Winner of both the G2 Prix d'Harcourt and G1 Prix Ganay this season, the French-trained odds-on favorite Dark Moondancer added a second Group 1 victory to his increasingly impressive portfolio. In a determined effort, he denied the German pair Ungaro, last year's winner of this race, and March Groom. Ungaro set a moderate pace from the outset, but quickened well once into the straight as Dark Moondancer struggled for racing room with March Groom making a bid on the outside. Winning jockey Gerald Mosse found an enticing split between Ungaro and March Groom and his mount readily accepted the invitation to go through, quickening to challenge for the lead. Both he and Ungaro stayed on well all the way to the line and it was Dark Moondancer who held the narrow call at the wire. March Groom rallied to regain third from Ivan Luis (Lycius) who faded in the dying strides. The winner, who was not suited by the lack of pace, will now point to the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot July 24, according to his trainer, Alain de Royer-Dupre.

Excellent Meeting had a four-race win streak interrupted by a fast-closing fifth-place finish in the Kentucky Derby and was pulled up after having trouble breathing in her last start in the May 15 Preakness. Back against her own sex here, the consistent filly was last early, moved up along the rail down the backstretch, waited for running room turning for home and swung to the outside for a determined stretch run that just got her up in the final strides. "That was heart and determination at the end," said winning trainer Bob Baffert. "If they were going to beat her, today was the day. Now we've got this race into her. We made that move down the backside I knew she was running and looking good. Then she ran into that wall of horses and he (jockey Kent Desormeaux) had to re-start her up again, otherwise he would have been about six wide. We'll run her in the (July 17 Gll Hollywood) Oaks next." Of Excellent Meeting's Triple Crown ordeal, Baffert said, "On the Derby, if she would have had the trip, she could have won. She just got beat 2 1/2 lengths with a horrendous trip. The Preakness, she was training great, I think a lot of it, she just got behind there and got all that sand and stuff...l think these fillies, you're better off just taking one shot at it (with the boys) and that's it. Some guy congratulated me coming out of the paddock today. I said, 'For what?' He said, 'For finally finding the right race for her."
