QUIET IS GOLDEN AT HOLLYWOOD Struggling to regain the form which got him home first in the 1998 Kentucky Derby and Preakness S. only to fall a nose short of Triple Crown glory in the Belmont S., Real Quiet (Quiet American) proved to be the real deal at Hollywood Park yesterday, winning one of the country's most prestigious events for older horses in the GI Sempra Energy Hollywood Gold Cup. Second in the March 7 GIII New Orleans H. at the Fair Grounds in his first start since last June's Belmont, he followed that race up with a second in the April 18 GIII Texas Mile at Lone Star, both losses coming as the 1-2 favorite. After a win in the GI Pimlico Special May 8, he was sent off the 4-5 choice in the May 29 GII Massachusetts H. at Suffolk Downs, but faltered, finishing third. All was redeemed yesterday, however. "When he runs a mile and a quarter, that's his distance," said winning trainer Bob Baffert, finding parallels to his Derby victory. "Any shorter, and he's going to have his little problems. That's why he's not a win machine." The victory puts Real Quiet second in the NTRA Champions on FOX Series standings with 22 points (Behrens leads with 28), and while the four-year-old's name appears on Baffert's Saratoga stall applications, he would not say whether the Aug. 1 Gl Whitney H. at the Spa or the Aug. 29 Gl Pacific Classic at Del Mar, the series finale, would be next. "I train my horses like I live my life," said Baffert. "One day at a time." The win was jockey Jerry Bailey's second straight in the Gold Cup, following his victory aboard Skip Away last year, and his fourth in the last eight years.

MONTJEU TOPS SADLER'S WELLS TRIFECTA IN IRISH DERBY French-trained favorite Montjeu (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), whose participation had been in doubt until the rains arrived at The Curragh Saturday, topped a one-two-three sweep for his Coolmore-based stallion in yesterday's G1 Budweiser Irish Derby in County Kildare, Ireland. (See Weekend Results, page 2). The winner followed in the hoofprints of last year's winner, his compatriot, Dream Well (Fr) (Sadler's Wells), by adding the Budweiser Irish Derby to his G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby) win at Chantilly June 6. Ironically, Cash Asmussen was on board both Sadler's Wells colts. The win establishes Montjeu as one of the favorites for the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 3.

Looking for redemption in this four-horse field and just his second win in five starts this year, Real Quiet's trainer Bob Baffert sent East for jockey Jerry Bailey, who stopped hearts in the stretch with his patient ride. Bailey settled the '98 Derby winner in last place down the backstretch off the pacesetting pair of Malek and Budroyale. Puerto Madero tracked those two in third, but as the field turned for home, Puerto Madero began to tire badly, and Bailey decided to wait for the dueling front-runners to drift off the rail. Anticipating an opening strides before it actually appeared, Bailey asked Real Quiet with a left-handed whip, and the four-year-old responded, running up on the leaders and slipping through the opening eventually left by a drifting Malek to get up for the win. Budroyale outnodded Malek late to snatch second place. "I left myself with three options," said Bailey of his stretch tactics. "One out, one in, one in between if the horses kind of split on me. I think I prepared myself well, but you always have to have some luck and a good horse." Ted West Jr., the trainer of Budroyale, who raced to Malek's outside through the lane, said, "I don't even know if our horse saw Real Quiet. I was hoping they wouldn't let him through, but Bailey found a way through there somehow." Said Richard Mandella of his third and fourthplace finishers, "I thought Malek got a little tired the last eighth of a mile, but he ran a great race. The frustration is trying to figure what I've done wrong with Puerto Madero."

Settled in last position as Urban Sea (Fr) (Bering (GB) led at a good pace from the Aga Khan's G1 Vodafone Derby runner-up Daliapour, Montjeu was still in the rear with less than a half-mile to run. But cool-asa-cucumber rider Cash Asmussen was only biding his time and caught all the breaks in the stretch, finding room whenever he needed it. He collared Daliapour at the quarter-pole and cruised into the lead with a minimum of effort to go clear for a superb victory. His trainer, John Hammond, whose Suave Dancer was beaten by Generous (Ire) in this race in 1991, said, "I am absolutely thrilled. It's lovely to win here in Ireland, with a great crowd and a super atmosphere. This is a super horse and he is improving with every race. He stays, he quickens and he's got an engine--everything you need. He's also more mature in his mind these days. I thought Cash rode a great race." Owner Michael Tabor, who shares the horse with Susan Magnier, but in whose colours Montjeu runs, said, "This is almost too good to be true. This is a special horse and Cash rode him to perfection. He simply cruised through to win and could not have been more impressive, winning as he liked, almost nonchalantly. It's all very exciting. The Arc is his main objective now, but he may have a race between now and then." Asmussen said, "Montjeu proved today that he is very special and, importantly, that he doesn't need a bog to be at his best." Daliapour's trainer, Luca Cumani, said he would renew his rivalry with Montjeu in the Arc.

Having suffered his only defeat when fourth to Montjeu in the G1 Prix du Jockey Club (French Derby) at Chantilly June 6, Slickly returned to his winning ways to land his first Group 1 event in impressive style. Slickly raced in second early, seized the initiative entering the final quarter and quickened clear of his rivals. Sardaukar was stuck in traffic at a critical point but nonetheless ran on best of the rest once in the clear and looked highly promising in third. Winning jockey Thierry Jarnet said, "I had so much horse left at the top of the straight that I did not hesitate to take off. I thought that it would take a super horse to catch me. ! had never ridden him before, even at work in the morning, and I must say that I am quite impressed." Owner Jean-Luc Lagardere's racing manager, Roland de Longevialle, said, "We don't know what could be next for him. We could keep him over 2000 meters (1 1/4 miles) and aim him at the (G1) Champion S. (at Newmarket, Oct. 16) or we could be tempted to run him again over a mile and a half and go for the (Oct. 3) Arc."

The winner of two of five starts in the French provinces, Mazel Trick made his American debut Oct. 3 at Santa Anita on the turf, finishing fourth. Switched to the dirt for his next, an optional claimer Oct. 24 at Santa Anita, he closed for his first stateside win and followed that up with a main-track victory in the GIII Laz Barrera H. at Hollywood Nov. 14. Rested since that victory, he was sent away the second choice behind even-money favorite Regal Thunder, took over in midstretch and drew away with ease to set a new track record. "I hadn't been working this horse, but (trainer) Bobby (Frankel, in Canada for the Queen's Plate) relayed the message that I should just let him place himself," said jockey Chris McCarron. "Then, he said, just try to find some room and go. Well, he went. Heck, I didn't know I could ride in nineteen-and-four."



Indy), winner of the Desert Stormer H. in her lone race this year, but the favorite was eased as Enjoy the Moment wired the field. Trainer Bill Spawr said she would be pointed next to the \$300,000 Chula Vista Aug. 8 at Del Mar. Eddie Delahoussaye, the rider of A.P. Assay, said his filly bobbled when another horse crossed in front of her. "I thought she might have broken down, but she didn't," he said. "It must have been the sand hitting her. Apparently, she is okay."
