TVG ANNOUNCES TV CREW The TV Games Network (TVG) announced its on-air talent and production staff at a launch party and press conference in Beverly Hills yesterday. The 24-hour-a-day cable network devoted to live horseracing is set to debut in July. Raymond Brune, most recently executive producer of ABC's Good Morning America/Sunday, joins Tony Allevato, formerly with ABC Sports and the producer of Hollywood Park Live!, as co-executive producer. On-air talent will include Caton Bredar, who has been seen on ESPN and Fox telecasts; trainer Frank Lyons, whose filly Desert Stormer won the 1995 Breeders' Cup Sprint; Matt Carothers, the former host of Monmouth and Meadowlands' replay shows; Gary Mandella, the son of trainer Richard Mandella; and Craig Hummer, who has worked for ESPN, Fox and NBC. TVG, an official marketing partner of the National Thoroughbred Racing Association, will feature four to six live, hosted races per hour and will offer home betting by telephone and through the Internet, and by interactive cable technology as it becomes available. A mix of Thoroughbred, harness and quarter-horse racing will be shown from tracks across the nation. TVG is a subsidiary of TV Guide, Inc., which is jointly owned by Liberty Media Corp. and News Corp.

NASTY AND BOLD DEAD Nasty and Bold (Naskra), the winner of the GI Brooklyn H. and GII American Derby in 1978, had to be put down due to the infirmities of old age, it was revealed Thursday. The 24-year-old stallion stood at Maple Heights Farm in Carlisle, Kentuck for a fee of \$1,000 this season. From 17 crops to race, the Kentucky-bred produced 38 stakes winners, including Grade I winners Ms. Eloise and Miss Josh and Puerto Rican champion Susie. His progeny have earned more than \$22 million. He is represented by 32 two-year-olds this year.
