ANOTHER TRAGEDY AT BELMONT Just four days after a fire which swept through the barn 8 annex at Belmont Park killed three horses, yet another tragedy cast a pall over Belmont yesterday, this time in the paddock. While in the process of being saddled prior to the running of the GI Mother Goose S., GI Acorn S. winner Three Ring flipped and sustained massive injuries when she hit her head, according to attending veterinarian Dr. Anthony Verderosa. She was immediately euthanized. Owned by Barry K. Schwartz and trained by Florida-based conditioner Eddie Plesa, Three Ring won the GII Davona Dale S. and the GII Bonnie Miss back-to-back in Florida over the winter, before finishing last in the Kentucky Derby after her saddle slipped. Three Ring's career ends with six wins from 10 starts and earnings of \$773,440.

PINCAY TOPS IN JOCKEY CHALLENGE The NTRA Jockey Challenge at Lone Star Park Friday evening featured 10 of the best jockeys America has to offer and when the dust settled, it was Laffit Pincay Jr. the winner with a total of 19 points. The Panamanian got off to a flying start when Gold Nugget, his mount in the first of the four challenge races, won by 4 1/2 lengths, earning the veteran 12 points. Pincay easily outdistanced Pat Day, Shane Sellers and Kent Desormeaux, each of whom rode one winner to log 12 points. The veteran in the field of top American riders joins previous winners Gary Stevens (1997) and Shane Sellers (1998).

SPRINT CHAMPION OUT OF TRIPLE BEND Breeders' Cup Sprint champion and Eclipse Awardwinning sprinter Reraise (Danzatore) has been withdrawn from this afternoon's GII Triple Bend Breeders' Cup H. at Hollywood Park. "He has a slight strain in the right tendon," said trainer Craig Dollase. "It is very minute, the prognosis is very good for a return. He did it on the track galloping (Friday)."

Manistique has ventured outside of California twice, losing both times to Banshee Breeze by a total of 17 lengths, a 6 1/4-length defeat in the GI Alabama at Saratoga last August as the 1-2 favorite and most recently a 10%-length drubbing in the Apr. 9 G1 Apple Blossom H. at Oaklawn Park, a race in which the 17hands filly reportedly displaced her palate. Within the confines of California, however, she was a perfect seven-for-seven and has seldom been challenged. Fortunately for new rider Chris McCarron, subbing for Gary Stevens, the Vanity is run at Hollywood Park. Content to let Yolo Lady gallop along to a three-length advantage, McCarron had the homebred in a perfect stalking position just off the rail in the opening stages of the race. Asked to take up the running entering the final turn, Manistique accelerated past Yolo Lady with ease, drawing off with just a few taps of the whip. "(Trainer) John (Shirreffs) brought her over here in absolutely fit condition. She is the kind of horse that gives you the feeling that they've got to be coming because she doesn't feel like she's going that fast. She just has a huge stride, covers so much ground" said McCarron. "And it's a very rhythmic stride, it just doesn't feel like she's going that fast." Runner-up Alex Solis knows how fast Manistique can go. "She is just too much," he said.

Dreams Gallore won the first two starts of her career, before closing out her two-year-old campaign with a solid second-place finish in the Pontalba S. at the Fair Grounds. In her third start of 1999, the bay came from behind to take the GIII Honeybee S., and was third to Excellent Meeting in the GII Fantasy S. three back. The Asmussen pupil stamped herself a top-five filly in her next two starts, when second by two lengths to Silverbulletday in both the GI Kentucky Oaks and May 14 GII Black-Eyed Susan S., her most recent start. As the gates opened, Robby Albarado took Dreams Gallore in hand and was last after the opening four furlongs. Confidently ridden, the heavy favorite loomed up to engage Oh What A Windfall and Better Than Honour nearing the top of the lane, zoomed by those two once into the stretch and coasted home the easiest kind of winner. "My filly just keeps getting better," said Albarado. "All you have to do is get her into the right spot and she takes care of the rest. She finished ral kindly today and had something left." Trainer Steve Asmussen indicated that the GI CCA Oaks July 24 would likely be the next start for Dreams Gallore. "We'll probably bring her back to Churchill and have her train there because she has flourished in that environment," he commented.

Dance Master's first stakes win provided trainer D. Wayne Lukas with his fourth triumph in the Bashford Manor S. The chestnut colt has begun to justify his price tag, showing improvement with every start, culminating in his most recent start when he broke his maiden by four lengths at Belmont June 5. Previously, Dance Master had finished second to Sky Dweller in a Churchill maiden event May 16, but was subsequently disqualified as he tested positive for the substance Benzenemethanol, a drug used in treating minor breathing problems and skin diseases. The winner drifted out at the start, but was quickly straightened out and set all the fractions en route to a very impressive victory. After the race, Lukas said "More than likely we'll go East with him, but I don't know exactly where." Favored Sky Dweller struggled with the track, according to jockey Pat Day, but rallied well to finish a clear second.

General Challenge won the first two outings of his career both against Cal-breds, before taking the GII Santa Catalina at Santa Anita Jan. 31 in his first try at two turns. Shipped to New Orleans for the Louisiana Derby, the lanky chestnut reportedly did not handle the journey well and a poor start in the race itself contributed to a disappointing fifth-place finish. He atoned for that loss with the addition of blinkers to take the GI Santa Anita Derby by 3 1/2 lengths which established him as the Kentucky Derby favorite, a race in which he would finish a troubled 11th, beaten 6 1/4 lengths. Given some rest, the homebred trained brilliantly in the interim, blasting five furlongs June 22 in :57 3/5 to signal his readiness for this effort. Shedding the shades, General Challenge settled nicely towards the rear while saving ground as Desert Hero contributed to a sensible pace. At the three eighths pole, David Flores aboard General Challenge made his move for the front, assumed command with a furlong to run and won by a widening margin to take a full second off Old Trieste's stakes record of last year. Said trainer Bob Baffert, "He's a very special horse and it's good to have him back like this. You look at his coat and stuff and he's really just blooming now." Baffert hopes the gelding blossoms even more in the GI Swaps S. July 18.

Following the scratch of Vodafone Derby winner Oath (Ire), the form of that Classic will now be represented by the runner-up Daliapour and third Beat All. who has been supplemented here at a cost of Ir£77,500. Daliapour had previously finished runner-up in the G3 Lingfield Derby Trial May 8, while Beat All had been off the track since beating subsequent Derby Italiano winner Mukhalif (Ire) in the Listed Newmarket S. Apr. 30. Montjeu, whose participation depends on the state of the ground, was an impressive winner of the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby) at Chantilly June 6, having lost his unbeaten record with a surprise defeat on fast ground in the G1 Prix Lupin at Longchamp May 16. Progressive Mutafaweg has also been supplemented and runs only nine days after an impressive win in the G2 King Edward VII S. at Ascot June 18. 
