies finished one-two in the first leg of the newly-inaugurated Triple Tiara. Roaring Twenties, winner of the May 24 GI Selene S. over this surface, was more highly regarded than her stablemate and was main reason for the entry's overwhelming favoritism. Touch Dial, however, exhibited sharp speed in winning the May 9 Fury S. at Woodbine, and was able to harness that speed for her classic win here. The bay filly broke alertly to set the pace, then was challenged and passed by Roaring Twenties in midstretch before battling back for the victory. "The filly ran a great race," said winning jockey Mickey Walls. "When Aaron (jockey Gryder, aboard Roaring Twenties) got to me at the head of the stretch, I thought he was going to kick on and open up. But my filly dug in and we were lucky to get the win."
