SILVER CHARM RETIRED Silver Charm (Silver Buck--Bonnie's Poker, by Poker), winner of the 1997 Kentucky Derby and Preakness and the 1998 Dubai World Cup, has been retired after finishing a disappointing fourth in Saturday's GII Stephen Foster H. at Churchill Downs. The five-year-old, never worse than second in 17 of his first 18 career starts, started the year with a win in the \$200,000 San Pasqual H. at Santa Anita, but finished third in his next two tries and then failed in his attempt to defend his Dubai World Cup title, running sixth in what would be his penultimate appearance. Silver Charm showed little of the fire in the Stephen Foster that earned him 12 victories, allowing Victory Gallop (Cryptoclearance) to charge past him unchallenged and trailing home 8 1/2 lengths behind that rival. It has been a tough month for owner Bob Lewis, who watched as his Triple Crown hopeful, Charismatic, ran third in the June 5 Belmont S., then pulled up just yards past the wire after fracturing two bones in his left front leg. "It's difficult, maybe tears are shed, but you just have to deal with it and move on," Lewis said. "(Retiring Silver Charm) was something that's been in my mind for some time. He ran a creditable race in the Stephen Foster and he came out of it in grand style, but he certainly didn't show the ability to run with that class of horses any longer. He doesn't seem to have the late kick he did have and he doesn't seem to have the high level of competitive spirit he showed when he performed so magnificently in the Triple Crown races and in Dubai. Rather than demean the horse after such a great career, we feel it's the appropriate time to go on to the next stage in his life, out in the pasture, serving as a stallion. Surely we would love to have Silver Charm and Charismatic and Exploit on the racetrack, but realistically we can't do that. It is much easier when they retire sound, as Silver Charm has, but we have had good fortune with Charismatic as well. He has come through his surgery in excellent condition, and we will have three very fine stallions." Silver Charm retires with earnings of \$6,944,369, the third-highest total for a North American racehorse behind Cigar (\$9,999,815) and Skip Away (\$9,616,360). It has not yet been decided where he will stand at stud. Lewis, who will retain "a meaningful share" in his stallions, said, "We'll probably know where (Charismatic and Silver Charm) will be standing in 60 to 90 days, but we have a lot of time 'til Feb. 15."

After breaking her maiden in a conditions event at Chantilly May 17 in what was only her second career start, Daryaba would not have been considered the likely winner of this on bare form alone. But her ownertrainer-jockey combination (the Aga Khan, Alain de Royer-Dupre and Gerald Mosse) had won the previous two runnings of this race, with Vereva (Ire) in 1997 and Zainta (Ire) last year. Daryaba grabbed the lead after a furlong and she still held the advantage while racing down the center of the course as they turned into the home straight. Star Of Akkar, last coming into the stretch, made steady progress on the inside, but the winner responded well to her jockey's strong driving and ran on resolutely to hold off the late challenge. Visionnaire, prominent throughout, proved the best of the remainder and kept on well for third. Winning trainer de Royer-Dupre said, "I would rate her on a par with Vereva, who was impressive when winning in 1997. She was quite a heavy filly last year and we had to give her time to mature. This is why we didn't ask her to do too much last year and she has only come to hand lately. On her first start this year at Chantilly Apr. 26, she ran an encouraging race, which gave us thoughts about today. As far as her future is concerned, I think she is entered in the [G1] Irish Oaks [July 11], but we need time to see how she comes out of this race before making a decision."

EXCELLENT MEETING RETURNS SUNDAY Excellent Meeting (General Meeting) worked six furlongs in a bullet 1:11 Saturday and will be back in action in Sunday's GII Princess S. at Hollywood Park. The three-year-old filly finished fifth in the Kentucky Derby and pulled up three furlongs from the wire in the May 15 Preakness, but came back none the worse for the wear and has been working sharply at Santa Anita.

The winner of the G3 Cumberland Lodge S. at Ascot last September, Capri could only manage a seventhplace finish when favorite in the G3 John Porter S. at Newbury Apr. 17, his sole start this year. He put that disappointment behind him with a powerful front-running display to take this prize back across the English Channel. Ridden into the lead as the gates opened, he set a strong pace, quickening readily at the quarter-mile marker. Only Epistolaire seemed able to make a challenge. The runner-up was at his closest when Capri swerved off the rail slightly entering the final furlong, and switched to the inner as Capri rolled back in, but any interference that occured was minimal and the winner was going away at the end. The stewards enquired into the interference, but allowed the result to stand. Winning jockey Kieren Fallon said, "He's a very nice horse and we have always thought a lot of him. He disappointed early this year, but he needed the run when he ran at Newbury. He's done it well today. The cameramen and the cameras near the winning post, he just ducked out from them."
