YAGLI TO KING GEORGE Barring any unforeseen setbacks, Yagli (Jade Hunter) will make his next start in the July 24 G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot, trainer Bill Mott confirmed yesterday. Jerry Bailey will ride. "We're going in that direction. We want to give it a try," Mott said. "Of course, he still has to be coming up to it well. But if he trains up to the race well, that's our decision, to go." Mott said Yagli will ship to England about a week before the race and will be stabled at the racecourse. "It would be a real feather in our cap to win it," Mott said. "There's not much in the U.S. this summer that we'd be missing and we'd be going for a purse that's nearly \$1 million. It's a very prestigious race and we should be meeting the best turf horses in the world." The King George is the first race in the nine-race international Emirates World Series Racing Championship (EWSRC), which offers a \$1 million bonus. Mott hasn't set a schedule beyond the King George, knowing that it may take the horse some time to recover from the trip. He added that his only major goal for the rest of the year will be the Breeders' Cup Turf (also an EWSRC race) and that he may look for one or two prep races in between. Yagli has raced sparingly this year, starting twice and winning twice. He captured the June 5 Gl Manhattan H. at Belmont Park in his last appearance.

CHARISMATIC ON THE MEND Nearly two weeks after surgery to repair his fractured left front cannon bone, Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner Charismatic (Summer Squall) is doing well at trainer D. Wayne Lukas' Belmont Park barn. "He's a very good patient," Lukas said yesterday. "He's doing better than we could have hoped for. He's bearing weight on that leg very well. Dr. (Stephen) Selway did a hell of a job putting him back together. He was brilliant." The three-year-old has been taken off all medication, but will remain in his stall for at least 60 days. "He's not showing stress at all from the whole deal," Lukas said. "He's stabilized well. The most critical point is far behind us."

Impressive winning the Oaklawn Breeders' Cup H. back in March, Sister Act went on to be second to champion Banshee Breeze in the GI Apple Blossom H. in Hot Springs Apr. 9 and finished just a half-length behind Catinca after setting the pace in the GII Shuvee H. last out May 22. The crowd expected her to turn the tables on that rival this time and she did not let them down, setting an honest pace and holding Beautiful Pleasure at bay in a game effort. "They pressed us much harder in the Shuvee than they did here," winning trainer Jeff Jacobs said. "They let her get loose. When they're chasing her, they're going to get beat." As for the future, Jacobs said, "She's not the greatest summer horse. We were lucky it was cool up here for a week. We'll go to Saratoga and see how she trains. She'll probably run in the Go for Wand (GI, Aug. 7)." Second choice Catinca, looking for her third in a row, made a move on the turn, but flattened out in the drive and came home a well-beaten third. "She didn't fire her best shot," jockey Richie Migliore said. "If she ran an 'A' race last time, I would grade her performance as a 'C' today." Both Beautiful Pleasure and Catinca are also expected for the Go for Wand.
