FOUR TO CONTEST GOLD CUP A small but select field of four was entered yesterday for Sunday's GI Sempra Energy Hollywood Gold Cup at Hollywood Park. The 7-5 morning-line favorite is 1998 Kentucky Derby winner Real Quiet (Quiet American). Coming off a win in the May 8 GI Pimlico Special, Real Quiet will be just the second Derby winner to start in the Gold Cup, following in the hoofprints of Sunday Silence who ran second to Criminal Type in the 1990 renewal of the race. GI Donn H. winner Puerto Madero (Chi) (Gallantsky), installed as the second choice at 2-1, can assume the lead in the NTRA Champions on FOX series with a first or a second in the Gold Cup. GII MassCap winner Behrens (Pleasant Colony), missing from this fray, currently leads the series with 28 points. Richard Mandella, looking for his third Gold Cup win in the last four years, trains both Puerto Madero and Malek (Chi) (Mocito Guapo). The later has not raced since finishing second in the Dubai World Cup in March. "My two horses are good enough to win this race if they're on their best day, and we'll just have to find out if they are," Mandella said yesterday. "I don't know that either of them has accomplished enough to say they're quite the same as (Mandella's previous winners) Gentlemen and Siphon yet, but they're surely made of the same mold."

MEDIEVAL MAN DEAD Medieval Man (Noholme II) was euthanized at Live Oak Stud in Ocala, Florida due to the infirmities of old age. The 25-year-old stallion's 17 crops have earned over \$15 million. Among his leading runners are 1995 champion sprinter Not Surprising and graded stakes winners Mr. Sony, Medieval Chapter, Evil Bear and Medieval Love. Medieval Man also sired Klassy Briefcase who set a world record for five furlongs at Monmouth Park in 1991. He was the broodmare sire of 1998 Horse of the Year Favorite Trick.

SARATOGA STALLS FOR BAFFERT Trainer Bob Baffert has been granted six stalls for the upcoming Saratoga meet, which begins July 28. Baffert has never started a horse at Saratoga and is 0-for-9 over all in New York. According to New York Racing Association Racing Secretary Mike Lakow, Baffert has put the name of two stars on his stall application, 1997 Kentucky Derby winner Real Quiet (Quiet American) and two-year-old filly sensation Chilukki (Cherokee Run). Lakow said, however, that Baffert has the option of changing the horses he will bring in for the meet. "We have been told that he's definitely coming for the meet," Lakow said.

BELMONT FIRE LABELED SUSPICIOUS Officials from the Nassau County fire marshal's office have ruled Tuesday evening's barn fire at Belmont as suspicious and the blaze claimed a third equine fatality yesterday. Surely Handsome (Brocco) was treated for smoke inhalation after the fire and seemed to be on the mend before taking a turn for the worse Wednesday afternoon. He was euthanized by Dr. Stephen Selway shortly after 4 p.m. yesterday. Although the investigation is still in its early stages, officials have not ruled out arson as a cause for the fire.

PAULSON TO SELL BROOKSIDE SOUTH Allen Paulson has put Brookside Farms South near Reddick, Florida on the market, according to a report in Thoroughbred Times. The 420-acre farm features 10 barns with 220 stalls, one-mile training track and four residences and carries a price tag of \$5 million. Paulson bought the nearly 900-acre property in 1992 for a reported \$3 million and sold roughly half of that to Roberts Development Corp. in 1996.
